### LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox dropped their first home series of the season in an 8-7 defeat to Richmond on Sunday afternoon. It's also the first time they have lost five of six in a series this season. Richmond outscored Bowie six runs to two in the final four innings to pull away with the win. John Rhodes collected three hits on the afternoon while Dylan Beavers and Anthony Servideo homered for the Baysox. Reliever Ryan Hennen took the loss after giving up the go-ahead runs in the eighth on a two-run homer by Jimmy Glowenke.

### STRUGGLES IN MAY

After batting a league-best .256 in the month of April, Bowie has batted a league-worst .210 in the month of May. Bowie scored the most runs in the league in the month of April (118) but have scored the third-fewest runs (88) in the month of May. The Baysox have struck out the third most times this month (224).

### LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF **Dylan Beavers** is getting hot at the right time for the Baysox. The Orioles No. 7 prospect belted his fourth homer in eight games with a three-run shot on Sunday against Richmond. The 22-year-old has five homers this month and seven on the season, which is one shy of matching the team-lead. After hitting just two homers in his first 34 Double-A games last year, Beavers has seven in his first 38 contests to start this season.

### BASALLO IS HOT

Over his last five games, C **Samuel Basallo** is batting .400 (8-for-20) with two homers, a double and six RBI and an OPS of 1.205. On Friday against Richmond, Basallo blasted a 392 foot, 115 mph three-run laser over the right field wall, his second homer of the series. After posting an OBP of just .276 in April, Basallo has posted an OBP of .353 in the month of May.

### TOP OF THE LEADERBOARD

OF **Jud Fabian** has six homers in the month of the May, which is tied for the league-lead with Harrisburg's Brady House. The Orioles No. 12 prospect's 15 RBI this month is tied for the fifth in the league....1B **TT Bowens** is tied for sixth in the Eastern League in RBI with 27....C **Samuel Basallo** has 44 hits on the season, good for sixth best in the circuit...OF **Dylan Beavers** owns an OPS of .899, which is fifth-best in the league.

### BRNOVICH ON THE BUMP

RHP **Kyle Brnovich** makes his fourth start of the season and his ninth overall appearance. After appearing out of the bullpen as a long reliever the last five outings, this will be the right-hander's first start since April 21 vs Altoona. In his last appearance vs Richmond last Wednesday, Brnovich struck out five over four innings but gave up a season-high five runs on five hits, including three homers. In three starts this season, Brnovich has a 2.08 ERA, a 0.92 WHIP with opponents batting .136 against him. This will be Brnovich's fourth career appearance vs Somerset.

### PREVIEWING THE PATRIOTS

Entering this week, the Somerset Patriots are fourth in the Northeast Division at 22-23. The Double-A affiliate of the Yankees most recently took three of seven at New Hampshire but have won two of their last three. Nine of the Yankees' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, are on the active roster- OF Spencer Jones (No. 2), LHP Brock Selvidge (No. 10), C/1B Ben Rice (No. 12), C Agustin Ramirez (No. 20), RHP Zach Messinger (No. 21), RHP Trystan Vrieling (No. 22), RHP Jack Neely (No. 24), RHP Danny Watson (No. 27), and IF Benjamin Cowles (No. 29).

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP Brock Selvidge makes his ninth start of the regular season for the Patriots. The 21-year-old most recently pitched five innings of two run ball with six strikeouts over a season-high five walks at New Hampshire last Wednesday. The Yankees No. 10 prospect started the season brilliantly with a 1.71 ERA in the month of April but has posted a 4.30 ERA in four May starts. Selvidge is in his first season at Double-A after spending all of last year in High-A Hudson Valley, where he struck out 137 batters over 127.2 innings.

**Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB (91-95), Changeup (82-85), Curveball (81-85), Slider (82-86)  
**Acquired from LAA in Dylan Bundy deal, which included BAL RHP Kyle Bradish and BOW RHP Zach Peek Returns for his third stint with Baysox. First full healthy season since 2021.**

**2024:** Makes his first start since 4/21 vs ALT, where he struck out season-high eight in 5.0 scoreless innings. Was used as a long reliever for last five outings. Holds a 2.08 ERA as a starter in three starts this season. Owns a 4.76 ERA on the road in three road outings. Gave up season-high 5 ER on 5 H (3 HR) in 4.0 IP in most recent outing on 5/22 vs RIC. In last road start, threw 4.2 shutout IP with 6 K to pick up win on 5/16 @ BNG. Named to Bowie Opening Day roster.

**2023:** Began season with FCL Orioles on a rehab assignment after recovering from Tommy John surgery. Made four rehab appearances between FCL Orioles, Single-A Delmarva and High-A Aberdeen before being sent to Double-A Bowie on July 25. Made four appearances (two starts) with Baysox and posted a 7.71 ERA in 14 innings, struck out 19 and gave up five homers.

**2022:** Began season with Triple-A Norfolk. Made two four-inning starts in April before suffering a right elbow injury. Underwent successful Tommy John surgery in May and missed rest of the season.

**2021:** Began first full season in Orioles system after trade. Started year in High-A Aberdeen and struck out 48 batters over 34.1 innings to an ERA of 2.36. Earned promotion to Double-A Bowie on June 22. Went five innings in six of his 11 starts and finished season with 75 K over 60.2 IP and an ERA of 3.86.

**2019:** Did not pitch a game while in LAA organization. Traded to BAL on Dec. 4, 2019, along with RHP Kyle Bradish, RHP Zach Peek, and RHP Isaac Mattson for RHP Dylan Bundy.

**Personal:** Drafted in the 8th round of the 2019 MLB Draft by the Los Angeles Angels out of Elon University. Pitched three seasons at Elon and was named a Consensus All-American in 2018. Struck out 360 batters in 281 career collegiate innings.

During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie’s “Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake” identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



### CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the “Chesapeake Baysox.” This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George’s Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



### BOWIE PIT BEEF

The “Bowie Pit Beef” is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore’s east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.



## COACHING STAFF

### ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization’s Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

### AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

### JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach
