TWIN BILL SWEEP The Portland Sea Dogs (3-3) swept the Reading Fightin Phils (3-5) in a twin bill on Saturday night. Portland took game one 9-2, while game two ended in a 5-4 victory. Portland launched six homers total across both games. Roman Anthony and Eddinson Paulino both smashed a homer in each game of the twin bill to account for four of the long balls while Nick Decker and Nick Yorke pitched in with one a piece. In game one of the doubleheader, Yorke (1) ignited the scoring with a two-run blast to right field in the top of the first to put Portland on the board first, 2-0. Reading countered in the bottom of the inning after Jose Rodriguez scored on a bases loaded balk. Anthony crushed his first homer of the season to center field to leadoff the third and extend the 3-0 lead. Paulino would record a two-run blast to mark his first of Double-A and make it 5-0, Portland. In the bottom of the fifth, William Simoneit hit a sacrifice fly to score Jim Haley. In the top of the sixth, Portland executed a double steal to extend the 6-2 lead after Max Ferguson (2) stole second base and Phillip Sikes (1) stole home. Decker blasted a three-run shot to right field to record his first of the season and secure the 9-2 win. In game two, Anthony launched the first pitch he saw to deep left and with an opposite field blast, the Sea Dogs took an early 1-0 lead. Reading countered in the bottom of the second with a two-run single off the bat of Haley to take the 2-1 lead. In the top of the fourth, Paulino cranked his second homer of the day to right field to tie the game at two apiece. Anthony worked a walk while Mickey Gasper came home to score on a wild pitch to regain the lead. Marcelo Mayer hit a single to center field to score a pair of runs and put Portland on top, 5-2. n the bottom of the fifth, Reading plated two but Portland held on to secure the 5-4 win.

**SEA DOGS STREAKS** Roman Anthony is currently riding a six-game on base streak and a three-game RBI streak coming into today. He has collected eight hits, three doubles, two homers, and two stolen bags to tally a .333 average. He ranks second across the Eastern League in slugging (.708) and fourth in OPS (1.093). Eddinson Paulino is also riding a three-game RBI streak with five over five games. Max ferguson is riding a three-game run streak after scoring five runs over five games. Marcelo Mayer is riding a six-game hitting streak after a pair of hits last night.

**HOME RUN PARTY** Portland launched six of their nine homers on the season between both games of the twin bill. Roman Anthony and Eddinson Paulino both blasted a home run apiece in each game while Nick Yorke and Nick Decker also chipped in with a homer each in game one of the doubleheader. With nine collectively, Portland now ranks second in the Eastern League just behind the Somerset Patriots who have 12 total.

**MAYER ON FIRE** Marcelo Mayer is currently riding a six-game hitting streak coming into today. The top prospect also ranks eighth across all Eastern League batters in average after accumulating a .348 average across six games. Across those six games, he has tallied six runs, eight hits, one double, one homer, four RBI and a pair of stolen bags.

**PROMISING PROSPECTS IN PORTLAND** The top three prospects in Boston's system (according to MLB.com and Baseball America) will begin the season in Portland with Marcelo Mayer (1), Roman Anthony (2), and Kyle Teel (3) headling the Opening Day Roster. Mayer appeared in 43 games with Portland in 2023 prior to a shoulder injury that ended his season in early August. Both Anthony and Teel were promoted to Portland for the final 10 games of last season. In their first glimpses of Double-A, Anthony hit .343 with four doubles, one homer, and three stolen bases while Teel recorded a .363 average with six doubles, two home runs, and three stolen bases. All three prospects were invited to Winter Weekend with the Red Sox in 2023 while also earning invitations to the inaugural Spring Breakout Game. Teel was named to the Spring Breakout First Team at the catcher position.

**ROSTER REVIEW** The Portland Sea Dogs will begin the season with 22 returning players from the 2023 season. Among the Opening Day roster, 9 players rank in the Red Sox top 30 prospect rankings according to MLB.com to enter the 2024 season.

**EXTENSION FOR EPPERSON** Chad Epperson will return for his third season as the Sea Dogs manager, becoming just one of four managers in franchise history to lead for three or more seasons. The Sea Dogs own a .540 winning percentage and 148-126 record with Epperson at the healm since he began in 2022.

**PITCHING PREVIEW:** RHP Angel Bastardo will take the mound for Portland in the final game of the series. Bastardo has faced Reading once in his career. In his final start of 2023 on September 6th, he tossed 5.0 innings allowing two runs on two hits while walking five and striking out three. He held the Fightins to a .207 average against him.

