TODAY'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and Tacoma Rainiers (Seattle Mariners) get set for the final game of the regular season on Sunday afternoon from Cheney Stadium. Express RHP Adrian Sampson is slated to pitch one more time this year against Rainiers LHP Rob Kaminsky. First pitch is scheduled for 3:35 p.m. CT.

NOT OUR NIGHT

The Rainiers took game five of the series by a final of 8-0. Tacoma struck first in the first inning. After CF Samad Taylor walked, he stole second base. A groundout moved him to third base before a wild pitch scored him to make it 1-0. A four-spot in the third inning increased the Rainiers lead to 5-0. 2B Kobe Kato doubled to start the frame and advanced to third base on a wild pitch. A sacrifice fly for RF Rhylan Thomas gave Tacoma a 2-0 lead. With two outs, DH Tyler Locklear doubled and 3B Jake Slaughter walked. LF Nick Solak made the E-Train pay with a three-run homer. The Rainiers kept the scoring coming in the sixth and seventh frames. After a single for SS Logan Warmoth, he stole second and the throw went into center field which allowed him to advance to third base. A sacrifice fly for Kato brought the lead to 6-0 for Tacoma. A single and walk for Thomas and Locklear put two on in the seventh. Slaughter singled home one run before a double for 1B Michael Papierski brought the advantage to 8-0. The shutout was the ninth of the year for Tacoma pitching and it was also the ninth of the season for the Round Rock offense.

SAMPSON START

Round Rock RHP Adrian Sampson is set to take the baseball in the final game of the regular season on Sunday. His 132.1 innings are fifth in the Pacific Coast League. His 269.0 innings with the Express are eighth in club history. He passed RHP D.J. Houlton with his 4.2 innings on Tuesday. Sampson's 17 wins are tied for fifth-most in club history. Since March 2014, his 664.0 innings in Triple-A are 14th overall and third among active pitchers.

SAVE THAT BASEBALL

Round Rock C Ben Hartl checked into the game in the ninth inning to pinch-hit. He ripped a clean single to earn the first Triple-A hit of his career. According to unofficial records, Hartl is the first player to appear in the Round Rock Classic at Dell Diamond and also suit up for the Express in the same season. Hartl was with the University of Kansas before he was a 14th round selection by the Texas Rangers in June.

DUFFY FINISHING STRONG

Round Rock INF Matt Duffy went 2-for-4 with a double last night. In 14 games this month, Duffy is hitting .298 (17-57). This is only the second month this season that he has appeared in double-digit games. Duffy played in 14 games in July.

ANOTHER GREAT YEAR FOR CRIM

Express 1B Blaine Crim went 2-for-4 yesterday with a walk. He enters today tied for fifth in the PCL in hits (140) with Tacoma INF Jason Vosler. Since the start of 2023, Crim leads the PCL in games (267), hits (283) and doubles (64). He is second in RBI (171), third in walks (141) and fifth in home runs (42).

SLOW SLUGGING

Entering the final day of the regular season, the Express are 24th in Triple-A and last in the PCL in slugging percentage (.411). They are 27th and last in home runs (138). It's the fewest homers since 2018 (128). They have hit 180 home runs or more in each of the last four seasons.

CY YOUNG CITY (BOLD IF APPEARED AT DELL DIAMOND)

This season, the Express have seen a total of six Cy Young award winners take the mound. RHP Max Scherzer (**April 24**, June 9, **June 15**, September 7) and RHP Jacob deGrom (**August 27**, **September 1**) are the two that have pitched for the Express on rehab assignments. Los Angeles Dodgers LHP Clayton Kershaw (**July 19**), Tacoma Rainiers LHP Dallas Keuchel (**June 15**) and San Francisco Giants teammates, LHP Blake Snell (June 23) and LHP Robbie Ray (June 23) all faced the Express. Los Angeles Dodgers RHP Yoshinobu Yamamoto (**August 29**) has not won a Cy Young award but also appeared at Dell Diamond on a rehab assignment and was awarded the largest contract for a pitcher in Major League Baseball history this offseason (\$325 million). While RHP Johnny Cueto did not win a Cy Young award, he did finish second in the Cy Young voting in 2014 with Cincinnati and received votes in three different seasons (2012, 2014, 2016). Cueto made eight starts with the E-Train.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.



Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
