AMAZIN' STARTS HERE BROOKLYN CYCLONES (18-14, 18-14) at ROME EMPERORS (16-14, 16-14)

LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn earned the 1,000th win in franchise history with a 2-1 victory over Rome on Saturday afternoon...The Cyclones jumped in front in the first with a 1B **William Lugo** RBI single and took the lead for good in the seventh on a run-scoring knock by DH **Wilfredo Lara**...Lara reached base three times in the contest...LF **Nick Morabito** worked three walks and scored both of Brooklyn's runs...RHP **Douglas Orellana** struck out a season-high 10 over four innings in a no-decision...RHP **Jake Stevenson** (1.0 IP), RHP **Josh Hejka** (1.2), and RHP **Joshua Cornielly** (1.0) combined to toss 3.2 scoreless innings of relief to close out the win, earning the win, hold, and save, respectively.

A THOUSAND VICTORIES: Brooklyn's 2-1 victory at Rome on Saturday afternoon marked the 1,000th in Cyclones' franchise history...Brooklyn holds a record of 1,000-842 (.543) in 1,842 games since 2001...Tuesday's 6-2 victory in Rome marked the franchise's 200th since joining the South Atlantic League in 2021...The Cyclones are 202-211 (490) in 412 games...Brooklyn captured its 900th franchise victory with a 6-5 triumph over Wilmington on August 14, 2022...Brooklyn's very first win came in a 3-2 victory on June 19, 2001, at Jamestown.

DOUBLE-DIGIT DOUGLAS: RHP **Douglas Orellana** set a personal and team season-high with 10 strikeouts on Saturday afternoon at Rome...The 22-year-old did not allow a run on two hits and walked just one...It was the second double-digit strikeout game of Orellana's career...The Caracas, Venezuela native punched out a career-high 11 over four frames in Game 2 of a doubleheader for the Florida Complex League Mets on July 14, 2022...Orellana is the first Cyclone to strike out 10+ hitters in a single game since RHP **Robert Colina** punched out 10 in six innings in a win at Greenville on September 2, 2023...The right-hander enters play on Sunday tied for ninth in the South Atlantic League in strikeouts (35).

PITCHING IN: The Cyclones have one of the best pitching staffs in all of Minor League Baseball in 2024...Entering play on Sunday, Brooklyn holds a South Atlantic League-best 2.95 ERA (92 ER in 280.1 IP)...The Cyclones' .590 opposing OPS is also the lowest in the circuit...Brooklyn's 2.95 ERA ranks fifth in all of Minor League Baseball...Double-A Birmingham (Chicago-AL) holds the best mark at 2.48...The Cyclones' .590 opposing OPS is the lowest in the minors, while the 1.18 WHIP is the eighth-lowest...Brooklyn is also tied for third in MiLB with five shutouts.

EXTRA! EXTRA! Brooklyn's 6-3 win over Rome on Friday night marked the Cyclones' first win in extra innings in 2024...The Cyclones had started the season 0-2, dropping contests on April 7 at Wilmington and May 2 vs. Aberdeen...Friday was Brooklyn's first win in added frames since a 13-12 triumph in 10 innings at Asheville on August 24, 2023...Since the start of 2023, the Cyclones are 7-10 in extra-inning contests.

GATOR-ADE: RHP **Brandon Sproat** has thrived in his first professional season for the Cyclones...After setting a career-high in innings pitched (5.2) and matching a career-best in strikeouts (8) on Thursday, the former Florida Gator enters play on Sunday with a 2-1 record and 1.07 ERA (3 ER in 25.1 IP)...Among pitchers with 25.0+ innings pitched, Sproat ranks third in the South Atlantic League in ERA (1.07), fifth in batting average against (.141), and fifth in strikeout rate (32.4%)...Sproat's 11.72 strikeouts-per-9-innings ratio is also good for third-highest in the SAL.

