**CARDS COMEBACK FALLS SHORT IN 9-5 LOSS TO NATURALS:** The Cardinals trimmed a five-run deficit to just one going into the bottom of the eighth inning but could not overcome a 6-1 hole as Springfield dropped the series opener 9-5 to the Northwest Arkansas Naturals at Arvest Ballpark on Tuesday morning. **Jimmy Crooks** drove in three runs with a bases-clearing double in the seventh inning, and **Bryan Torres** had two hits for the Cardinals. **Torres** and **Jeremy Rivas** extended their on-base streaks to 22 and 17 games, respectively.



**OPPOSING STARTER:** Right-hander **Mason Barnett** makes his sixth start of the season for the Naturals...Last pitched on Wednesday, May 1 at home against Wichita and did not factor in the decision, allowing 2 ER on 3 H with 7 K over 5.0 IP...For the month of April went 1-0 with a 3.38 ERA with 25 K and just 13 H allowed in 18.2 IP...Made 7 starts at the end of the season for NW Arkansas in 2023, going 2-1 with a 3.58 ERA...Made one start against the Cardinals last season and got the win on September 1 at Arvest Ballpark allowing 2 ER on 4 H with 6 K over 5.0 IP...Made 16 starts with High-A Quad Cities to start last season and registered a 4-6 record with a 3.18 ERA...Selected by the Royals in the 3rd round of the 2021 draft out of Auburn...Earned an invite to MLB Spring Training this season as a non-roster player...Went 303 with a 4.38 EA in 19 appearances (14 starts) as a junior at Auburn...Started the Tigers' third game of the College World Series against Arkansas and took the loss allowing 4 ER on 5 H over just 2.2 IP...23 years old

**CARDS, NATURALS CLASH FOR FIRST TIME IN 2023:** The Springfield Cardinals conclude their 12-game, two-city road trip in Springdale, AR with a six-game series against the Northwest Arkansas Naturals (Double-A, Kansas City Royals). It is the first meeting of the season between the two North Division rivals. The Naturals finished 64-74 in 2023, the worst record in the Texas League by a half-game.

### CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD



The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

## CARDS' RADIO HOME

**CLASSIC ROCK 106.7** For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

**COMEBACK CARDS:** Of the Cardinals' 27 games so far this season, they have fallen behind first in 15 of them. Of those 15 games, the Cards have won nine, making them 9-6 when their opponent scores first. Amazingly, despite Springfield's opponent scoring first in 11 of 12 games at Hammons Field, the Cardinals hold an 8-4 record at home this season.

**BIRDS BOAST BEST DOUBLE-A OFFENSE:** Through 27 games the Cardinals lead the three Double-A leagues with a .267 batting average; the Arkansas Travelers are next at .260. The Cards also lead the level in runs scored (159) and RBIs (148). Springfield is 2nd in hits (239) and OBP (.360), is tied for 4th in BB (122) and has also been particularly productive hitting situationally with 15 sacrifice flies this season, three more than any other team in Double-A.

The Cards' bats, however, have cooled off since April 26, batting just .234 over their last 9 games which ranks 8th in the Texas League during that time

**GRINDIN':** Perhaps the Cardinal offense's greatest attribute is their ability to grind out at bats and put the ball in play. The Cardinals have struck out just 196 times in 27 games, the 2nd-fewest in all of full-season Minor League Baseball. The Cardinals trail only the Spokane Indians (181 K's) for fewest whiffs in the minor leagues. The Indians, however, have played four fewer games than the Cardinals (23). The Birds are averaging just 7.26 K's per game.

**STAFF LOOKING TO GET BACK ON TRACK:** Since the Cardinals' franchise-record nine-game winning streak to start the season, Springfield has struggled to prevent runs the way they did at the outset. Over their last 16 games since April 16, the Cards have a 6.33 ERA, the highest mark in the Texas League by over a run (Amarillo Sod Poodles, 5.32). Springfield's WHIP (1.63) and opponents batting average (.278) are also last in the league since that time. Additionally, the 24 home runs the Redbirds have allowed over their last 18 games is most in the circuit during that time. The Birds have allowed 34 longballs this season, 2nd-most in the league behind the Sod Poodles (35).

Springfield posted a 2.88 ERA during their first nine games of the season, resulting in a franchise record nine-game winning streak. The Cards are 9-9 since.

**TABLE SETTERS:** The hitters that occupy the top two spots in the Cardinal lineup on the most regular basis, **Bryan Torres** and **Nathan Church**, have been the fuel to Springfield's league-leading offense. Combined, **Torres** and **Church** are batting .340 (65-for-191) with 38 R, 12 2B, 20 SB, 3 CS and have 26 BB compared to just 21 K. One of their names can be found 9 times among the top 5 in 7 different categories on the Texas League offensive leaderboard.

Springfield leadoff hitters are batting .303, good for 2nd in the Texas league, while the Cards have a league-leading .319 average out of the 2-hole.

**TAKE ME TO CHURCH:** Cardinals outfielder **Nathan Church** ranks in the top-5 among qualified hitters in the following categories: RBIs (3rd; 22), hits (3rd; 35), total bases (4th; 52), and runs (3rd; 20). **Church** has hit safely in 23 of his 25 games played and has struck out just 8 times in 119 plate appearances (6.7%). The UC Irvine product has already set a career high with 4 HR. He hit just 3 longballs at High-A Peoria last season in 119 games.

On Monday, **Church** was named Cardinals Minor League Player of the Month for April when he slashed .349/.402/.512 with 3 HR and 18 RBIs. He led all Cardinals minor leaguers in OPS (.914), hits (30), total bases (44), and runs (17). He hit safely in 19 of 20 games for the month.

**BRYAN TORRES, ON-BASE MACHINE:** Springfield leadoff man **Bryan Torres** has set the tone atop the Cardinals potent lineup, ranking among the leaders in the Texas League in 5 offensive categories: batting average (3rd; .353), OBP (5th; .441), hits (5th; 30) and leads the league with 13 stolen bases while being caught just twice. **Torres** has reached base safely in all 22 games in which he has played this season, the longest streak in the league.

**REDMOND TIES FRANCHISE RECORD:** With his go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on April 23 against Arkansas, Cardinals slugger **Chandler Redmond** tied the franchise record for most home runs. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with **Xavier Scruggs** (2010-13). **Redmond** already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 206.
