### Jersey Shore BlueClaws (32-28/70-56) vs Aberdeen IronBirds (31-29/65-61)

Leidos Field at Ripken Stadium – Aberdeen, Maryland (opened 2002) RHP Casey Steward (4-2, 2.96) vs TBA Series: Game 1 of 6 (Aberdeen leads season series 12-9 of 27)

Last Time Out... Roc Riggio hit a grand slam in the sixth inning to blow open a 2-1 game and Hudson Valley topped the BlueClaws 6-2 on Sunday afternoon at ShoreTown Ballpark...Riggio's grand slam was the second hit by Hudson Valley in the series (Brendan Jones hit one on Thursday)...Aidan Miller went 5-5 in the loss.

Playoff Picture...The BlueClaws are in second place, 3.0 games behind first place Hudson Valley with six games left...Hudson Valley won the tie-breaker with their win on Sunday, so their magic number is three (should the BlueClaws go 6-0, they would need Hudson Valley to go 2-4 this week against Asheville in Wappingers Falls)...Last year, the BlueClaws trailed by six games on August 3<sup>rd</sup> and rallied to make the postseason on the final day...This year, the BlueClaws have been as many as 7.0 games back (after July 5<sup>th</sup> following a 5-9 start to the second half)

Welcome to Aberdeen...The BlueClaws are in Aberdeen for the final series of the regular season...Jersey Shore is 9-12 agianst the IronBirds this year and 4-8 at Ripken Stadium...The last series was a six-game series that they split ending July 28th in Lakewood...They next meet on April 8th, Opening Night at the Jersey Shore in 2025

Five for Aidan...Aidan Miller went 5-5 on Sunday, tying a BlueClaws record with five hits in a game (it has been done 11 times since 2001, including earlier this year by William Bergolla on June 9<sup>th</sup> at Greensboro)...Miller is 21-61 since August 14<sup>th</sup> with six doubles, two triples, two home runs, and 11 RBIs...Miller is the 16<sup>th</sup> Phillies first-round pick to play for the BlueClaws - he was taken 27th overall last year.

Mendez Mashing...Hendry Mendez had four hits on Saturday, his second four-hit game of the season (July 6th) and is 15-29 in his last eight games with two doubles and two triples...He had three hits on both August 25th and August 27th ...Further, since the start of July, Mendez is 48-142 (.338) with 14 doubles and both of his home runs...The 20 year old spent last year with Wisconsin (Brewers High-A) and was acquired from Milwaukee last November.

Hitting Hawkeye Keeps on Hitting...Keaton Anthony has two hits in six of his last 13 games (17-54)...He homered on both August 18th and 20th and is 30-93 (.322) with four doubles, a triple, three home runs, and 15 RBIs (and 10 multi-hit games) in his last 23 games played...The former Iowa

Hawkeye is hitting .335 with the BlueClaws adding 19 multi-hit games...He had a walk-off single on July 23rd against Aberdeen...He was hitting .322 in 44 games with Clearwater, adding four home runs and 21 RBIs, and drew 28 walks in 186 plate appearances while striking out only 28 times...He signed as an NDFA from the University of Iowa in 2023 after three years with the Hawkeyes.

Bennett Makes History...Pierce Bennett had a 3-run triple on Friday in an exciting week for him...He was intentionally walked with the bases loaded on Wednesday night after a series of events that included a mid-at bat pitching change rejected by the umpires following a second mound visit during his at bat...Bennett is the first MiLB player to be intentionally walked with the bases loaded since at least 2005...Since 1969, the following MLB players have beer intentionally walked with the bases loaded: Barry Bonds (with SF vs AZ in 1998), Josh Hamilton (with TEX vs TAM in 2008), and Corey Seager (with TEX vs LAA in 2022)...Mexican League player Abel Martinez was also intentionally walked with the bases loaded in 2005 for Laguna vs Tiajuana.

BlueClaws-a-Palooza...Sam Aldegheri, who began the year with the BlueClaws (6-5, 3.18 in 13 starts), made his big league debut with the Angels on Friday, becoming the 124<sup>th</sup> player to go From the Shore to the Show...His first pitch was thrown to C Logan O'Hoppe (2021 BC), hit by JP Crawford (2013-14 BC) and caught by CF Mickey Moniak (2017 BC)

Farquhar On Fire...Trent Farquhar has hit safely in 10 of his last 12 games, over which he is 16-52...Since joining the BlueClaws on July 20th, he has also drawn 14 walks and been hit by six pitches while adding 14 stolen bases...He had three hits on August 24th, his second three-hit game with the BlueClaws...Farquhar was hit by three pitches in his July 20th BlueClaws debut in Brooklyn, tying the team single-game record set last year by Nick Ward on 6/6 against Hudson Valley...Farquhar signed as a non-drafted free agent last year out of Michigan State.

