NOTES AND NUGGETS

WHAT A RELIEF

Omaha got 7.2 scoreless innings from its bullpen yesterday, one of the relief corps' top performances of the season.

Yesterday was the 9th time Omaha's relievers have combined to not allow a run in a game ... it was the 2nd straight game and 4th time in the last 6 games the bullpen combined for a scoreless day.

In May, Omaha's bullpen has a 2.97 ERA, the 6th-best in the International League this month ... since May 3, over the last 6 games (with 4 scoreless outings), it's a touch lower at 2.39 (7 ER in 26.1 IP) ... the relievers had a 4.44 ERA (59 ER in 119.2 IP).

7.2 scoreless innings is now the longest scoreless bullpen performance of the season, passing 7.1 scoreless innings from the relievers on May 3 vs. Indianapolis.

Omaha's relievers have not been charged with a run in the last 10.2 innings, going back to Thursday's win over the Bats ... this is the 2nd time the relievers have combined for more than 10.0 innings without a run, also doing so for 12.1 innings between Friday, May 2 and Sunday, May 4.

LET'S RAVE

Outfielder **John Rave** has been a consistent presence at the top of the Omaha all season long, contributing in all facets of the game.

Rave leads the league lead in triples (4), is 2nd in runs scored (29), tied 6th in stolen bases (12), 7th in slugging percentage (.533), tied 7th in total bases (64) and tied 7th in extra-base hits (15) ... in addition to these categories, he also leads Omaha in hits (33), home runs (6) and runs batted in (19).

Rave has served as Omaha's leadoff hitter in 29 of 35 games this year ... he's reached base to begin 12 of 29 games (.414 OBP leading off the 1st inning), including 3 straight games this week ... that includes 8 hits (2 singles, 3 doubles, 3 homers), 3 walks and 1 hit-by-pitch ... his 3 leadoff homers this year are tied for the most in the Minor Leagues.

5 of Rave's 6 home runs this season have come against Louisville, including all 3 of his leadoff homers ... between 2024 and 2025, Rave has hit 10 of his 27 homers against the Bats, the most of any player in the last two years against Louisville, while his 20 RBI vs. Louisville in that span are also the most in the league.

U CAN'T TOUCH THIS

The Omaha Storm Chasers pitching staff ranks near the top of the International League in strikeouts, with 351 strikeouts this season ranking 3rd in the league, tied 4th at the Triple-A level and just 10 strikeouts behind first place.

Omaha pitchers are averaging 10.35 K/9, which ranks 3rd both in the International League and at the Triple-A level.

With 351 strikeouts through 35 games, an average of 10.03 strikeouts per game has the staff on pace for 1,494 strikeouts this season ... the franchise record is 1,282 strikeouts by the 2023 Storm Chasers.

GET RATIOED

A pair of Storm Chasers have some of the best ratios in the Minors right now.

With 29 walks this season to just 17 strikeouts, **Nick Loftin's** 1.706 BB/K rank as the 3rd-best walk-to-strikeout rate in the Minors (min. 100 PA) ... his .213 walks per plate appearance is the 14th-best in Minor League Baseball.

Right-hander **Andrew Hoffmann** has struck out 30 batters in 19.1 innings, with just 4 walks ... his 13.97 K/9 ranks as the 4th-best strikeout rate in Triple-A (min 15.0 IP), while 7.50 K/BB is the 3rd-best strikeout-to-walk rate at the level.

MASHIN' MERV

While his first week in Triple-A was slow, outfielder **MJ Melendez** picked up the pace offensively last week against Indianapolis.

Melendez went 6-for-23 (.261) against the Indians last week, with a pair of doubles, a home run, 4 RBI and 1 walk ... he drove in a run in 4 of 6 games.

In 14 games with Omaha, MJ has an average exit velocity of 94.1MPH, Omaha's hardest average exit velo this year ... his average exit velo ranks 7th among 359 Triple-A League hitters with at least 50 plate appearances this year.

MJ has 3 Omaha's top 9 single exit velos this year, including the team's hardest hit ball of the year: a double on May 1 vs. Indianapolis that was hit at 112.0MPH ... was his 3rd-hardest batted ball recorded by Statcast (since MLB debut in May 2022).

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

While the Storm Chasers do not lead the league in stolen bases, Omaha has the highest success rate on the basepaths in the IL.

Omaha has successfully stolen 53 bases this year, and only been caught 6 times ... 53 steals rank 5th in the International League, with the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp leading the league with 87 steals.

53-for-59 in steal attempts is a 89.8% success rate, the highest stolen base rate at the Triple-A level and 3rd in Minor League Baseball (1st: San Jose Giants, 92.2%).

LUINDER AVILA SCOUTING REPORT

MLB Pipeline

Scouting grades: Fastball: 50 | Slider: 50 | Curveball: 50 | Changeup: 45 | Control: 45 | Overall: 40

The Royals signed a 16-year-old Avila out of Venezuela during the 2018 international signing period. Ever since, it's been steady progress for the now-23-year-old who spent most of the 2024 season at Double-A before making one Triple-A start. Avila posted a 1.37 WHIP over 19 starts for Northwest Arkansas. It was the first time since 2022 that he didn't throw over 100 innings, as he missed about six weeks with a minor oblique injury. In five games (three starts) in the Arizona Fall League, Avila posted a 3.07 ERA with 17 strikeouts and eight walks in 14 2/3 innings. The Royals added him to their 40-man roster to protect him from the Rule 5 Draft in November.