### Sea Dogs Coaching Staff

### **CHAD EPPERSON - MANAGER**

Epperson returns for his third season as Portland's manager. In 2023, he led the Sea Dogs to an overall record of 73-63 (.537). In 2022, Epperson led the Sea Dogs to a Double-A best 45-24 (.652) record in the second half, securing Portland's first post-season berth since 2014. Before managing the Sea Dogs, Epperson spent 12 seasons as the Red Sox Catching Coordinator. Prior to that, he spent his first eight seasons with the Red Sox as a manager or coach at the minor league level. A manager from 2004-09, he led his club to the playoffs in four straight campaigns beginning in 2006, including Single-A Salem in 2009. A back-to-back California League Manager of the Year with Lancaster from 2007-08, he also managed Wilmington to the playoffs in 2006. The Kentucky native managed Capital City in 2005 and Augusta in 2004 after spending two seasons (2002-03) as Sarasota's hitting coach. He also managed Cook County of the independent Frontier League in 2001. Epperson played nine years in the minor leagues in the Mets (1992-95), Red Sox (1997-99), and Orioles (2000) systems before his coaching career.

### **CHRIS HESS - HITTING COACH**

Chris returns to Portland after serving as the Greenville Drive's hitting coach in 2023. He was a coach for the Sea Dogs in 2022 and in Fort Myers during the 2021 season. During his time with the Drive, they ranked first in batting average (.259), hits (1,133), doubles (249), second in triples (36) and third in RBI (618) in the South Atlantic League. The Drive were also crowned South Atlantic League champions for the 2023 season. This year will mark Hess' fourth year in the Red Sox organization. Previously, he was an assistant coach at the University of Rhode Island, his alma mater, after three seasons playing in the New York Yankees organization (2017-19). Hess replaces former Hitting Coach Doug Clark who was promoted to be the Hitting Coach for the Triple-A Worcester Red Sox.

### SEAN ISAAC - PITCHING COACH

Isaac enters his second season as a coach in the Red Sox organization. He led the Sea Dogs to a 4.10 ERA and 30 saves in 2023. His pitching staff finished the year with 1,308 strikeouts, fifth most in the Eastern League. In 2022 he was the assistant pitching coach for the Nashville Sounds, the Triple-A affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers. Previously Isaac served as the Director of Player Development at UC-Santa Barbara. He spent three seasons (2016-2018) as a minor league pitcher in the Angels organization reaching the Triple-A level in 2017 and 2018. In 78 career games, he notched a 9-4 record with a 4.34 ERA. On May 2, 2018, he pitched the final

### **MICKEY JIANG - COACH**

The 2024 season will be Jiang's 18th with the Red Sox where he has held several different roles, including work as a consultant with International Scouting (2007-2012). He has been coaching in the Red Sox minor league system since 2009. He previously served as a coach in Portland from 2016-2017 and 2023. He served as a coach with Single-A Greenville in 2022 and with Fort Myers in 2012 and 2018-2021. A native of Taiwan, Jiang received his B.A. in International Trade from Tung-Hai University.

### **KYLE SASALA- COACH**

Kyle joins Portland's staff after previously working as the Associate Head Coach at Grove City College from 2016 – 2023. Sasala helped the 2023 Wolverines to a school-record 30 victories, along with a 16-4 conference record. The Wolverines also won 28 games in both 2021 and 2022. In 2019, Sasala assisted head coach Matt Royer in leading the Wolverines to a then-program record 28 victories. He served as the team's interim head coach during the Eastern College Athletic Conference Division III Championship Tournament, guiding Grove City to a runner-up finish. Portland's former coach in 2023, Pablo Cabrera, was promoted to Complex Defensive Coach based out of Fort Myers with the Red Sox.

### JUSTIN FROMETA - DEVELOPMENT COACH

Justin begins his second season as the Sea Dogs Development Coach and fourth in the Red Sox organization. He previously served as a Baseball Operations Associate and Player Development Associate for the Red Sox. He is a 2020 graduate of Tufts University.

### **BOBBY STACHURA - ATHLETIC TRAINER**

Stachura returns to Portland for his second season as the Sea Dogs' Athletic Trainer. Stachura has served as the Athletic Trainer for Single-A Greenville for the past four seasons. He started in the Red Sox organization in 2017 as the Athletic Trainer for the Lowell Spinners. He also spent four years as an athletic trainer at the University of Rhode Island. Stachura graduated with a B.S. in Athletic Training from Lasell College in 2013. He received his M.S. from the University of Rhode Island's Department of Kinesiology in 2015.

### DONNY GRESS- STRENGTH AND CONDITIONING COACH

After spending the last two seasons with the Greenville Drive, Donny Gress joins the Sea Dogs for the first time. Previously, Gress spent four years at the University of Kentucky, first as a graduate assistant (2018-2020), before becoming a coaching assistant with the Wildcats' Olympic Strength and Conditioning staff. Joe Hudson has been promoted to Worcester's Strength and Conditioning Coach after previously working with Portland in the same role in 2023.