King Felix of ShoreTown ... Felix Reyes has hit safely in eight of his last 10 games, going 15-41 with two doubles and two home runs...He had two hits on Wednesday and four hits on Sunday in Brooklyn...Seven of his eight home runs this year have come since Father's Day.

Welcome Back Bryan...SS Bryan Rincon was reinstated from the 60-day Injured List on Tuesday and is 0-10 with two walks in three games...The Phillies #10 prospect (MLB Pipeline) had been out since May 19th with a hamstring injury...Rincon was a 14th round pick in 2022 from Shaler Area HS in Pennsylvania.

Ware It... Bryson Ware hit a solo home run on Tuesday, his first as a BlueClaw, that broke a 1-1 tie in the fifth inning...He had two hits on Friday and is 19-48 since August 13th and hitting .310 since joining the BlueClaws on August 1st ... Ware has started games at 1B, 2B, 3B, and SS with the BlueClaws... With Clearwater, he started games at 1B, 2B, 3B, SS, LF, and CF...Ware was an 8th round pick in 2023 out of Auburn.

#### **Tie-Breaker Scenario** Hudson Valley holds the tiebreaker over the BlueClaws by virtue of taking four of six from Jersey Shore last week...Had the BlueClaws won on Sunday, they would have been one game out with the

On Pan... Wen-Hui Pan has allowed just three ER In 20 innings with the BlueClaws this year, adding 22 strikeouts against just seven walks... Pan threw a scoreless inning on Sunday and earned a save on August 17<sup>th</sup> against Winston-Salem at ShoreTown Ballpark...The 21 year old signed with the Phillies in January of 2023...He is the #20 prospect in the system per MLB Pipeline.

In the Second Half...Since the second half began on June 21th, Keaton Anthony is tops in the league in batting average at .335 among qualified hitters while third in on-base percentage at .398...Hendry Mendez is third in OPS at .866.

Going Going Gone ... The BlueClaws have hit 33 HRs in Lakewood and 40 on the road this season...Aidan Miller hit his 6<sup>th</sup> BlueClaws home run on September 1<sup>st</sup>...Bryson Ware homered, his first with Jersey Shore, on Tuesday...Felix Reyes and Emaarion Boyd hit back to back home runs on August 24th in Brooklyn, the first pair of back to back home runs this season by the BlueClaws... Jordan Dissin leads the team with nine and Leandro Pineda (now with Reading) and Schreffler each have eight.

The NEWClaws ... The BlueClaws roster entering today has just nine players that have been with the team since Opening Day: Ps Jack Dallas, Charles King, Gunner Mayer, and Danny Wilkinson, C Jordan Dissin, IF Felix Reves, and OFs Emaarion Boyd, Hendry Mendez, and Troy Schreffler.

Hitting Triple Digits ... A South Atlantic League starting pitcher has thrown 100 pitches nine times in a game this season eight are BlueClaws...Mitch Neunborn threw 108 over 6.2 innings on August 16<sup>th</sup>...Sam Aldegheri has done it three times (including 103 on June 13<sup>th</sup>), Jean Cabrera has done it three times (including a league-high 110 on Wednesday at Brooklyn), and Braeden Fausnaught has done it once...Cabrera's 110 pitches are the most by a BlueClaw since Nick Fanti threw 113 in two no-hitters in 2017 (7/17 vs CHA, 26 outs in a 5/6/17 nohitter at COL), not incluing Matt Russell, who threw 125 pitches in eight innings against ABD in 2022 but pitched three innings in April and the remaining five in June after the game was suspended.

Save Index...Daniel Harper (now with Reading) leads the BlueClaws with seven saves and earned his seventh on June 19th at Brooklyn...Andrew Walling (now with Reading) earned his sixth save of the year in the win on July 14<sup>th</sup>... Gunner Mayer has four while Jaydenn Estanista has three.

Walk-Off This Way ... The BlueClaws have three walk-off wins this year – July 23<sup>rd</sup> vs Abedeen (Keaton Anthony RBI single), July 9<sup>th</sup> against Hudson Valley (Emaarion Boyd 2run single) and April 5th against Aberdeen (Opening Night, Boyd scores on wild pitch)...They had eight walk-off wins in 2023, including one in their final regular season home game...On September 3<sup>rd</sup>, Felix Reyes hit a three-run walk-off home run to cap a four-run BlueClaws ninth inning comeback against Aberdeen...It was the first BlueClaws walk-off home run since Ben Pelletier hit one on August 15, 2019 against Delmarva.

