FRIDAY: Oscar De La Cruz did not allow a fit through the first five and a third innings before Tanner Nishioka's homer tied the game at 1. Portland would take the lead in the seventh and tack on 2 more runs in the 8th to make it 4-1 as the Ponies would go on to lose by that final and drop their 6th straight game.

DE LA CRUZ CRUISING: Ponies RHP Oscar De La Cruz was outstanding going six and two thirds innings giving up 4 hits and 2 runs while striking out 5. De La Cruz didn't allow a baserunner until the 5th inning in what was his longest appearance of the year. In this one start, De La Cruz lowered his ERA from 14.09 to 8.28.

STARTING EXCELLENCE. Between Cole Gordon and De La Cruz the Ponies starting pitchers have allowed only two runs over 12.2 IP over the past two nights. Gordon allowed 1 run on three hits over six innings Thursday and De La Cruz went allowed two runs over six and two thirds innings Friday.

JEFF MCNEIL BOBBLEHEAD: Tonight is Jeff McNeil bobblehead night at Mirabito Stadium. McNeil spent parts of three seasons in Binghamton playing 64 games and hitting .315 with 15 HR and 45 RBI during his AA career. During his 2018 season McNeil started in Binghamton and went on to make his New York Mets debut while also being named an organizational all-star. In 2019 McNeil made his first MLB All-Star game appearance.

9TH INNING RALLIES: The last two nights the Ponies have trailed 4-0 and 4-1 respectively in the ninth inning. In each game, they have brought the tying run to the plate but fell short by a 4-1 tally on both nights.

U.S. OPEN GOLF : Tonight's starting pitcher Luc Rennie was drafted out of Torrey Pines High School in San Diego, CA. Torrey Pines Golf Course is currently hosting its 2nd U.S. Open tournament in course history.

LEADING THE PACK: Sea Dogs OF Joey Meneses hit an RBI double in the 8th inning putting himself at the top of the AA Northeast league leaderboard with 36 RBI. Portland RHP Jose Adames also sits atop the league leaderboard with 10 saves in 11 saves opportunities

HIGH SCHOOL TEAMMATES: Before Sea Dogs INF Triston Casas and Rumble Ponies INF were regarded as highly ranked prospects in their organizations, the two were teammates at American Heritage high school in Plantation, Florida.
