TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER: The Curve hook up for another series with the Akron RubberDucks, who took 4-of-6 games from the Curve in the first full week of the season. Akron is loaded with returners like RHP Aaron Davenport and Tommy Mace in the rotation. INF Travis Bazzana, the No. 1 overall pick in 2024 out of Oregon State, highlights their prospect group. Bazzana was born in Austrailia and made history with Chase Burns (Italy, selected No.2 overall by Cincinnati) as the first pair to be born overseas and selected at the top of the draft.

On the mound, Aaron Davenport brings those long beautiful blonde locks back to PNG Field. Davenport makes his second start against the Curve this season where he fired 5.0 scoreless innings on April 12. Davenport has made 5 career appearances against Altoona and gone 1-0 with a 2.67 ERA and 21 strikeouts in 27.0 innings. He went 7-4 with a 2.85 ERA in 27 games, 26 starts last season. Davenport hails from Kirkland, WA and was Cleveland's 6th round pick in 2021 out of the University of Hawaii, his older brother, Adam, pitched for the University of Washington.

JEBBING: Utilityman Mitch Jebb has a hit in 7 straight games, during which he's batted .462 (12-for-26) with 4 BB and 4-4 SB.

SAMMY SLAMS: Outfielder Sammy Siani has reached in 11 straight games, matching the longest stretch of his Double-A career. Since April 16, he's batting .326/.420/.535 with a .955 OPS, 2 2B, 2 3B, 1 HR, 12 RBI and 6-6 SB.

SCAN THIS BARCODE FOR OUTS: Lefty Hunter Barco has tossed 20.2 consecutive scoreless innings to begin the season, the longest stretch to begin a season since Roansy Contreras tossed 18.2 scoreless to begin the 2021 season. The longest scoreless streak in franchise history belongs to lefty **Jared Lakind** who threw 25.1 scoreless innings during the 2016 season.

Barco was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week for the week of April 21-27 after striking out 16 batters in 7.2 innings across two outings against the Baysox.

ENTER SANDMAN: Righty Cam Sanders leads all minor league relievers with 7 saves entering play on Wednesday, April 29. Sanders is the first Curve reliever to pick up 7 saves in a calendar month since Matt Eckelman saved 8 games in June of 2019. Justin Kaye (June, 2005) and Matt Peterson (June, 2007) hold the record for saves in a month by a Curve pitcher with 9.

ON THE MEND: Infielder Spencer Horwitz made his organizational debut with the Pirates Sunday at Chesapeake, he is 1-for-4 with 2 walks in 6 plate appearances during his rehab.

Horwitz was acquired from the Cleveland Guardians in exchange for RHP Luis Ortiz, LHP Michael Kennedy and LHP Josh Hartle this past off-season and is rehabbing an injured wrist. Horwitz, like Isiah Kiner-Falefa last year, will play for the Curve before he plays for the Pirates. Horwitz made his major league debut in 2023 for Toronto and last season led all qualified MLB rookies with á .357 on-base percentage last season. He recorded a .790 OPS in 97 games for the Blue Jays.

A YOUNG MAN'S GAME: Infielder Termarr Johnson opens as the youngest position player in the Eastern League at 20 years old, just two days younger than Reading's Aidan Miller. Among Double-A players, he is the 7th-youngest player at the level; the youngest is San Antonio's Ethan Salas (SD, 18.8 years old). Johnson <u>has reached base safely in 25-of-33 games with the Curve</u> and has a hit in 15-of-19 games to begin the season. **Johnson was 10-for-31 (.323) with a double and pair of solo home runs** during his seven-game hitting streak that ended on Tuesday, July 29.

OUT FOR A WALK: Altoona hitters are 3rd among all Double-A clubs with 105 walks in 22 games this season.

IT'S ABOUT HOW YOU START: Curve starters tossed 15 scoreless innings to begin the season (Barco, Dotel, Solometo, Chen). Overall, Curve starters have a 1.05 WHIP, 2nd among Double-A staffs and 3.23 ERA, 6th among Double-A clubs.

THE PIRATES ARE THIEVES: Altoona enters play on Wednesday, April 29, 4th among Double-A clubs with 40 stolen bases in 47 tries. Mitch Jebb leads the club with 9 steals, 1st in the Eastern League, 4th among Double-A players.

WE'LL SEE THEM ALL: For the first time since the 2019 season and the creation of the six-game series, the Curve will face every team in the Eastern League this season. Altoona will face New Hampshire and Binghamton on the road only, while Hartford and Reading will only play the Curve at PNG Field.

Andy Fox Manager (1st Season) Career Record: 45-94

Andy Fox is the 16th manager in Curve history. Fox's coaching ca-reer has seen him serve in several roles, including time with the Rang-ers, Mariners, Marlins, and Red Sox. He spent the last 14 years in Boston's system, serving as the team's infield coordinator and first base coach. Prior to his time in Boston, Fox served as a first base coach for the Marlins and managed the Rangers Single-A Clinton team in 2006. Fox was drafted in the 2nd round of the 1989 Draft by the Yankees and won two World Series in his nineyear Major League career with New York (1996) and the Florida Marlins (2003) as an infielder.

Matt Ford **Pitching Coach** 1st season/12th overall

Ford joins the Curve in 2025 after serving as the Pitching Coach for Low-A Bradenton in 2024. This is his 12th season serving as an in-structor in the Pirates system, pre-viously serving in the FCL (2022), Greensboro (2021), as the team's Rehab Pitching Coordinator (2019-20), Bradenton (2017-18), both West Virginia clubs (2015-2016) as well as with Bristol (2014). Ford was Toronto's third round pick in 1999 and made his Major League debut with the Brewers in 2003. He pitched in 25 games and made four starts in his lone Major League season. He began his coaching career at the University of Akron in 2012.

Scott Seabol Hitting Coach 1st season/10th overall

Seabol comes to Altoona after spending the 2024 season as the Hitting Coach in Bradenton. This is his second season as a Pirates minor league instructor. He joined the Pirates after four seasons as a hitting instructor in the Miami Marlins system (2020-2023) and the New York Yankees (2016-2019). Seabol was drafted by the Yankees in 1996 out of West Virginia University and played 60 Major League games with New York (2001) and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005).
