**Tonight's Game:** It's game three of a six-game series between the Nashville Sounds and St. Paul Saints. The Saints rallied to take game two 5-3 after a three-run eighth. Right-hander Janson Junk starts for the Sounds, facing St. Paul's Brent Headrick.

**Janson Junk:** 27-year-old Janson Junk makes his fourth start with the Sounds. The right-hander is 2-1 with a 1.31 ERA (20.2 IP/3 ER) through five total appearances in Nashville. He's also made a start with Milwaukee this season (0-1, 7.71 ERA). Junk took his first loss as a Sound on April 27 vs. Omaha. He allowed two runs (both earned) on five hits and a walk while striking out three Storm Chasers. Among International League pitchers to have thrown at least 20 innings this season, Junk has the lowest ERA. Junk was acquired by Milwaukee in the trade that sent Hunter Renfroe to the Angels. The Seattle Yankee-university product was originally selected in the 22nd round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft by the Yankees.

**Brent Headrick:** 25-year-old Brent Headrick makes his sixth appearance of 2023 and second start for St. Paul this evening. He's 0-0 with a 6.00 ERA (9.0 IP/6 ER) for the Saints and has a 3.24 ERA (8.1 IP/3 ER) in three relief outings with the Twins. The southpaw chewed up five innings in Minnesota's 12-6 loss to New York-AL on April 26, holding the Bronx Bombers to three hits and two runs with eight strikeouts. Headrick held Indianapolis to a run in five innings in his last appearance with St. Paul on April 11. Tabbed as the No. 25 prospect in the Twins system by MLB Pipeline, Headrick was drafted by Minnesota in the ninth round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Illinois State University.

**2023 Standings:** The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in 2023: First: 1, Second: 6, Third: 2, Fourth: 2, Fifth: 15, Sixth: 2, Seventh: 0, Eighth: 0, Ninth: 0, Tenth: 0.

**The Chosen One:** Keston Hiura extended his hitting streak to 10 games last night and is batting .486 (17-for-35) with six runs, five doubles, three homers and 13 RBI during the streak. It is currently the longest active Sounds hitting streak and second-longest on the season. He leads the Brewers minor league system with 10 homers, 26 RBI, .714 slugging percentage, 1.102 OPS, 30 hits, 15 extra-base hits and 65 total bases. Hiura ranks among league leaders in homers (T-3rd), SLG (5th), RBI (T-5th), OPS (5th), extra-base hits (T-5th) and total bases (5th).

**The Jedi Knights:** The Sounds pitching staff holds the second-lowest ERA in the league at 3.66, trailing only Norfolk's mark of 3.62 entering the day. Nashville leads the circuit in shutouts (4) and WHIP (1.31). While Sounds starters have the seventh-best ERA in Triple-A and the fifth-best in the IL, the bullpen boasts the only sub-3.00 ERA at 2.92 (142.0 IP/46 ER).

**Gets On Base, He Does:** Abraham Toro extended his on-base streak to 21 games with three walks yesterday. He and teammate Jon Singleton trail only Colton Cowser of Norfolk for the longest on-base streak in the league. Toro is batting .288 (23-for-80) with 11 RBI and 13 walks during the 21-game streak which began on April 4.

**This Is The Way:** Jon Singleton extended his on-base streak to 22 games with a RBI single last night. Like his teammate Abraham Toro, Singleton holds the second-longest on-base streak in the IL. The infielder is batting .247 (18-for-73) with seven runs, 12 RBI and 22 walks since the streak began in game two of a doubleheader on April 6.

**Do or Do Not. There Is No Try:** Sounds reliever Ethan Small set a new season-high with six strikeouts over three innings in relief, the most by a Sounds reliever since Lucas Erceg struck out six against Gwinnett on August 13, 2022. Over his last five appearances (9.1 IP), Small has held opponents to three hits and three walks for a 0.64 WHIP and .100 opponent batting average.

**Welcome Young Padawans:** Reliever Ryan Middendorf and infielder Isaac Collins became the first two Shuckers to get the move up to Nashville with yesterday's transactions. Middendorf pitched the seventh in his Triple-A debut on Tuesday while Collins played in left field yesterday in his Triple-A debut.

**The Rebel Alliance:** Nashville currently has four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 9 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 13 prospect. Right-hander Gus Varland is the No. 25 prospect, currently on MLB rehab assignment.

**Jedi Master:** Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022, 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 615-531 record during an eight-season span.

**LAST OUTING:** Junk last appeared on April 27 vs. Omaha, taking the loss in Nashville's 2-1 defeat. The right-hander allowed two runs on five hits, including one home run, over 5.0 innings. He walked one and struck out three. Despite the loss, Junk's ERA rose to just 1.31 (20.2 IP/3 ER).
