Today's Game

The Fightin Phils remain home and continue a six-game series against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. It is the second-of-18 matchups this season between the teams, and second-of-six at FirstEnergy Stadium. Hartford won the 2024 season-series over Reading 10-8. Following this week, the Fightin Phils go to Hartford from July 29-August 3 and Sept. 2-7. Reading leads the season-series 1-0 after Tuesday night's win.

Game 62 Recap

Reading's offense stayed red-hot and once again used the long ball en route to a 7-4 win over Hartford on Tuesday night. Caleb Ricketts returned from the injured list with two home runs and three RBI. Leandro Pineda also had a home run, double and three RBI in the win. Braeden Fausnaught started, but lasted just three innings, allowing one run on four hits, with three strikeouts. Behind Fausnaught, the bullpen was stellar. Nelson Alvarez and Andrew Bechtold tossed two-scoreless frames each. Then, Jack Dallas fired a scoreless eighth inning. Tommy McCollum did allow a three-run home run in the ninth, but did manage to strike out the side to secure the series-opening victory for Reading. Every R-Phil in the lineup reached base on the night.

Welcome Back Caleb

After missing two months on the injured list, Caleb Ricketts made his return to the Reading lineup in a big way on Tuesday night. The 25-year old catcher launched two home runs and drove in three runs in the win. His two home runs marked the second two home run game of his career, with the last coming on June 6, 2024, against Harrisburg at FirstEnergy Stadium. It marked the third two home run game of the season for a Reading player, with the other two being Robert Moore on Apr. 15 vs Binghamton and Paul McIntosh on June 7 at Harrisburg.

Catch Me If you Can Carson

Carson DeMartini continues to be a threat on the base paths since joining the Fightin Phils last week. Over seven games, DeMartini has swiped six bags. Since June 10, his Double-A debut, DeMartini ranks second in the Eastern League in stolen bases, trailing only Hartford's Cole Carrigg, who has stolen seven bases since the start of last week. DeMartini is tied with Aidan Miller for second in the Phillies organization in stolen bases with 24.

Hammering Homers

After three-more home runs on Tuesday night, the Fightin Phils have launched 19 home runs since the start of June. That is a mark that is most in the Eastern League, and four ahead of second place Binghamton and Erie, who have 15. Reading ranks fourth in the league in home runs this season with 52.

Red Hot Like the Weather

With summer approaching, the Fightin Phils bats are also heating up as of late. Since last Thursday, Reading has won four-of-five games and are averaging 6.8 runs per game over that stretch. Since last Thursday, Reading's offense holds the following Eastern League rankings: 3rd AVG (.260), 1st runs (34), T-3rd hits (39), 1st HR (9) and 2nd OPS (.883).

It's Miller Time

Phillies No. 2 Prospect Aidan Miller continues to be a threat on the base paths. After two-more stolen bases last Wednesday night, Miller is alone in first place in the Eastern League with 24 stolen bases, three clear of second place. In the Phillies organization, Miller is tied for second with Carson DeMartini at 24 stolen bases, behind Lehigh Valley's Oscar Mercado, who has 26. Justin Crawford of the IronPigs has 23 stolen bases on the season.

Binelas Brings the Boom

Alex Binelas enters tonight on a season-best eight-game on-base streak, dating back to June 6. Over the streak, Binelas is slashing .304/.452/.478 (.930 OPS), with four runs, a double, home run and nine RBI. A highlights of the streak was a career-high five RBI on June 12 against New Hampshire, a night in which Binelas had two hits, a run, a home run and five RBI. His nine RBI from June 10-15 were the most in the Eastern League for last week.

This Day in Baseballtown History

June 18, 2021: At Harrisburg, starting pitcher Jack Perkins takes the mound for just the second time in his Double-A career, and pitched six quality innings for the winning effort. He allowed just four hits and two walks in a shutout effort, striking out five. Perkins launched his first homerun of the season in his first at bat.

