GRAY, CONINE LEAD JACKSONVILLE PAST BULLS

Tristan Gray homered and Griffin Conine drove in a run and threw out two runners on the bases on Tuesday to lead the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp to a 5-3 victory over the Durham Bulls. Jonathan Davis led off the game with a single and two batters later Dane Myers singled. In his first game back in Durham, Tristan Gray (1) blasted a three-run shot and Jacksonville never looked back, adding a run in the third and fifth to take a 5-0 lead. Durham plated three in the fifth but couldn't muster any more offense.

SHRIMP ON THE POND

Through four games in 2024, Jacksonville has mustered only 11 runs, in large part due to the club's struggles with runners in scoring position. Thus far during the 2024 campaign, the Jumbo Shrimp are a woeful 4-for-35 (.114/.256/.229/.485) hitting with runners in scoring position, stranding a total of 29 runners. In 2023, Jacksonville hit just .247/.336/.400/.736 with runners in scoring position, figures that respectively ranked 27th, 29th, 27th and 29th in Triple-A.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU?

Daren Brown returns in 2024 as Jacksonville's manager for the third straight season. A native of Holdenville, Okla., Brown holds a 1,283-1,271 (.502) record as a minor league manager. In 2022, Brown's first season with Jacksonville, he piloted the Jumbo Shrimp to an 80-69 (.537) record, placing third in the IL East. Brown also juggled a franchise-record 79 players in 2022, including a Jacksonville high for starting pitchers (25). The Jumbo Shrimp followed that up with a 70-79 (.470) record in 2023, with Brown utilizing a franchise-record 44 different pitchers throughout the campaign.

BOMBS A-GRAY

With his first inning three-run home run last night against Durham, **Tristan Gray** hit the first big fly of 2024 for Jacksonville. Over the last two years, Gray has hit 60+ home runs (33 in '22 and 30 in '23). The Jumbo Shrimp finished in the bottom of the IL in home runs last year (T-15, 160). Historically, Jacksonville has clobbered more home runs on the road over the last several seasons (82 vs 78'23, 109 vs 74 '22 and 81 vs 55 '21). Jacksonville's highest home run total for a player since 2021 was **Jerar Encarnacion's** 26 in 2023.

TROY MEETS WORLD

Jumbo Shrimp first baseman **Troy Johnston** is coming off an extraordinary season that saw him earn Marlins Minor League Player of the Year. Johnston finished the season leading all of Minor League Baseball in RBIs (116) while ranking fourth in extra-base hits (67), ninth in hits (157), tied for 10th in runs (102), 13th in OPS (.948), tied for 15th in doubles (36) and 17th in slugging percentage (.549). Over 134 games between Jacksonville and Double-Pensacola, Johnston slashed .307/.399/.549/.948 with 26 home runs and 24 stolen bases, becoming the first Marlins minor leaguer since 2008 to post a season with at least 20 homers and 20 steals.

DANE TIME

Originally selected by the Detroit Tigers as a pitcher back in 2017, **Dane Myers** converted to a full-time position player in 2021. The Katy, Texas native batted .292/.371/.442/.813 in 45 games in 2021 and then .267/.315/.489/.804 between Double-A Erie and Triple-A Toledo in 2022 before the Marlins selected him in the minor league phase of that winter's Rule 5 draft. In 2023, Myers unlocked a new level, hitting .316/.406/.489/.895 between Jacksonville and Double-A Pensacola while also making his major league debut with Miami. In Spring Training entering this season, Myers hit .412/.474/.735/1.209 with two doubles, three home runs, five RBIs, four stolen bases and seven runs scored in 17 games.

BACK TO WINNING PLEASE?

Thanks to a 75-55 (.577) record in 2021 and an 80-69 (.537) mark in 2022, Jacksonville collected back-to-back winning seasons for the first time since 2013-14. In 2023, though, the Jumbo Shrimp finished just 70-79 (.470) to snap their run of winning records. Jacksonville finished the first half of the season with the International League's worst record at 32-42 (-51 run differential) before rebounding with a 38-37 (.507) in the season's second half (-23 run differential).

SHRIMP BITES

Despite a 5-3 win last night against Durham, the Jumbo Shrimp struggled against the Bulls in 2023 going 6-12 with a 6.39 team ERA. On the flip side, Jacksonville slashed .220/.299/.382/.681 with 160 K's against Durham hurlers.

ABOUT DARREN

-McCaughan was originally selected by the Seattle Mariners in the 12th round of the 2017 draft out of Long Beach State. McCaughan made his major league debut for the Mariners on July 21,2021 by pitching 5.0 innings of one-run ball at Coors Field against the Colorado

-On February 9, 2024, two days after being designated for assignment, McCaughan was dealt to the Marlins in exchange for cash considerations.

-A terrific collegiate pitcher, McCaughan earned Big West Pitcher of the Year following both his sophomore (2016) and junior (2017) seasons at Long Beach State. He also became the first Long Beach State pitcher since Jered Weaver (2003-04) to be receive multiple All-American honors in consecutive seasons.

-With 414 strikeouts in 84 starts with Triple-A Tacoma, McCaughan is the "Rainiers" all-time strikeout leader (during Seattle affiliation, since 1995), and has accumulated the third-most strikeouts in franchise history. Ron Herbel (443 K) and Steve Luebber (431 K) from the 1960s and 70s remain the only hurlers who've fanned more batters than McCaughan during Tacoma's Triple-A history (since 1960).

2024 SEASON

-Tabbed as Opening Day starter for Jacksonville, tossed six innings and struck out four en route to 5-4 win over Gwinnett.

2023 SEASON

-In 12 home starts for Tacoma, McCaughan went 4-1, allowing 31 R, 25 ER on 55 hits in 67.2 innings for a 3.33 ERA

-Held opponents to a .218 batting average when pitching at home.

-Led all Tacoma pitchers in IP (139.0), starts (25), complete games (T-1st, 1) and strikeouts (130).

2022 SEASON

-Led Tacoma pitching staff in starts (28), IP (154.1) and strikeouts (141).

-In night games, he totaled 116.1 innings with 107 strikeouts to just 31 walks and held opponents to a .215 batting average

-Held left-handed hitters to a .213 batting average and notched 76 strikeouts..

2021 SEASON

-McCaughan made his major league debut for the Mariners on July 21, 2021 with 5.0 innings of one-run ball in a game against the Colorado Rockies at Coors Field. He did not allow a hit and also did not strike out a batter. He walked three Rockies hitters in a 6-3 Mariners' loss.

-In Triple-A, left-handed batters posted a .779 OPS against him in 252 plate appearances. Right-handed hitters compiled a .699 OPS against McCaughan in 221 plate appearances.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-McCaughan majored in civil engineering in college.

-An excellent all-around player in high school, McCaughan batted .371 during his senior
