The Fisher Cats are now 1-7 in extra-inning games this season. New Hampshire failed to score in the top of the 10 th and Hartford managed to load the bases with no outs and left-hander Mason Fluharty on the mound in the bottom of the 10 th . Hartford's Kyle Datres grounded a ball underneath the backhanded glove of third baseman Orelvis Martinez , giving the Yard Goats the walk-off win in front of a home crowd of 6,739. The Fisher Cats outhit the Yard Goats 14 to 12 and scored first with a pair of runs in the first inning but fell behind by as many as three runs, trailing 6-3 heading into the sixth. Miguel Hiraldo drove in a run with a base-hit in the sixth, part of a 3-for-5 night at the plate for the Fisher Cats second baseman. In the seventh, Rainer Nunez grounded an RBI single into left to make it a 6-5 game before Will Robertson drove in the tying run with a double down the left-field line to even the score 6-6. Signed by Blue Jays after a great showing with the Missoula PaddleHeads, an independent team in the Pioneer League. Had been working prior to that as a groundkeeper for Cal Baptist. Went 4-1 for Dunedin in six games before being promoted to Vancouver, where he went 3-0 in nine games (two starts). Struck out 46 over 50.2 innings for Dunedin (A) and Vancouver (A+)

2019: Bash logged a 1.98 ERA as California Baptist's Sunday starter and also played some third base. Appeared in 14 games, all in relief for Angels AZL club with a 1-1 record and 2.81 ERA.
