TODAY'S GAME: The Curve continue a six-game series with the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, the teams will meet a total of 12 times this season.

LAST TIME OUT: Altoona overcame a pair of early deficits and held on for an 8-7 win to even the series with New Hampshire. Brendt Citta had 3 hits and Henry Davis picked up his first multi-hit game with the Curve in a 12-hit attack.

A GREAT START: Matt Fraizer knocked Altoona's second lead-off homer of the season on Thursday, June 23 at New Hampshire. Previously, Nick Gonzales homered on the game's first pitch on April 29 at Akron. It marked the 33rd time in franchise history that Altoona has hit a lead-off homer. Jonah Davis knocked a pair of them in 2021 for the Curve.

THAT'S ODD: With Wednesday's walk-off loss at New Hampshire, Altoona has lost 3 games in walk-off fashion this season. RHP J.C. Flowers has been on the mound in all three defeats: May 28 at Harrisburg, June 9 at Reading and June 22 at New Hampshire.

BIG LEAGUE CURVE: With 2019-21 Curve OF Bligh Madris became the 194th alumni head to the majors after their time in Curve, PA with his major league debut on Monday, June 20 against the Chicago Cubs. Madris became the 11th alumni to debut this season, joining Diego Castillo, Beau Sulser, Jack Suwinski, Cam Alldred, Cal Mitchell, Yerry De Los Santos, Canaan Smith-Njigba, Jason Delay, Liover Peguero and New Hamp. Cam Vieaux. In 2016 and 2018 the Curve had 14 players make their debut, a figure that could easily fall by the time the 2022 season wraps up.

Curve INF Liover Peguero became the third player to be recalled directly to the major league roster on Friday, June 17 when INF Tucupita

Marcano went on the COVID IL on short notice. Peguero arrived in Pittsburgh in time for first pitch and made his major league debut on Satur
Binghamton day against San Francisco going 1-for-3 with a walk. He became the first Pirate born in the 21st century to suit up for Pittsburgh.

SHACKDADDY: Curve INF Aaron Shackelford picked up his first career multi-homer game on Friday, June 17 against Erie, Shackelford's two-run homer in the fifth inning traveled approximately 462 feet. It was the second time this season that the Curve had a multi-homer game (Sabol, May 17 vs Richmond) and the 115th in franchise history. The 2021 Curve had six multi-homer games with three of them coming from Mason Martin.

ACE OUT, ACE IN: Prior to Thursday's game against Erie, the Curve announced the promotion of RHP Mike Burrows to Triple-A Indianapolis. Ranked as the No. 11 prospect in the Pirates Minor League System by MLB.com, Burrows was unscored upon in six of his starts this year and allowed 2 runs or fewer in 9-of-his-12 starts. At the time of his promotion he ranked: 5th in ERA (2.94), 6th in K (69), 5th in BAA (.199), 9th in WHIP (1.10), T-1st in GS (12) and was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on May 30.

In his place, Altoona activated RHP Quinn Priester from the IL, ranked as the No. 4 prospect in the Pirates system by MLB.com. With Priester's activation, the Curve have the 2019 and 2021 Pirates first round selections on the active roster. Priester made his team debut on Sunday, June 19 against Erie with 3.0 scoreless innings.

ALVY'S BIG START: Andres Alvarez picked up a career-high 5 RBI in Altoona's 13-12 win over Bowie on Thursday, June 2. After an RBI single and an RBI triple in the second inning, Alvarez smashed a go-ahead 3-run homer in the 8th inning to lead the Curve to a win. Through 44 games Alvarez has set a new career-high with a team-best 10 home runs and 27 RBI. His .530 slugging percentage ranks 7th in the Eastern League

LET'S HIT: The Curve have picked up at least 10 hits in 15-of-their-35 last games. Altoona has had 10 or more hits in a game 22 times this season, most in the Eastern League. The Curve lead the Eastern League in team batting average (.251) and total hits (560); they hold a 25-hit lead over the next highest team in the league (Bowie).

NO LEAD IS SAFE: Altoona has held a lead after 5 innings in 33 of 67 games played this season and hold an 23-10 record in those games. Since May 17, the Curve are 12-1 when they hold a lead after 5 innings.

TROUBLE WITH THE LONG BALL: Altoona pitchers have surrendered 72 home runs on the season, tied for 25th-most by a pitching staff in minor league baseball and fourth-most in the Eastern League behind Hartford (91). The Curve have allowed a home run in 41 of 67 games.

THE 'FISHER KITTIES: Managed by Cesar Martin in his second season, the Fisher Cats have one member of the Blue Jays 40-man roster in RHP Hagen Danner. Top prospects in Manchester include INF Orelvis Martinez (#2), RHP Adam Kloffenstein (#11), RHP Hagen Danner (#17), RHP Trent Palmer (#23), RHP Joey Murray (#24), OF Sebastian Espino (#25), RHP Hayden Juenger (#26) and INF Spencer Horwitz (#30).

THE FIRST TOSSER: Luis Quinones takes the ball on Saturday night. A 34th round pick by the Jays in 2019 out of San Jacinto JC in Texas, Quinones hails from Arecibo in Puerto Rico. Quinones also doubles as the Fisher Cats' team barber, something he has done since he was in middle school. Quinones is 2-5 with a 4.86 ERA (27 ER / 50.0 IP) in 13 career starts for New Hampshire.

1999 - Adam Hyzdu collects 7 RBIs with the help of a grand slam and a second homer in a 9-3 win at New Britain, a single-game record that would stand for over a decade until Alex Pressley drove in 8 in 2010

2004 - Nate McLouth extends his then-record on-base streak to 30 games after going 2-2 during a 6-4 win at Erie. His streak ends the next day. He compiled another 30-plus on-base streak later in the season.

Bradenton's no-hitter was the first he's ever been part of in his life... Completed his rehab assignment on 6/14 with Greensboro: allowed five runs on six hits in 2.2 innings...

2021: Entered the season ranked by Baseball America and MLB Pipeline as the fourth-best prospect in the Pirates system...Was also ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 58 prospect in all of baseball and the No. 17 right-handed pitching prospect... Was listed as having the "Best Curveball" in the Pirates minor league system by *Baseball America* entering the 2021 campaign... Was a non-roster invitee to Pirates Spring Training where he made two appearances and allowed one earned run in 1.1 innings pitched... Spent the entire season in Greensboro's rotation, went 7-4 with a 3.04 ERA in 20 starts... His 3.04 ERA was the second-best mark among Pirates minor leaguers (minimum 90.0 IP) behind Bradenton's Adrian Florencio (2.46)... CURVE CUTS: Charles Quinn Priester... Was committed to play collegiately at Texas Christian University before his selection in the 2019 draft... Signed for a bonus of \$3,400,000 by Pirates scout Anthony Wycklendt... Is a 2019 graduate of Cary-Grove (IL) High School, where he posted an 8-2 record and 1.00 ERA as a senior... Was named the 2018-19 Gatorade Illinois Player-of-the-Year... Was a two-sport athlete in high school; also played wide receiver and defensive back on the high school's football team that went 14-0 and won a Class 6A state high scriool's lookbalt team that went 14-0 and won a class of state championship in 2018 where he caught a 3-yard touchdown pass in the championship game against Crete-Monee HS... Played quarterback as an underclassmen before moving to receiver during his senior year of high school...