Hey Hartford

Hartford enters tonight with a 32-32 record, 11-games back of Northeast Division first half champion Binghamton. The Yard Goats dropped four-of-six against Akron last week, including losing the final three games. After this week, Hartford returns home to face New Hampshire. Hartford's roster features eight of Colorado's top-30 prospects: Cole Carrigg (2), Seam Sullivan (8), Benny Montgomery (13), Kyle Karros (18), Wlinton Herrera (20), Jack Mahoney (24), Dylan Jorge (27) and Connor Staine (30).

Goat on the Bump

Righty McCade Brown makes his fourth start for Hartford tonight. Over 12 starts between Spokane (A+) and Hartford, Brown is 0-0, with a 2.14 ERA (11 ER, 46.1 IP). Brown has struck out 68 over 46.1 IP (13.21 SO/9.0 IP). Brown allowed two runs on four hits, with nine strikeouts, over 5.2 innings against Akron last Thursday. Brown was promoted to Hartford on May 30 and made 12 appearances between the ACL-Rockies (ROK) and Fresno (A) in 2024, going 1-3, with a 6.85 ERA. He missed the entire 2023 season. The 24-year old was a third round pick of the Rockies in 2021 out of Indiana, where he pitched from 2019-21.

Cabrera's streak of one-walk outings came to an end as he issued three last Thursday against New Hampshire. It was still a solid outing for Cabrera, as he allowed two runs on just two hits over five innings of work. After two clean innings to start the game, Cabrera surrendered two runs in the top of the third inning. He issued a one-out walk to Jay Harry, then Eddinson Paulino homered for the only two runs Cabrera allowed on the night. Following the third inning, Cabrera finished his night strong with two more zeroes in the fourth and fifth innings. Cabrera was relieved by Andrew Schultz in the top of the sixth inning.

2025 Season:

- Prior to the 2025 season, Cabrera was added to the Phillies 40-man roster (on 11/19/24) to protect him from the Rule-5 Draft; optioned to Reading (AA) on March 8
- Appeared in relief for the Phillies in the Spring Breakout Game (3/14 vs PIT) and tossed two innings following Moises Chace, who started the game
- Opened the season ranked as the Phillies No. 11 Prospect (MLB Pipeline)
- Tabbed as Reading's Opening Day starter Apr. 4 vs Portland (ND, 4.2 IP, 2 H, ER, 4 BB, 3 SO)
- Lone win of season Apr. 16 vs Binghamton (5.0 IP, 4 H, 1 ER, 2 BB, 7 SO)
- Season-high six innings on three occasions: Apr. 22 at Portland, May 8 at Binghamton and June 6 at Harrisburg
- May 8 at BNG: 6.0 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 8 SO; eight strikeouts was season-high
- Walked season (and career-high) five batters twice: May 1 vs HBG and May 20 at POR
- Issued season-low one walk in three-straight starts: May 25 at POR, May 31 vs ERI and June 6 at HBG
- Posted seven strikeouts June 6 at Harrisburg, which was tied for his second-most in a game this season
- Over six home games, has a 3.56 ERA (12 ER, 30.1 IP), compared to 4.18 ERA (15 ER, 32.1 IP) across five away contests
- Holding RHH to .160/.265/.214 (.479 OPS) slash line
- Wish RISP, opposing hitters are slashing .159/.250/.238 (.488 OPS)
- Entering play on Wednesday, Cabrera is tied for seventh in the Eastern League in strikeouts (59), fourth in IP (62.2) and sixth in average against (.194)
- Entering play on Wednesday, has allowed the most walks in the Eastern League (36)
- Since May 25 (four starts/21.1 IP) has allowed 41st most walks in the league (6)

2024 Season:

- Began season with Jersey Shore (A+), where he made 14 starts prior to promotion to Reading (AA) on July 9
- Limited LHH to a .190/.261/.286 (.547 OPS) slash line
- Fanned a career-high 14 batters on July 12 vs Wilmington, which was the second-most strikeouts in BlueClaws history
- Collected first Double-A win on Aug. 23 at Binghamton, in his final start of the season
- Over five April starts, posted a 2.25 ERA (7 ER, 28.0 IP)

- Spent 2023 with Clearwater (A), where he ranked second in the FSL with 3.91 SO/BB ratio
- Also spent all of 2022 with Clearwater, striking out 23.9% of hitters faced