YIPPEE KI-YAY: TWP **Nolan McLean** has had an incredible start to his Cyclones career...On the mound, McLean had his team-best scoreless inning streak halted at 15.1 innings in a no-decision on Friday at Rome...Over his last four starts, McLean is 2-0 with a 1.00 ERA (2 ER in 18.0 IP), allowing just 10 hits and five walks (.781 BB%), adding 21 strikeouts (32.81 K%). On the year, he is tied for eighth in the South Atlantic League in WHIP (1.00) among pitchers with 24.0+ innings...At the plate, the 22-year-old tied a career-high with three hits and collected a pair of extra-base hits with a double and a two-run home run on Wednesday...McLean enters play on Sunday with 11 extra-base hits, tied for 10th in the SAL...The Willow Springs, N.C. native has registered 35 fewer plate appearances (57) than any other player with 11+ extra-base knocks in the circuit and 10 fewer plate appearances with that total across the minor leagues...Among players with 55+ plate appearances, McLean is second in the league in slugging (.611) and eighth in OPS (.909).

OMAR-I-GONE: With a pair of stolen bases off the bench last Thursday afternoon, OF **Omar De Los Santos** (58) became the Cyclones' all-time stolen base king, breaking a tie with UT **Jaylen Palmer** (50)...In 2023, the 24-year-old eclipsed INF **Walter Rasquin**'s (32) single-season stolen base record with 37 swipes...Omar is 16 swipes away from tying his previous record and on pace for 87 in 2024...De Los Santos is 2-for-23 stealing bases to start the season...The 21 swipes are second in the South Atlantic League and tied for second-most throughout the minors...Since the start of 2022, De Los Santos is tied for third across the Minors in steals (128).

WALK THIS WAY: 1B/OF **Ryan Clifford** and INF **William Lugo** have accumulated walks in droves in 2024...Clifford's 32 walks are not only the most in the South Atlantic League but the most in all of Minor League Baseball...Clifford also ranks second in the SAL in on-base percentage (.424)...Additionally, Lugo's 26 free passes are tied for third-most in the league...Clifford's 24.2% walk rate is fourth-best in MiLB, while Lugo's 22.6% mark is good for 10th.

NICK THE STICK: INF **Nick Lorusso** has quietly been one of the top hitters in the South Atlantic League in 2024...The Connecticut native's season-long hitting streak was snapped at nine on Saturday, but his on-base streak stands at 10...Since April 27, the former Maryland Terrapin is 11-for-39 at the plate, hitting .282/.341/.436 with a .777 OPS...Lorusso has five runs scored, four doubles, a triple, and six RBI in that time...The 23-year-old is tied for second in the South Atlantic League in triples (2), tied for third in doubles (8), tied for seventh in extra-base hits (12), and 10th in slugging (.478).

WELCOME TO BROOKLYN: OF **Nick Morabito** has reached safely all four games since making his High-A and Cyclones debut on Tuesday night...The now 21-year-old leads Minor League Baseball in on-base percentage (.508) and sits fourth in batting average (.370)...He is also eighth in wRC+ (.193)...At the time of his promotion from Single-A St. Lucie, Morabito led the Florida State League in hitting (.397), on-base percentage (.530), and OPS (1.043)...He was also third in slugging (.513), hits (31), and stolen bases (11), tied for sixth in walks (18), and seventh in total bases (40).

vs. ROME: Brooklyn opens its only two-week road trip of the season against the Braves' High-A affiliate...The Emperors possess seven of Atlanta's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: RHP **Spencer Schwellenbach** (3), RHP **Owen Murphy** (5), RHP **Drue Hackenberg** (10), RHP **Jhancarlos Lara** (13), INF **Sabin Ceballos** (18), INF **Ambioris Tavarez** (21), and RHP **Lucas Braun** (24)...This marks the first ever meeting between the Rome and Brooklyn franchises since the Cyclones entered the South Atlantic League in 2021...Rome will visit Coney Island from July 23-28.

