**THURSDAY'S RECAP:** The New Hampshire Fisher Cats lost to the Portland Sea Dogs 3-2 on Thursday afternoon from Hadlock Field. The Sea Dogs lead the series two games to none in the Fisher Cats first visit to Portland of the season. Starting pitcher **Sem Robberse** threw six innings matching a season-high and gave up three runs on five hits and one walk while striking out seven, one shy of his season-high, receiving the loss. Robberse gave up a pair of home runs, a solo home run to Nick Yorke in the fourth and a two-run go-ahead home run to Ceddanne Rafaela in the sixth to put Portland ahead for good. **Zac Cook** and **PK Morris** collected the lone RBIs of the game for New Hampshire. Cook lifted a sac fly in the second to open the scoring for the Fisher Cats and Morris delivered a tiebreaking RBI single in the sixth off Portland reliever Ryan Miller. **Miguel Hiraldo** recorded his eighth multi-hit game of the season with a game-high two hits. He is second on the team in multi-hit performances behind **Damiano Palmegiani** (9). New Hampshire outhit Portland on the afternoon seven to six but went 1-for-8 with runners in scoring position and stranded nine on base.

**CHUCKY CHEESE DALLAS: Chad Dallas** was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week after a dominant seven shutout inning, nine strikeout performance on Friday against Binghamton. It's the first time a Fisher Cat pitcher has been named with the weekly award since Max Castillo the week of April 8-17, 2022. Dallas's seven-inning start in his Fisher Cats debut was the longest start of his career.

**30 FOR NUMBER 2: Orelvis Martinez** drove in his 30<sup>th</sup> RBI of the season on Tuesday against Portland with an RBI single in the eighth. He is the third Eastern League hitter this season to drive in 30 or more RBIs behind Hartford's Hunter Goodman (43) and Erie's Colt Keith (35). 12 of Martinez's 20 hits this season have gone over the wall for home runs. His nine home runs this month ties a Fisher Cats record. Last season, Martinez had 23 RBIs in the month of May. This year, he has already 20 RBIs in May with seven games to go this month.

**'OBP' – ON BASE PALMEGIANI: Damiano Palmegiani** is in the top-10 of the Eastern League leaderboard in on-base percentage. The corner infielder is getting on-base at a .400 clip, eighth-best in the league. On Thursday, he collected another base hit and has now reached base in an impressive 31 of 36 games played this season.

YOU GOT THE CALL: Two Fisher Cats this week have received promotions to Triple-A Buffalo. Left-handed pitcher Jimmy Burnette was promoted on Tuesday and infielder Trevor Schwecke was promoted on Thursday. They are the third and fourth Fisher Cats to be promoted to Buffalo this month, along with left-handed pitcher Sean Mellen and infielders Luis De Los Santos. Prior to their call ups, Burnette had not allowed a run in six May outings and Schwecke recorded his first five-RBI game of his career with his second career grand slam on Sunday in game two of the doubleheader.

**WELCOME TO NEW HAMPSHIRE:** In corresponding moves, left-handed pitcher **Mason Fluharty** and infielder **Riley Tirotta** have both been received from High-A Vancouver. Fluharty, a 5<sup>th</sup> round pick by the Blue Jays out of Liberty in the 2022 Draft, posted a 0.59 ERA in 15.1 innings to start the season with 21 strikeouts over just five walks. Tirotta, a 12<sup>th</sup> round pick by the Blue Jays out of Dayton in the 2021 Draft, batted .303 with three home runs and 16 RBIs. This is both Fluharty and Tirotta's first stints at Double-A.

THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (May 26, 2010) – In an 11-6 win at New Britain, the Fisher Cats banged out 17 hits, including a franchise-tying record nine doubles. Jonathan Diaz went 4-for-5 with four doubles and three RBI. It's the only time a Fisher Cat player has had four doubles in one game. Kyle Drabek allowed two runs in seven innings for his sixth win.

 MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Toronto (26-25) dropped three of four at Tampa Bay, falling 6-3 last night. Alek Manoah went only three innings and gave up five runs and five walks while striking out six in the loss. Trailing by five in the ninth, the Blue Jays put up two but could not get any closer. Toronto has lost eight of its last 10 and will visit the Twins for a three-game series ...Triple-A Buffalo (23-25) won 12-2 at Lehigh Valley. Rafael Lantigua went 3-for-3 with 3 RBI and 3 walks. Yosver Zulueta got the win after two shutout innings and three strikeouts of relief. Jimmy Burnette faced the minimum in his Triple-A debut....High-A Vancouver (21-19) lost 7-3 at Spokane...Class A Dunedin's (22-18) game with Fort Myers was suspended in the 3<sup>rd</sup> with Fort Myers leading 2-1.

COMING UP: New Hampshire continues its six-game road trip at Portland this week, their first of two visits to the Sea Dogs this season. The next home game will be Tuesday, May 30 when the Fisher Cats host Reading.
