NOTES AND NUGGETS

SEASON 57

2026 marks the 57th season (58th year) in franchise history and the 15th season (16th year) in the Storm Chasers era.

Omaha is coming off a 2025 campaign in which they went 62-86 (.419 winning %) to finish tied 17th in the 20-team International League ... the 2025 Chasers tied for the MiLB lead with 199 home runs, the 4th-most in a season in franchise history.

OS-BORN FOR THE JOB

Patrick Osborn begins his 2nd season in Omaha and 1st as manager of the Storm Chasers in 2026, bringing a championship resume to Werner Park.

Osborn served as Omaha's bench coach in 2025, before being named the 20th manager in Triple-A Omaha franchise history in January 2026 ... he is the 4th manager in the 15-season Storm Chasers era of the club (2011-present).

2026 marks his 7th season as a Minor League manager, owning a 375-309 (.548) career record with 5 postseason trips in 6 Yankees-system seasons (2014-19).

He led Double-A Trenton to the 2019 Eastern League championship and was named 2016 Florida State League Manager of the Year with High-A Tampa.

Is a former 2nd-round pick by Cleveland and professional infielder ... recently served as a Marlins pro scout (2020-21) and Miami's Field Coordinator (2021-24).

CLASHING WITH THE CUBS

This week, the Storm Chasers open their first series of the season against the Iowa Cubs, a familiar opponent for the Triple-A Omaha franchise.

Since 1969, Omaha and Iowa have faced off 1,092 times, accounting for 13.7% of all games in franchise history ... since both clubs joined the International League in 2021, their 124 meetings are tied for the 5th-most between any two IL teams.

In the International League era, Omaha has won two of five season series against Iowa (2021: 24-16 and 2024: 12-9) ... last season, however, the Storm Chasers went just 5-16 against the Cubs, with a .238 winning percentage - Omaha's lowest in a single season against Iowa in the 21st century.

Over the past three seasons (2024-26), Iowa's Connor Noland has logged 28.2 innings against Omaha, the most of any IL pitcher, while his 28 strikeouts vs. Omaha are tied for 2nd ... he struck out 1 over 4.1 innings yesterday.

STARTED FROM THE BOTTOM, NOW WE'RE HERE

After an 0-4 start to the season, the Storm Chasers have won 5 of their last 6, with a series win last week at home against the Buffalo Bisons.

Last season, the Storm Chasers won just 6 of 27 series played, only just 2 series at home ... including the final homestand of the 2025 series, September 9 to 14 vs. Charlotte, Omaha has won its last two series at home.

Infielder Josh Rojas and catcher Luca Tresh tied for the team lead with 6 hits and 10 total bases last week, as they both went 6-for-16 with 4 doubles ... Rojas led the team with 4 RBI, while 6 different players tied for 2nd with 3 RBI.

On the mound last week, Eric Cerantola worked 2.0 scoreless innings across 3 relief appearances, earning saves in 3 of Omaha's 4 wins in the series ... Helcris Olivarez also authored 3.0 scoreless innings out of the bullpen.

CLOSING TIME

Eric Cerantola has been Omaha's most reliable bullpen arm to open the 2026 season, leading the International League in both saves (3) and appearances (5).

The righty has not allowed a run in any of his 5 outings, tossing 4.1 scoreless innings while holding opponents to a .188 average (3-for-16) ... he has struck out 7 of the 17 batters he has faced.

Additionally, righty Mason Black earned a save in Omaha's second win of the season last Thursday, his first professional save.

MEET THE PRODUCERS

Infielder Josh Rojas and outfielder John Rave have been two of Omaha's most productive offensive contributors through the first 10 games of 2026.

Rojas leads the Chasers in hits (11), doubles (5) and extra-base hits (6), with a team-leading .976 OPS while his 9 RBI tie for the lead ... his 5 doubles are tied for 2nd in the International League and he has reached base safely in 8 of 9 games played.

Rave, meanwhile, has drawn 9 walks through 9 games, tied for 9th in the IL in walks, with a .405 OBP ... he has also swiped 4 bases in 4 attempts, tied for 6th in the league in steals.

BOSACKER ATTACKER

- KEEPING THE MOMENTUM:** Bosacker is back for his fourth stint with the Storm Chasers after ending last season with Northwest Arkansas (AA), but is coming in off his best Double-A stretch ... after returning to the Travelers on August 19 last year, he put up a 2.84 ERA (6 ER in 19.0 IP) and 0.74 WHIP across 5 games (3 starts) to finish the season.
- LATE ROUND STEALS:** As a 13th round draft pick by the Royals in 2023, Bosacker joins **Ryan Ramsey** (13th, 2022), **Luca Tresh** (17th, 2021) and **Chazz Martinez** (17th, 2022) as a group of four players on the Storm Chasers roster selected by Kansas City in the back half of the draft since 2021.

LAST OUTING: THURSDAY, APRIL 2 VS. BUFFALO

- Made his season debut the same day he was assigned to Omaha ... worked a scoreless 1st inning, allowed 2 singles but also picked off **Carlos Mendoza** ... allowed a solo homer in the 2nd to **Brandon Valenzuela** and a 2-run shot in the 3rd to **Eloy Jiménez** ... worked around a walk for a scoreless 4th inning.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS

- Did not appear in a Cactus League game for the Royals ... assigned to Omaha on April 2.

- Split time as both a starter and reliever between Northwest Arkansas (AA) and Omaha ... combined to post a 4.05 ERA (49 ER in 109.0 IP) with a 1.25 WHIP in 28 appearances (15 starts) between the two levels.
 - Opened the year with the Naturals and started his first 7 games before a promotion to Triple-A, pitching at least 5.0 innings in all 7 Double-A starts and posting a 5.00 ERA (20 ER in 36.0 IP).
 - Made his Triple-A debut for the Storm Chasers on May 17 vs. Columbus (CLE), allowing 5 runs in 5.0 innings ... had 3 separate stints with Omaha, his longest (and last) stint between July 18 and August 19 when he produced up a 4.73 ERA (7 ER in 13.1 IP) across 7 games (2 starts).
 - Finished the season in Double-A, working a 2.84 ERA (6 ER in 19.0 IP) and 0.74 WHIP across 5 appearances (3 starts) after being transferred back to NWA on August 19.
