TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves conclude a 13-game homestand today against the Montgomery Biscuits. This is the fourth of five series between the two clubs, the last coming at Riverwalk Stadium from August 22-17. The M-Braves another two-week homestand from August 29-September 10.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Drew Lugbauer recorded the first three-homer game in Trustmark Park history, leading the M-Braves to a 7-4 win. Luis De Avila tossed six shutout innings. The series is now even at three games apiece.

LAST TIME AGAINST THE BISCUITS: The Biscuits took three of five games from July 4-9 in a series that included two postponements due to rain. The M-Braves split a DH on Saturday to close out the series. In game two, the M-Braves got a combined shutout from Domingo Gonzalez, Hayden Harris, Daysbel Hernandez and Alec

YEAH, WE GOT PROSPECTS: The M-Braves had several players jump into the most recent prospect rankings on MLB Pipeline and now have nine Top-30 prospects on the roster.

The prospects include No. 11 INF Cal Conley, No. 12 OF Jesse Franklin V, No. 23 RHP Alan Rangel, No. 25 C Tyler Tolve, No. 26 LHP Luis De Avila, No. 27 INF Luke Waddell, No. 28 RHP Tyler Owens, No. 29 INF/OF Cody Milligan, No. 30 C Javier Valdes

THE HARTFORD BRAVES: On July 24, Atlanta announced a trade with the Colorado Rockies for RHP Pierce Johnson that sent two of Atlanta's top prospects in Double-A, RHP Victor Vodnik (No. 10) and RHP Tanner Gordon (No. 26), to the Rockies organization. Both were assigned to Double-A Hartford after the trade.

On August 1, Atlanta announced another trade with Colorado, sending M-Braves RHP Alec Barger for LHP Brad Hand, a three-time all-star. Barger was also assigned to Double-A Hartford after the trade.

REINFORCING OUR PITCHING: In response to the trades, the M-Braves received LHP Nick Margevicius from Triple-A Gwinnett and RHP Peyton Williams from High-A Rome on Tuesday.

TOP PITCHING STAFF: The M-Braves lead the Southern League, and rank 4th in Double-A, with a 3.94 ERA. The pitching staff has given up just 74 home runs, the fewest in Double-A. The M-Braves bullpen is 3rd in Double-A with a 3.58

RETURN OF THE PEARL CITY BOMBERS: The M-Braves rank T-3rd in the league and T-11th in Double-A with 114 homers in 100 games - 77 on the road, while their opponents have just 76 total home runs.

M-Braves opponents have just 22 home runs at Trustmark Park this season.

CAN'T CATCH A BREAK: The M-Braves have lost nine of their last 10 one-run games, all coming since June 18. The M-Braves are 7-14 since the All-Star Break.

WADDYYY: Luke Waddell is the league's active leader with a .294 batting average and ranks among the league leaders in OBP (.398, 4th).

COUNTIN' ON CAL: Cal Conley reached base in 17 of 18 games from July 15 to August 4 and just lost a seven-game hitting streak. Over the 18 games, Conley is hit .302 with a .413 OBP, one homer, three doubles, 10 walks, seven RBI.

JESSE'S STREAK: Jesse Franklin V is riding a 17game on-base streak with hits in 14 of those 17 games. Over the streak (July 16), he is batting .281 with two home runs, two doubles, 10 RBI and a .388 OBP.

SLUGBAUER MAKES MORE HISTORY: 1B Drew Lugbauer recorded his first career three-homer game and the first in Trustmark Park history on August 5 vs MTG, hitting his 107th minor league home run and his 66th in three seasons for the M-Braves. Lugbauer returned on July 19 from his second IL stint. He went on a 14-game hitting streak from June 1-July 23, batting .465 with 5 2B, 4 HR, 11 RBI, 8 BB, .558 OBP, and 1.418 OPS over the streak. It's the club's longest hitting streak this season.

Lugbauer is currently tied for the league lead with 20 home runs. On May 23, Lugbauer cranked a 117-mile-per-hour home run, ranking 5th among MLB players for hardest-hit balls.

The M-Braves all-time and single-season home run leader slugged his 50th career M-Braves home run on April 30 at Biloxi. Lugbauer has a club record, and Double-A franchise record 60 home runs over parts of three seasons. Lugbauer also has a club-record 173 RBI. He hit 18 homers in 2021 and led the Southern League and Braves minor league system with 28 homers in 2022.

**DE AVILA DELIVERS:** Luis De Avila delivered 11 hitless innings in two starts on July 17 and 23, earning SL Pitcher of the Week. The lefty delivered five solid starts in June, going 3-0 with a 1.61 ERA in 28.0 innings. He has allowed three earned runs in his last 22.2 innings. After a team-most 19 starts, De Avila ranks among the league leaders in ERA (2.95, 3rd), opponent average (.214, 4th) and WHIP (1.24, 4th).

EVEN STEPHENS: Landon Stephens is T-2nd in the league with 18 home runs and has 12 home runs since the start of June. He homered in three straight games from June 16-18 and has homered in two-straight, on four different oc-

**RETURN OF THE KING:** RHP Nolan Kingham returned to the M-Braves from Triple-A Gwinnett on Jully 25. In two starts, he allowed two runs in 11 innings and earned two wins. Kingham has pitched for the M-Braves in 2019, 2021 and 2022. In 25 games, 23 starts, for the M-Braves, Kingham is 11-8 with a 3.14 ERA in 137.2 innings.

GRAND SALAMI TIME: The M-Braves have a club record six grand slams, including the first-ever multi-grand slam game on June 16 at Pensacola (Cade Bunnell, Luke Waddell). Waddell hit grand slams on June 16 at Pensacola and July 1 at Biloxi.

# **TODAY'S GAME**

- The 22-year-old will make his fourth Double-A start and his second career start against Montgomery. Owens was added to the M-Braves roster on July 21, after appearing in 15 games (11 starts) for High-A Rome. Owens is the 14th different starting pitcher for the M-Braves this season.
- Owens was recently added to Atlanta's prospect rankings, coming in at No. 28 on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Prospect List.

### **LAST TIME OUT**

 In the series opener on Tuesday against Montgomery, Owens allowed one run on three hits in four innings. He walked none and struck out five.

- Owens was promoted to Mississippi from High-A Rome on July 14...with Rome, he
  was 0-5 with a 2.27 ERA (10 ER/39.2 IP), nine walks to 42 strikeouts over 15 games (11
  starts).
- Matched a career high with 5.0 innings of shutout ball at Greenville on July 7, walking one and striking out four, tossing a season-high 56 pitches.
- Combined with Rolddy Munoz for a three-hit shutout on June 18 against Hudson Valley going 4.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 4 SO

 Spent the season with Low-A Augusta, making 32 appearances (4 starts) for the Green Jackets, going 5-3 with a 5.20 ERA (36 ER/62.1 IP), 28 walks, 67 strikeouts, 5-for-7 in save chances

- Attended Trinity Catholic High School in Ocala, FL, and committed to play college baseball at the University of Florida before signing with the Braves for \$547,500 - the fifth-largest signing bonus given by the Braves in the 2019 draft.
- Had been committed to Florida State before flipping to coach Kevin O'Sullivan's
  Gators, was one of the hardest throwers available in the 2019 MLB draft, having had
  his fastball clocked at 98 miles-an-hour at a Perfect Game showcase in 2018.
- Missed much of his junior season of high school with a scapular imbalance that caused inflammation in his shoulder, he returned for the Celtics' playoff games despite being a bit rusty and on a low pitch count.
