NORTH LITTLE ROCK, AR – Northwest Arkansas Naturals right-hander **Zach Haake** delivered his second three-inning scoreless appearance in relief this week, but the Naturals fell to the Arkansas Travelers, 5-0 Sunday afternoon.

- Northwest Arkansas starting pitcher **T.J. Sikkema** kept the Travelers off the board over the first three innings but ran into trouble in the fourth, allowing three hits with an error that knocked him out of the game.
- Haake was the first arm out of the bullpen behind Sikkema and allowed the first three hitters he faced to reach base and two inherited runners scored, then retired the next eight he faced, including six on strikeouts.
- Across two relief appearances this week, Haake compiled 6.0 scoreless innings, with just three hits allowed and nine strikeouts.
- Yefri Del Rosario** came in after Haake allowed a run over 1.1 innings but the Naturals could not get anything on the scoreboard.
- Northwest Arkansas entered the ninth with just three hits – two from second baseman and a third inning double from leadoff hitter **Tucker Bradley**.
- Robbie Glendinning** and **Jake Means** doubled in the ninth but the Naturals could not scratch across a run, as both were stranded on in the second shutout loss of the week.

THIS DAY IN NATURALS HISTORY

The Naturals are 6-6 all-time when playing on August 16

On August 16, 2013, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals beat the San Antonio Missions, 2-1 on a walk-off in 12 innings at Arvest Ballpark. San Antonio took a lead in the fifth inning with a home run, then **Brett Eibner** doubled in **Whit Merrifield** in the eighth to tie the game at 1-1 and force extra innings. The game remained tied until the first pitch of the bottom of the 12th, **Cheslor Cuthbert** homered to left field to win the game. After **Sugar Ray Marimon** allowed the run in the fifth inning, the Naturals bullpen of **Santiago Garrido**, **Andy Ferguson**, **Zach Jackson** and **Jon Keck** combined for 6.0 scoreless innings against the Missions.

FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in *Advanced Rookie* Burlington (2019) and *High-A* Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 13 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 4 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: **Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Jake Means and John Rave.**

EXTREME ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM

When looking at the Naturals' numbers one game to the next, it appears rather black and white with what leads to a win or loss.

- When scoring seven runs or more, the Naturals are 34-8, while when scoring six runs or less, just 10-56.
- The Naturals are 30-14 when recording 10 hits or more, but when they get nine hits or less, are just 14-49.
- The Naturals are 41-14 when out-hitting their opponent or hits are tied, but 3-49 when out-hit by their opponent.
- When the Naturals score first, they are 28-20, whereas 16-43 when the opponent scores first.

ONE RUN GOES A LONG WAY

The Naturals are 5-17 in one-run games this season, meaning 17 of their 63 losses (26.98%) this season have been decided by just one run.

- The Naturals have had the tying run at the plate or on base in 20 losses this season (including 13 of their one-run losses).

Yo, YOU WANNA SEE SOME REAL SPEED?

Through 107 games, the Naturals have stolen 137 bases in 170 attempts (average 1.28 steals/game, 80.59% success rate).

- 137 steals is tied for the Texas League lead, ranks tied seventh in Double-A and tied 31st in the Minors ... the team's collective 80.47% success rate ranks 26th among the 120 full-season MiLB teams.
- The Naturals have stolen at least one base in 70 of 107 games this season (65.42%), including 34 games with two or more steals ... the team stole a season-high six bases on July 6 vs. Tulsa with a pair of five-steal games as well this season.
- The Naturals have pulled off a double steal 17 times, meaning 34 of 137 steals this year (24.82%) have come on a double-steal.
- Naturals players have stolen multiple bases in a game 14 times, SIX of those occasions being Garcia ... **Tucker Bradley** had the first three-steal game of the season (and of his career) on July 9 vs. Tulsa.
- Maikel Garcia's** 27 steals (in 30 attempts) still ranks fourth in the Texas League, **Nick Loftin's** 24 (in 27 attempts) ranks seventh in the league.

TUCK(ER) AND ROLL

Naturals outfielder **Tucker Bradley** has been consistent from the start of the season and established himself as one of the team's most reliable hitters.

- Bradley has reached base at least once in 75 of 92 games played this season (81.52%) and reached base multiple times on 48 occasions, which ranks second on the Naturals behind Logan Porter's 49 ... he has hits in 65 of 92 games and has a team-best 28 multi-hit games, as well as 13 multi-run games and nine multi-RBI games.
- Bradley's .300 batting average leagues qualified Naturals hitters, ranks tied ninth in the Texas League and fourth among Kansas City's minor league hitters ... his .383 on-base percentage ranks third in the system, as are his 100 hits, while 19 doubles are tied fourth, 57 runs scored and 146 total bases rank tied eighth and his .822 OPS is tied ninth,
- The Georgia native has hit first in the order 24 games this year, which ranks second behind Maikel Garcia (76) ... when hitting first, Bradley is a .296 hitter (29-for-98) with a .395 on-base percentage and .793 OPS ... when leading off innings, he hits .307 (27-for-88) with a .390 on-base percentage.

TYLER, THE CREATOR (OF RUNS)

Naturals outfielder **Tyler Gentry** has been one of the best hitters in the Kansas City Royals' system this season, with an incredible impact since joining the Naturals in June.

