**Today:** The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, conclude a six-game series with a Sunday matinee at the Lake County Captains – the 258th all-time meetings between Lansing and Lake County and the 12th meeting of the 2025 regular season. The Nuts are 4-7 vs. the Caps this year, splitting a six-game series in Lansing at the end of April and start of May before dropping four of the first five games of the current series.

**Game 1: Captains 2, Lugnuts 0.** Wuilfredo Antunez homered and a trio of Captains hurlers held the Lugnuts to one hit, clinching a Lake County series victory.

**Game 2: Lugnuts 4, Captains 0.** Tommy White and T.J. Schofield-Sam hit back-to-back home runs in the first inning in a two-hit Lansing shutout.

**On Deck:** An off day tomorrow on Memorial Day, and then the Nuts return to Michigan's state capital to open a six-game series with the Beloit Sky Carp.

**Prospecting:** The Nuts have six of MLB Pipeline's Top 30 A's prospects: No. 7 prospect (**Tommy White**), No. 10 (**Joshua Kuroda-Grauer**), No. 12 (**Steven Echavarria**), No. 17 (**Ryan Lasko**), No. 18 (**Rodney Green, Jr.**) and No. 28 (**Nate Nankil**).

**Welcome to The Show:** Center fielder **Denzel Clarke** made his Major League debut on Friday night for the Athletics, becoming the third Nut to make his MLB debut this season, alongside **Max Muncy** and **Gunnar Hoglund**, and the 196th all-time Lugnut to go from Lansing to the Majors.

**Roll Call:** When pitcher **Nathan Dettmer** debuted on Friday, he became the 965th Lugnut in franchise history (as well as the eighth to start a game this season, the 19th different pitcher and the 34th different player used this season).

**Promotions:** Pitcher **Diego Barrera** was promoted to Double-A Midland yesterday, one day after infielder **Sahid Valenzuela** was called up to Triple-A Las Vegas yesterday. There were no corresponding moves, leaving the Lugnuts' roster at 27 active players.

**What a Debut!** 2023-24 Lugnuts starter **Luis Morales** premiered in Triple-A last night with six hitless innings for the Las Vegas Aviators at Sugar Land, striking out seven while walking just one on 88 pitches. **David Leal** eventually lost the no-hitter in the eighth inning, but the Aviators still rolled to a 6-1 victory, improving their league-leading record to 32-17. 2023 Lugnuts catcher **Daniel Susac** went 2-for-5 to improve his batting average to .300.

**Your 2025 A.L. Rookie of the Year:** 2023 Lugnuts shortstop **Jacob Wilson** went 3-for-4 with a walk in the A's extra-inning loss to the Phillies last night, improving his batting average to .342, third highest in the American League. Wilson's 67 base hits trails only Aaron Judge among Major Leaguers.

**Atop the League:** First baseman **T.J. Schofield-Sam** (.341) leads Lake County infielder **Christian Knapczyk** (.336) for the Midwest League batting title. Both players went hitless yesterday, ending Schofield-Sam's 14-game on-base streak and Knapczyk's 13-game hitting streak.

**At the Plate:** The Lugnuts rank second in the Midwest League in batting average (.258), second in base hits (368), second in doubles (85), second in on-base percentage (.355), third in total bases (550) and are the toughest team to strike out (299).

**In the Field:** The Nuts are the best defensive group in the league, posting a .980 fielding percentage with only 30 errors committed in 1,528 chances. The Lugnuts also rank third in the league in fewest stolen bases allowed (36 in 51 attempts).

**On the Mound:** Lansing's pitching corps is first in the league in holds (19), first in complete games (2), first in fewest HBPs (14), first in fewest balks (3), tied for first in fewest walks (148) and fifth in saves (11).

### MAY 25TH IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**1999:** Franklin German tied the Midwest League record and established a Lugnuts franchise record (since tied by Kevin Pillar, Ryan McBroom and Emilio Guerrero) with six hits in one game.

**2009:** Another outstanding Chuck Huggins appearance was wasted by the Lugnuts. Huggins struck out nine batters in four scoreless innings at Cedar Rapids, but the Lugnuts blew a 5-0 lead by giving up three runs in the 6th, one run in the 7th and an Adam Younger walk-off two-run double in the 9th for a 6-5 defeat.

**2015:** Anthony Alford tied the franchise record with four walks and scored four runs, and the Lugnuts blasted Fort Wayne, 11-5, on Memorial Day at Cooley Law School Stadium. Rowdy Tellez had four RBIs and Richard Ureña also scored four runs to back Sean Reid-Foley's professional high five innings / seven strikeouts.

**Last Time Out:** Steven tossed a career high six innings in the series opener for his first career professional quality start, limiting the Captains to one run; struck out six and walked three... 82 pitches, 45 strikes.

**Gatorade, Not Gator:** Echavarria posted a 0.28 ERA with 80 strikeouts in 50 innings as a senior at Millburn High School, allowing only one extra-base hit the whole season. He was named New Jersey's 2022-2023 Gatorade High School Baseball Player of the Year and the top prep prospect in the state. Initially committed to Oregon, he changed his commitment to the University of Florida as his senior year dawned, but then signed with the A's for \$3 million to head into professional baseball – the only New Jersey high schooler taken in the 2023 MLB Draft.

19-year-old Steven Echavarria is part of an exclusive club: players who suited up for the Lugnuts as teenagers. Future Major Leaguers include 19-year-old Max Muncy, who joined the Nuts for the final 42 games of 2022; 19-year-old Gabriel Moreno, who homered in his first Lugnuts at-bat in 2019; Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. and Bo Bichette, who were 18 and 19 respectively when they dominated the 2017 Midwest League and appeared in the Futures Game; 18-year-old Carlos Beltrán, who was in the Lugnuts' very first Opening Day lineup on April 5, 1996; and the 1999 Lugnuts teenage duo of 19-year-old Corey Patterson, who was named the Midwest League Prospect of the Year, and 18-year-old Carlos Zambrano, who won 13 games and worked 153 1/3 innings.

**Path to Lansing:** After signing, Echavarria debuted in instructional league ball in 2023. He was slated to pitch in the 2024 Spring Breakout for the A's against the Giants, but the game was canceled due to rain. On May 2, 2024, Game 22 of the Stockton Ports' season, he made his official professional debut, starting against Visalia and working three scoreless innings before allowing two unearned run in the fourth... posted 9.00 ERA in six May starts (20 R/18 ER in 18 IP)... limited opposition to one run or fewer in nine of his final 13 starts of the year, including stretch from June 25-August 4 with just 2 ER allowed in 25 2/3 IP... vs. right-handers: .306/.386/.387, 1 HR, 5 GiDP... vs. left-handers: .316/.431/.474, 3 HR, 1 GiDP... best inning was the fourth inning: 3-for-26, .115 avg. against... base-stealers were successful in 11 of 13 attempts.