JONAH'S WHALE OF A START: RHP **Jonah Tong**'s stretch of innings to start the year without allowing an earned run came to a close on Wednesday night at 26.0 frames...In seven appearances (five starts) between St. Lucie and Brooklyn, the 20-year-old is 1-0 with a 0.33 ERA (1 ER in 27.2 IP)...Tong is tied with High-A Beloit's LHP **Emmett Olson** (0.33) for the lowest ERA among qualifiers in Minor League Baseball...The Markham, Ont. native is third among qualifiers in MiLB in strikeout rate (43.5%) and sixth in strikeout-to-walk rate (32.4%)...Tong's 47 strikeouts are 10th-most in the minors.

ATOP THE HEJ-ES: RHP **Josh Hejka** earned his first save of the season last Sunday afternoon vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 50 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-1 record with a 2.59 ERA (23 ER in 80.0 IP) and 4 saves, walking just 19 and striking out 70.

FEAR THE HAWK: RHP **Dakota Hawkins** had his 9-inning scoreless streak snapped in the fifth inning on Thursday at Rome...The stretch was the longest spotless run by a Brooklyn reliever this year...Among South Atlantic League relief arms, Hawkins is tied for fourth in the circuit in strikeouts (26)...He is also tied for eighth in innings pitched (17.0) and ninth in strikeout-to-walk rate (6.50).

LONG ARM OF THE LAW: RHP **Justin Lawson** has started his 2024 with a bang...The former member of the NC State Wolfpack is tied for third in the circuit in saves (4) with teammate RHP **Joshua Cornielly**...Among South Atlantic League relievers with at least 15.0 innings pitched, the 23-year-old leads the circuit in ERA (0.59), WHIP (0.72), and fewest hits allowed (5).

GOING BACK TO BACK: The Cyclones shut out the IronBirds for the second-straight day with a 4-0 win last Saturday...RHP **Nolan McLean** (5.0 IP), RHP **Victor Castañeda** (2.0), and RHP **Ben Simon** (2.0) combined on a five-hitter...On Friday, RHP **Brandon Sproat** (5.0), RHP **Jeffrey Colón** (2.2), and RHP **Joey Lancellotti** (1) united to one-hit Aberdeen, 2-0...The back-to-back shutouts are the first for the Cyclones at the full-season level and the first since Brooklyn blanked the Connecticut Tigers on the road in both ends of a doubleheader on August 23, 2019...RHP **Michel Otañez** (4.1), RHP **Mitch Ragan** (1.2), and RHP **Josh Hejka** (1.0) united on a 4-0 win in Game 1, while RHP **Dan Goggins** (2.0), RHP **Hunter Parsons** (2.0), and RHP **Jared Biddy** (3.0) led the charge to a 5-0 victory in Game 2...It is also the first for Brooklyn in consecutive nine-inning games since August 21-22, 2014, vs. Staten Island and Tri-City...RHP **Daisuke Matsuzaka** (5.0), LHP **Brad Wieck** (2.0), LHP **Kelly Secrest** (1.0), and LHP **Shane Bay** (1.0) twirled the Cyclones to a 2-0 win over Staten Island in the first leg...RHP **Martires Arias** (5.0), RHP **Gaither Bumgardner** (2.0), and RHP **Cameron Griffin** (2.0) provided the zeroes in a 7-0 rout of Tri-City on the back end...Last Saturday's blanking marked the fifth of the season for Brooklyn's pitching staff...The five shutouts are the most in the South Atlantic League and tied for the second-most in all of Minor League Baseball...The Cyclones set a franchise record with 11 shutouts in 2023.

KING STANLEY: With his RBI double in the bottom of the first inning last Friday, OF **Stanley Consuegra** became the first player in Cyclones history to reach the century mark in RBI...The 23-year-old is Brooklyn's all-time leader in several categories, including 67 extra-base hits, 29 home runs, and 101 RBI...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C **Francisco Alvarez** for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...Consuegra also surpassed Alvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by **Ronny Mauricio** in 2021.