- Among qualified full-season Minor League hitters, Gentry ranks **SIXTH** in batting average (.330) when you combine his stats between Northwest Arkansas and Quad Cities (A+).
- He is the Royals' organization leader in batting average (.330), slugging percentage (.559) and OPS (.984), while ranking second in on-base percentage (.425) ... his 17 home runs between the River Bandits and Naturals are tied third in the system, while 62 runs batted in are tied fifth.
- Gentry has reached base in 40 of 45 games (88.89%) and has hits in 31 of his 45 games with the Naturals, with already 18 multi-hit games.
- In 45 games since his call-up to Double-A on June 14, Gentry is batting .325 (55-for-169) with nine doubles, 12 home runs and 39 runs batted in and a 1.011 OPS ... he's driven in at least one run in 21 of 45 games, with 10 multi-RBI games.
- Gentry leads the Naturals in nearly every category since joining the team, with the highest average (.325), most total bases (100) and most runs batted in on the team (39) ... his 39 RBIs are the second-most in the Texas League since then and his 12 homers and 1.011 OPS ranks third since his arrival in the circuit, while 100 total bases are fourth.
- His 18-game on-base streak between June 26 and July 17 is the longest for a Naturals player this season ... in that span, he hit .382 (26-for-68) with 10 extra-base hits and 12 walks, with an on-base percentage of .459 in that span.

ALEXANDER THE GREAT

Infielder **CJ Alexander** has quickly heated up at the plate since joining the Naturals in a trade last month from Atlanta.

- Alexander has hit 6 of the Naturals' last 10 home runs, across the team's previous 10 games ... that means he has *hit more home runs than the rest of the team combined.*
- Over 24 games with the Naturals, the corner infielder is hitting .263 (26-for-99) with 11 extra-base hits (eight home runs) and 26 runs batted in, with 15 runs scored as well.
- He has hits in 15 of 24 games with the Naturals, 10 of which are multi-hit performances, while he's driven in runs in 9 of 24 games, including already SEVEN multi-RBI games.
- In the month of August, Alexander is hitting .326 (15-for-46) with seven home runs and 18 runs batted in ... seven homers, seven homers and 18 RBI lead the Texas League this month, while 37 total bases are tied first.
- CJ homered in four straight games against Tulsa, August 3 to 6 ... he is the third Natural this season and just the sixth all-time to homer in four consecutive games.
- Alexander began his Naturals tenure 0-for-12 over his first three games, then homered on July 16 @ Corpus Christi for his first hit with the team and went 4-for-10 in his next two games.

ROCKIN' ROBBIE

After slumping for much of June, first baseman **Robbie Glendinning** has returned to form, with a hot stretch that has carried through July into August.

- Glendinning's 65 runs batted in this season rank seventh in the Texas League, while 64 runs scored are tied for the eighth-most in the league.
- He has reached base in 81 of 91 games played this season (89.01%), reaching multiple times in 43 games this season ... he has hits in 60 of 91 games, including 26 multi-hit games this season.
- Among Royals minor league hitters, Glendinning ranks as one of the top hitters in nearly every category ... he is third in the system with 37 extra-base hits and 64 runs scored and tied third in the system with 17 home runs, 65 runs batted in, fourth with 162 total bases and tied fourth with 19 doubles ... his .475 slugging percentage and .842 OPS rank as the sixth-best in the organization, while his .367 on-base percentage and .264 batting average each rank ninth in the system.

Pitchers of the Month (1)

May: **LHP Drew Parrish** ... started five games and went 3-1 with a 0.59 ERA (2 ER in 30.2 IP) ... only allowed 15 hits and four walks, while striking out 29 opposing hitters ... among qualified Texas League pitchers, threw the most innings and had the lowest ERA and WHIP (0.62), while holding opponents to a .144 average.

Players of the Week (3)

- April 25 to May 1: **2B Michael Massey** ... hit .417 (10-for-28) across six games with a league-best 19 total bases and nine runs batted in, while tied for the Texas League lead with 10 hits. His 1.221 OPS ranked third among players with at least 20 at-bats, while his .417 average tied for second among that same group.
- May 23 to May 29: **2B Michael Massey** ... hit a league-best .481 (13-for-27) across six games in Midland, while tied for the league lead with 19 total bases. He drove in nine runs as well, doubling three times with one home run, a go-ahead grand slam on May 24 and collected multiple hits in each of the first five games of the series.

- Christian Colón returns to the organization as the Naturals Assistant Hitting Coach in 2022, following a 12-year professional career.
- He was the Royals first-round pick in the 2010 MLB Draft, scored the winning run in the 2014 AL Wild Card game and had the game-winning hit in the title-clinching Game 5 of the 2015 World Series.
- After being drafted in 2010, Colón ascended to Northwest Arkansas by 2011 and between 2011, 2012 and 2014, played 202 games for the Naturals ... in 2011, Colón led the Texas League in sacrifices (21), while leading the team in at-bats (491) and hits (126). His 21 sacrifices that season are the most a Naturals player has ever recorded in a single season, while 28 overall are tied for the club record.
- During his playing career, he made stops in Miami (2017) and Cincinnati (2019-20) ... spent 2021 with the Rich Baseball-owned Buffalo Bisons (Triple-A, Toronto) before announcing his retirement.
- He also played in parts of four seasons in the Puerto Rican Winter League.
- Christian lives in Cave Springs, Ark. (15 minutes North of Arvest Ballpark) with his wife, Kayla, and three daughters, Marley, Mia and Lucy.

- Jirschele was originally selected by the Texas Rangers in the fifth round of the 1977 MLB Draft and played in 999 minor league games over 13-plus seasons in the Rangers and Royals systems.
