THE LAST TIME OUT: The Curve wrapped up their 2019 season with a 69-71 record, falling to the Harrisburg Senators, 1-0, on September 2, 2019. Left-hander Sean Brady coasted through the first five innings retiring 11 straight hitters to start the game. He walked around a walk in each the fourth and fifth inning, keeping the Senators off-balance with well-placed fastballs and a tight slider. He picked up his third and fourth strikeouts to start the sixth inning but fell behind Michael A. Taylor in the count, 3-1, before the Senators outfielder drove his ninth homer of the season over the right field wall. Senators starter Kevin McGowan led the shutout effort with six scoreless innings and held the Curve to three hits. Jordan Mills and Jacob Condra-Bogan each fired scoreless innings in relief before Jhonathan German (Save, 2) closed out Harrisburg's second straight shutout win over the Curve.

TODAY'S GAME: The Curve take the field for the first time in 610 days after the COVID-19 Pandemic led to the cancellation of the 2020 campaign. It has been 614 days since Peoples Natural Gas Field last hosted Curve baseball.

WE'RE FIRST!: Altoona-Bowie and Portland-New Hampshire are both slated to open the 2021 Minor League Baseball season with 6:00pm first pitches. There are 55 total games slated to get underway across the country on Tuesday night as all levels of MiLB get underway on the same day for the first time in modern history.

THE LIMIT DOES EXIST: In compliance with local health guidelines and Major League Baseball COVID-19 protocols, Peoples Natural Gas Field can host up to 2,300 fans to begin the season. Fans can purchase tickets in seating pods of 2, 4, 6, or 8 and each pod is spaced at least six feet apart from any other in their respective section.

40-MAN CURVE: The Curve roster features three members of the Pirates 40-man roster in INF Oneil Cruz, INF Rodolfo Castro and RHP Max Kranick.

THE BAYSOX: Bowie begins the 2021 season with two of the top four prospects in the Orioles minor league system in C Adley Rutschman and LHP D.L. Hall. The Baysox roster also features Terrin Vavra (No. 13, MLB.com), who was acquired from the Colorado Rockies in exchange for former Baysox righty Mychal Givens. Vavra spent the 2019 season with the High-A Asheville Tourists hitting .318 with 10 home runs and 52 RBI. He has a career .313 average in the minors. Other top prospects for Bowie include RHP Kyle Bradish (No. 14, MLB.com), who was acquired from the Los Angeles Angels in 2019 for RHP Dylan Bundy, and RHP Cody Sedlock (No. 28, MLB.com). The Baysox roster includes eight players that have previously suited up for Bowie: RHP Diogenes Almengo, LHP Tyler Erwin, RHP Steven Klimek, RHP Tim Naughton, Sedlock, INF Alex Torres, INF Willy Yanh, and OF Zach Jarrett.

FOR ALTOONA: RHP Roansy Contreras makes his organizational debut on Tuesday night. Contereas was acquired by the Pirates in a five-player deal that brought fellow Curve OF Canaan Smith-Njigba to the organization along with INF Maikol Escotto (Bradenton) and RHP Miguel Yajure (Indianapolis) in exchange for former Curve RHP Jameson Taillon. Contereas spent the 2019 season with Single-A Charleston in the Yankees organization where he went 12=5 with a 3.33 ERA in 24 starts for the RiverDogs...For more on Contreras, see page two.

FOR BOWIE: LHP D.L. Hall makes his 2021 debut after the COVID-19 Pandemic kept him from regular season action. Hall was drafted in the first round, 21st overall, by the Orioles in the 2017 MLB Draft. He owns a 6-12 career minor league record in 46 games with a 2.96 ERA and 228 strikeouts in 185 1/3 innings pitched. Hall spent the 2019 season with High-A Freder-Average Attendance. ick. Upon the cancellation of the 2020 MiLB season, Hall spent time at the Orioles Alternate Site camp in Bowie.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Curve active roster features eight of the top-30 prospects in the Pirates organization according to Baseball America. INF Oneil Cruz (No. 2 Pirates, No. 50 overall), RHP Cody Bolton (No. 6), INF Ji-Hwan Bae (No. 9), INF Mason Martin (No. 16), OF Cal Mitchell (No. 19), Rodolfo Castro (No. 22), RHP Max Kranick (No. 23), and RHP Travis MacGregory (No. 28) are all ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Pittsburgh Pirates prospects list.

Miguel Perez was named the 12th manager in franchise history after Dave Turgeon was tabbed to lead the team for the 2020 season.

Perez is the first former Curve to serve as the team's Manager and enters his 14th season as a member of the Pirates organization in 2021. Perez served as the Curve's Third Base Coach in 2015 under Manager Tom Prince and played 92 games for the Curve combined between the 2008, 2009, 2012, and 2013 seasons,batting .271 with four home runs and 36 RBI. Perez played made two appearances for the Cincinati Reds as a 21-year-old in September of 2005, going 0-for-3 with a strikeout. Perez also spent time with Akron Aeros (44 games in 2010, batted .280), and the Harrisburg Senators (3 games in 2011, went 0-for-9)

Drew Benes Pitching Coach

1st season 5th overall

Drew Benes was slated to be the Pitching Coach for a second consecutive season with the Bradenton Mauraders in 2020 before the COVID-19 pandemic.

Born in Evansville, IN, Drew is the son of former major league pitcher Andy Benes and the nephew of former big leaguer Alan Benes and minor leaguer Adam Benes. Originally selected as a third baseman by the Cincinnati Reds in the 47th round of the 2007 draft, but did not sign, Benes converted to the mound when at Arkansas State University. Benes was selected by the St. Louis Cardinals in the 35th round of the 2010 draft and spent three seasons in their system accumulating a 9-11 record with a 4.57 ERA in 66 appearances.

David Newhan Hitting Coach

1st season 10th overall

Newhan comes to the Curve for his first year in the Pirates organization and 10th season as a coach in professional baseball. He managed the Double-A Mobile BayBears during their final season and spent the previous two years as the Infield Coordinator for the Los Angeles Angels. Newhan's coaching career started in 2011 as a hitting coach in the Padres system. His first managing experience came in the Athletics organization in 2014. In 2015-16, he was on the Detroit Tigers' major league coaching staff as the Assistant Hitting Coach. Newhan played parts of eight seasons in the big leagues and 14 seasons overall as an infielder and outfielder with the Padres (1999-2000), Phillies (2000-01), Orioles (2004-06), Mets (2007) and Astros (2008).

Gary Green Bench Coach

1st season 16th overall

Gary Green is in his first season with the Curve and 16th season as a minor league instructor for the Pirates. He has served as the Minor League Infield Coordinator/Roving Infield Instructor for the Pirates since the 2011 season and joins an affiliate coaching staff for the first time since 2010.

Green was selected 27th overall by the San Diego Padres in the 1984 amateur draft and earned a silver medal for Team USA in the '84 Olympics in Los Angeles. He batted .222 with nine doubles and 11 RBI in 106 major league games across four seasons with the Padres, Rangers and Reds. Green spent 11 seasons as a manager in the Pirates and Detroit Tigers organizations, amassing a 588-713 record (.488).