The Comeback Claws...The BlueClaws erased a six-run deficit on August 20<sup>th</sup> at Brooklyn, trailing 8-2 and rallying to win 10-9 (their largest comeback win of the season)...The BlueClaws got a two-out, two-strike hit from Keaton Anthony and a two-strike RBI double from Felix Reyes on July 21<sup>st</sup> at Brooklyn to tie the game, that they would win 9-6 in 10 innings...Jersey Shore erased a 5-0 deficit on June 8th at Greensboro and a 4-0 deficit on June

15<sup>th</sup> to come back and beat Wilmington...On June 15<sup>th</sup>, Troy Schreffler doubled home two runs to tie the game and Justin Crawford gave the BlueClaws the lead with a line drive RBI single to centerfield...Their largest comeback win last year was six (5/24/23 at Aberdeen in a game they trailed 8-2 and won 12-10).

Just Grand... The BlueClaws hit three grand slams between 2021 and 2023, but they have three grand slams since May 30<sup>th</sup> – one by Justin Crawford (May 30<sup>th</sup>), one by Emaarion Boyd (June 9<sup>th</sup>), and one by Jordan Dissin (June 11<sup>th</sup>)...Boyd's home run was the second of his career while Dissin's was his sixth home run of the season.

Trying For Back to Back...The BlueClaws have only made the playoffs in back to back years once - in 2009 and 2010, both SAL Championship seasons...They have a chance to do so again this year after reaching the SAL Northern Division Championship Series last year.

Youth Is Served...Per Baseball America, the BlueClaws had five of the 25 youngest players in the South Atlantic League (based on Opening Day rosters of 360 players): William Bergolla (3rd youngest), Bryan Rincon (9<sup>th</sup>), Justin Crawford (11<sup>th</sup>), Hendry Mendez (17<sup>th</sup>), and Emmaarion Boyd (21<sup>st</sup>).

In the First Round ... Aidan Miller is the 16<sup>th</sup> former first-round pick to play for the BlueClaws and the fifth to play for the BlueClaws as a High-A team...(his ex-teammate Justin Crawford in 2024, Andrew Painter and Mick Abel in 2022 and Bryson Stott in 2021)... Since 2000, the only two Phillies first round picks not to play for the BlueClaws are Joe Savery (2007) and Aaron Nola (2014) plus 2023 first-round pick Aidan Miller, who is currently with Clearwater.

From The Shore to the Show...124 players have now gone From the Shore, to the Show including two this year (Sam Aldegheri, Angels and Ben Brown, Cubs)...Three debuted in 2023 – James McArthur with the Royals, Johan Rojas with the Phillies, and Orion Kerkering with the Phillies...Kerkering, who was with the BlueClaws from May 9<sup>th</sup> through July 6<sup>th</sup>, is the only player to play for the BlueClaws and Phillies in the same year...Aldegheri is the fastest player ever go advance, last pitching for the BlueClaws on July 6<sup>th</sup> and debuting on August 30<sup>th</sup>.

On the Staff...Greg Brodzinski returns to manage the BlueClaws in 2024 after leading the BlueClaws to the playoffs and a league-best 73-58 mark in 2023...Pitching coach Brad Bergesen is in Lakewood for a third time (2018 and 2022) and is joined as a pitching coach by first-year Phillies coach Matt Ellmyer...Hitting coach Adam Lind hit 200 big league home runs and is in his first year as a coach...Position coach Orlando Munoz is in his first year with the BlueClaws after managing the DSL Phillies since 2017...Development coach Beth Greenwood is the first BlueClaws female position coach and a member of Team USA Women's National Baseball Team.

Season Notes: Threw five scoreless innings with eight strikeouts to earn win on 8/28 vs HV...Earned win on 8/21 at BRK, allowing one hit over 5.2 scoreless innings with seven strikeouts...Threw a career-long seven scoreless innings on 7/23 vs ABD...Earned first BC win on 7/3 at WIL (5 IP, 2 R/1 ER)...Struck out nine over five innings, one run in Claws debut on 6/27 vs GBO...Joined the BlueClaws on 6/27 from Clearwater where he was 4-2, 3.38 in 12 games (10 starts) with 52 strikeouts and 19 walks in 50.2 innings pitched...Threw five scoreless innings with five strikeouts on 5/4 at Lakeland.

Career Notes: Made five appearances between the FCL Phillies (two scoreless innings in two games) and Clearwater (two runs in four innings in three games) in first professional season...First player the Phillies have drafted from D2 Washburn University...Notable baseball alumni include Dayey Lopes, who had a 16 year big league career, managed the Brewers (2000 – 2002) and was the Phillies 1B coach from 2007-2010, including for their 2008 World Series title...Has a twin brother named Calvin.