Last year marked the first time Avila missed significant time; he's been a durable young pitcher for the Royals, and those innings don't go unnoticed. Avila's comfort zone with his fastball is 94-95 mph with flashes of the upper 90s, and the pitch has natural cut and ride. To help him command the arm'side of the plate, Avila introduced a two-seamer that is about the same velo as his four-seamer. He throws both a slider and curveball, and both can miss bats. They can sometimes morph into each other, so the separation is a work in progress. A fringe-average changeup rounds out Avila's arsenal, a pitch he's still developing with a focus on backing off the 89-91 mph velocity. Avila has near-average command but hides the ball well in his delivery, and as he's grown, his presence on the mound has gotten stronger.

Now that he's on the 40-man, Avila could make his big league debut at some point in 2025. He needs more development time in Omaha, particularly with his secondary pitches and command, but will be part of the Triple-A depth to begin the season. Avila will continue to start but might be someone whom the Royals can rely on in different roles depending on need for a long reliever or a swingman.

Baseball America

Scouting Grades: Fastball: 55 | Curveball: 60 | Changeup: 45 | Control: 45

Track Record: It's been a slow trek through the Royals system for Avila since first signing in 2018, but he's proven enough value to get a spot on the 40-man roster. The Venezuelan righthander was on the way to a strong season until a rib cage injury in early July put him on the sidelines for seven weeks. He returned in time to get three more starts at Double-A Northwest Arkansas and one with Triple-A Omaha. His 3.81 ERA and .229 opponent batting average in Double-A were among the best numbers of his career. Avila finished his year in the Arizona Fall League, where he pitched in the annual Fall Stars Game as well as throwing two scoreless innings in the championship game.

Scouting Report: Avila's four-seam fastball has glove-side cutting action and sits 93-95 mph, touching 98, with ride. A development goal will be to improve the location and consistency of the pitch. His best pitch is a high-spin two-plane curveball at 79-83 mph and he uses it to get swings and misses with its downward movement that's tough to barrel. His 87-91 mph hard changeup is still in development, a pitch with natural sink that gets whiffs, and could be an average offering with more consistency. He repeats his delivery and has been called a sneaky competitor.

The Future: The Royals added Avila to the 40-man roster in November. He projects as a valuable innings-eater at the back of the rotation but could thrive in a bullpen role.

- Avila is making his **7th start with Omaha** this season ... made Omaha's 2025 Breaking Roster, after ending the 2024 season in Triple-A with the Storm Chasers ... was added to Kansas City's 40-Man roster this offseason.
- Playing his 7th professional season this year, all have come in the Royals organization.
- Most of Avila's career has been spent as a starting pitcher, with 86 of his 109 professional outings as a starter ... 72 of his 74 outings since the start of the 2022 season have been starts.
- Since 2021, Avila ranks 2nd among Royals Minor League arms in innings (396.2) and 3rd in strikeouts (366) ... he's allowed just 24 home runs in 446.0 pro innings, for a 0.48 HR/9 ... in that span (since 2018), only two qualified Minor League pitchers (min. 400.0 IP) had a better mark: the best is **Luis Devers** (0.37 HR/9, Cubs org).

In his second start of the week against the Indians, threw his second quality start of the season and earned his first Triple-A win ... opened the game with 5.0 scoreless innings (on just 64 pitches), including 1-2-3 innings in the 3rd and 5th ... a double and RBI single scored a run against him in the 6th inning ... did not come out for the 7th.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS

- Optioned to Triple-A on March 9, the first player optioned to Omaha this spring.
- Pitched 3.0 innings of relief (4th to 6th) of the Royals' Spring Breakout game, on March 14 @ Arizona ... allowed 3 runs on 3 hits and 1 walk, with 4 strikeouts ... threw a 1-2-3 6th inning, retired his last 5 batters.
- Started Omaha's home opener, April 1 vs. Louisville ... retired his first 12 hitters, and struck out a career-high 11.
- His turn in the rotation was skipped during Omaha's series vs. Norfolk, April 16 to 22.
- Leads Omaha with 2 quality starts ... both came on a Sunday, as his second time pitching against that team in the series ... between the two starts, has allowed 3 ER in 12.0 IP (2.25 ERA) with 8 strikeouts.

- Opened the season in the Double-A starting rotation with Northwest Arkansas ... made 16 starts before landing on the 7-Day Injured List on July 12 ... missed 47 days of the regular season, activated on August 27 and made 3 more starts with the Naturals.
- Ranked 2nd on the Naturals' pitching staff in starts (19), tied 2nd in wins (6) and 4th in innings pitched (82.2).
- Made 3 quality starts for the Naturals, including tying a career-high with 7.0 scoreless innings on June 21 vs. Tulsa (LAD) ... made quality starts back-to-back starts on May 17 @ Arkansas (SEA) and May 23 vs. Amarillo (AZ).
