YESTERDAY: Daniel Espino pitched a career-high 6.2 innings with 10 strikeouts and combined with Tim Herrin on a two-hit shutout, as the Captains beat the Beloit Snappers, 4-0. **Micah Pries** and **Raynel Delgado** both homered in the victory that kept the Captains' playoff hopes alive heading into the final game of the regular season.

PLAYOFF PICTURE: The Captains enter today trailing the Cedar Rapids Kernels by 1.0 game for the last playoff spot in the High-A Central League. The Captains only have to finish the season tied with Cedar Rapids because Lake County owns the tiebreaker (best winning percentage over the final 20 games). The Quad Cities River Bandits have clinched the top seed and will face either Lake County or Cedar Rapids in a best-of-five championship series that begins on Tuesday.

CAPTAINS CLINCH IF: The Captains clinch a playoff berth only if they win and the Cedar Rapids Kernels lose today.

CAPTAINS ELIMINATED IF: The Captains are eliminated from playoff contention today if they lose or if the Cedar Rapids Kernels win.

DIVISION CHAMPS: With yesterday's win and a loss by the Great Lakes Loons, the Captains clinched the High-A Central League East Division Championship. It is the Captains' first division title since 2010, though it does not guarantee them a playoff spot. The top two teams in the league, regardless of division, reach the postseason.

RUNNERS STRANDED: The Captains have struggled with runners in scoring position recently. Over the last 11 games, Lake County has batted .176 (16-for-91) with men in scoring position and left 66 runners aboard (6.0 per game).

SLUMPING: The Captains' offense has the league's lowest team batting average (.204) in September. Six Captains hitters with 25+ plate appearances this month have batting averages under .200.

TRENDS & NOTABLES

Jhonkensy Noel: Among all minor league hitters with 250+ plate appearances, Noel is fourth in OPS (1.031), fourth in slugging percentage (.633), fourth in batting average (.348) and fifth in wRC+ (168).

Micah Pries: Has gone 6-for-20 (.300) with two homers and a double this series. Over his last nine games, Pries is slashing .314/.368/.543 (.911). This comes after a 10-game stretch when Pries slashed .172/.294/.414 (.708 OPS). Raynel Delgado: Delgado is 4-for-9 with three homers and two walks in four games this series. This comes after an eight-game stretch when he was 3-for-29 (.103).

Christian Cairo: Has a .937 OPS over his last eight games with two homers, three doubles and eight walks. José Tena: Tena is 5-for-16 (.313) with a homer and two doubles over the last four games. This comes after an 11-game stretch when he went 7-for-40 (.175) with 16 strikeouts and two walks.

Joe Donovan: Donovan is 3-for-28 (.107) over his last 10 games. Two of his three hits are home runs.

SUPERLATIVES: Baseball America recently released its annual list of the best tools among minor league prospects in each league, as voted on by minor league managers. Several Captains made the cut. Daniel Espino was tabbed for the best breaking ball in the High-A Central League. Joe Naranjo was named best defensive first baseman. José Tena was awarded both best defensive shortstop and best infield arm. Greg DiCenzo was named best manager prospect.

LAST TIME OUT: Hickman surrendered four runs over 5.2 innings against Dayton on Sunday, but three of those runs came after he left the game. The right-hander held the Dragons to one run over the first five innings, but Dayton rallied with two outs in the sixth. Hickman left the bases loaded after allowing a single and two walks. **Nathan Ocker** then gave up a grand slam to Jonathan Willems. The grand slam broke a 1-1 tie, but the Captains came back to score six runs on one hit in the seventh to beat Dayton, 7-5.

AIRBORNE: Hickman has allowed the fourth-highest fly ball percentage (48.4%) among Cleveland minor league pitchers with 50+ innings pitched.

COLLEGE ACCOLADES: Hickman was named a Preseason All-American by *Collegiate Game*, and Second Team Preseason All-America by *Perfect Game* before the shortened 2020 season.

2020 DRAFT: Cleveland selected Hickman in the fifth round (154th overall) of the 2020 draft, which was shortened to five rounds. This was considered a bit of a steal by some outlets with both *Perfect Game* and *Baseball America* ranking Hickman as the 65th best draft prospect entering the draft.

COLLEGE WORLD SERIES CLINCHER: Hickman's shining moment at Vanderbilt came in 2019 as he helped lead the Commodores to their second National Championship in school history. In the series clinching win, Hickman started for Vanderbilt tossing six strong innings, allowing just one run while fanning 10 Wolverines in the 8-2 win. He also started in the CWS semifinals against Louisville throwing six scoreless frames and surrendering just two hits with three strikeouts. In four total NCAA Tournament starts he went 2-0 with a 1.57 ERA in 23 innings.

CAPTAINS AND VANDY: Hickman is just the second Captain ever to come out Vanderbilt. The first and only other Commodore to come to Lake County was catcher on the 2003 Captains and Lake County Manager in 2012. David Wallace

STAFF LEADER: In 2019 Hickman found himself starting 2019 out of the bullpen despite being the teams Sunday starter as a freshman, appearing out of the bullpen three times in 2018. After coming out of the pen in his first six appearances of 2019 with a 2.50 ERA Hickman rejoined the rotation and thrived. He finished the year with a 2.05 ERA to lead the team and finish 4th in the SEC.

COACHES WORDS: Hickman worked with Tim Corbin at Vanderbilt who has built a powerhouse in Nashville churning out top baseball talent. In recent years Walker Buehler, Sonny Gray and David Price among others have all starred in the big leagues after pitching for Vandy. Corbin says "Mason has turned into one of the most dependable and reliable starting pitchers that we have had in our program. He continues to develop and get better as his craft while taking on a leadership role on our pitching staff. He is a quality young man that excels in the classroom as well. Very competitive in everything that he does."

STRIKEOUT BUMP: After striking out just eight batters per nine innings as a freshman in Nashville, Hickman saw an increase in whiffs towards the end of his sophomore season. In his final six starts of the season he struck out nine or more batters five times. He finished 2019 with 129 strikeouts to finish 13th in the country and struck out 12 per nine innings.

PROFESSIONAL STAFF: The teammates Hickman worked with at Vanderbilt have been highly regarded around baseball. Pitchers that Hickman joined in the clubhouse that have recently been drafted include Tyler Brown (2020, HOU), Jake Eder (2020, MIA), Drake Fellows (2019, SD), Zach King (2019, MIA), Jackson Gillis (2019, MIL), Joe Gobillot (2019, TB), AJ Franklin (2019, KC), Patrick Raby (2019, CIN), Maddux Conger (2018, DET) and Justin Wilson (2018, NYY). In 2021, Commodores Kumar Rocker and Jack Leiter are both expected to be first round draft picks in 2021 and were teammates of Hickman's in 2019 and 2020. Vanderbilt has also had 12 position players since 2018.