SEVENTH HEAVEN: The Cyclones' offense exploded for seven runs in the bottom of the first in last Tuesday's 9-2 win vs. Aberdeen...They also accomplished the feat in the bottom of the third in a 13-3 win vs. Wilmington on April 24...Brooklyn had 10 consecutive batters reach base with one out in the inning...The seven-run frames are the largest for the Cyclones since they erupted for nine in the bottom of the second inning on July 27, 2023, vs. Wilmington, in an 11-7 triumph...The 13 runs for Brooklyn set a new season high...The Cyclones had not tallied that many in a single contest since a 13-12 win at Asheville in 10 innings on August 24, 2023...It was the first time Brooklyn scored 13+ in a nine-inning game dating back to an 18-1 thrashing at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022...Since 2005, the Cyclones' highwater mark for runs in a single inning is 10 in the top of the sixth of a 20-6 romp at Bowling Green on May 27, 2022...The 20 runs were also a franchise record.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The Cyclones have five of the Top 30 per BA: **Ryan Clifford** (No. 6), **Brandon Sproat** (10), **Nolan McLean** (11), **Jonah Tong** (22), and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Plus six of the Top 30 per MLB: Clifford (4), Sproat (13), McLean (19), Ziegler (22), **Wilfredo Lara** (23), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26)...MLB Pipeline also considers Clifford the 87th-best farmhand in all of baseball.

LAST TIME OUT: Picked up his first win of the season on Tuesday night at Rome...Did not allow a run on three hits over a season-high five innings...Walked one and struck out a season-high eight...Tossed a season-high 91 pitches and 55 strikes (60.44%)... Relieved by RHP **Jake Stevenson** to start the bottom of the sixth inning with Brooklyn leading 6-0...Emperors would break up the shutout bid on a two-run home run by 2B **E.J. Exposito** with two out in the ninth...Cyclones went on to win, 6-2.

PROSPECT RADAR: After a stellar 2023 season, De La Cruz was deemed the New York Mets' No. 39 prospect entering the 2024 campaign by *Baseball America*.

WELCOME TO BROOKLYN: The 22-year-old joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie last year on August 22 and thrived over three starts...De La Cruz accumulated a 2-1 record with a 2.45 ERA (5 ER in 17.0 IP) with five walks and 17 strikeouts...The southpaw hurled quality starts in two of his three starts, including going all six innings in the lid-lifter of a doubleheader on August 31 at Greenville...After allowing a leadoff home run, De La Cruz retired 18 of the final 19 batters he faced, including sitting the last 11 down in order...The southpaw was credited with a complete game, the first for a Brooklyn pitcher since RHP **José Butto** accomplished the feat, tossing six innings in a seven-inning loss at Aberdeen in Game 1 of a twinbill on June 30, 2021...After making his SAL debut on August 23 at Asheville, De La Cruz ranked third in the circuit in WHIP (0.94), fifth in batting average against (.183), and sixth in ERA (2.65).

FELIPE FINISHES WITH A FLOURISH: De La Cruz racked up the strikeouts in bunches over his final month at Single-A...Over his final eight appearances (seven starts), De La Cruz paced the Florida State League and all Single-A players in strikeouts (57)... Struck out 8 more batters than Clearwater's LHP **Danny Wilkin-**son (49) who was second...De La Cruz went 1-2 with a 4.33 ERA (17 ER in 35.1 IP) with 18 walks (11.4 BB%) and 57 strikeouts (36.1%).

FLORIDA STATE FELIPE: De La Cruz was among the best strikeout artists in the Florida State League in 2023...Among FSL pitchers with 90.0 or more innings pitched, the 22-year-old led the circuit in strikeout rate (28.7%)...The southpaw also led the league in strikeouts-per-9 innings (11.36) and swinging strike rate (15.5%), while ranking 2nd in xFIP (3.68)...In 21 appearances (19 starts) with St. Lucie, De La Cruz was 3-6 with a 4.68 ERA (47 ER in 90.1 IP), 41 walks, and 114 strikeouts.
