RIDERS SWEEP DOUBLEHEADER IN AMARILLO:

The Frisco RoughRiders picked up a doubleheader sweep against the Amarillo Sod Poodles on Thursday, winning both games by a score of 10-2 in Amarillo. The Riders (23-12) jumped out to a 1-0 lead in the first game of the doubleheader on a sacrifice fly by **Cody Freeman** against Amarillo (14-22) starter Billy Corcoran (0-1) in the opening frame. Leading 1-0 entering the third inning, the RoughRiders sent 14 batters to the plate on their way to an eight-hit, nine-run inning. Eight different Frisco batters secured a hit, with the biggest coming from **Liam Hicks** and **Maximo Acosta** who each snagged RBI singles. After waiting over thirty minutes to retake the mound, **Ryan Garcia** (2-2) allowed a two-run single to Deyvison De Los Santos in the bottom of the third inning, rounding out the game's scoring. Garcia tossed 5.0 innings, surrendering just two runs on three hits and three walks while fanning five. **Andy Rodriguez** finished the contest, spinning 2.0 hitless innings while striking out two. Offensively, the RoughRiders managed 14 hits. **Geisel Cepeda** led the way with a three hit affair that included a double. **Keyber Rodriguez** doubled and tripled as **Liam Hicks**, **Aaron Zavala** and **Maximo Acosta** each added two hits. Acosta's three RBI led the Frisco attack.

In Game 2 of the doubleheader, **Ben Anderson** (2-2) was tagged for a run in the bottom of the first inning on an RBI single by De Los Santos. Anderson settled in to go 5.0 innings, allowing just a run on five hits and no walks while punching out a career-high eight. After being blanked in the first, the RoughRiders scored in four consecutive innings. In the top of the second the Riders tied the game on an **Abimelec Ortiz** double and then took the lead when Keyber Rodriguez drove him home with a two-bagger. In the top of the third inning, Frisco extended their lead to 5-1 with Freeman's fifth homer of the season, a three-run bomb to left off Jamison Hill (1-3). The Riders offense continued to thrive, scoring four runs in the top of the fourth to make it a 9-1 advantage. **Cooper Johnson** drove in the first run of the frame with a single and Zavala capped the scoring with a double. Johnson snagged another RBI with a single in top of the fifth, making it back to back 10-run efforts for the Frisco offense. De Los Santos drove in a run with a single in the bottom of the sixth against **Ricky DeVito**, cutting the deficit to 10-2. DeVito spun 2.0 innings, conceding one run on one hit and one walk while punching out three. **Frainyer Chavez**, Freeman, Rodriguez and Johnson collected multi-hit performances. Freeman's three RBIs led the team. Across both games, four Riders pitchers combined to allow just four runs across 14 innings as the Frisco offense put up 20 runs on 26 hits. The RoughRiders managed seven doubles, a triple and a homer on the day.

TIMING MATTERS:

While the RoughRiders are fourth in the league in batting average (.248), they are tied for first in the Texas League in average with runners in scoring position (.294). They also have the third-fewest left on base in the Texas League (211, 6.0 per game). **Josh Hatcher** is eighth in the league with a .371 batting average with RISP while **Cody Freeman** is 11th (.353) and **Aaron Zavala** is 12th (.344).

DRIVERS, START YOUR ENGINES:

The RoughRiders have seen a lot of runs this season in the first inning of games. Frisco is third in the Texas League with 26 first-inning runs while they have the second-highest first-inning ERA in the league as well (6.17).

MAY FLOWERS:

The RoughRiders are 10-3 in the month of May, the best record in the Texas League. Frisco has the best overall ERA in the month (3.04) while they have a 1.81 bullpen ERA in the month. Out of their 10 wins in the month, the Riders have recorded a league-best six saves. On the offensive side, they are second in the league with 24 steals and fewest strikeouts (87), but are fourth in OPS (.719) and seventh with just nine home runs.

IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

Riders outfielder **Kellen Strahm** has the longest on-base streak this season for the RoughRiders, currently at 22 games. During the streak, he hit .306 (26-for-85)/.394/.412/.806 with a double, a triple, two home runs, eight RBIs, 13 walks, five steals and 20 runs scored. The streak is the third-longest active streak in the Texas League. In his career, Strahm has the second-longest on-base streak in RoughRiders franchise history (37 games in 2022). His 159 career walks with the RoughRiders are the second-most in franchise history, trailing only **Guilder Rodriguez**, who walked 206 times over seven seasons from 2009 to 2015.

THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Part of the RoughRiders' dominance on the mound has been the Frisco bullpen. Over the last 14 games, the bullpen has allowed just nine earned runs over 48.0 innings (1.69 ERA). On the season, the bullpen is second in the Texas League with a 3.48 ERA.

I WANT TO BREAK FREE(MAN):

Cody Freeman had a monster game on April 25th against Amarillo, going 5-for-5 with two home runs and a double. It was the first five-hit game in Freeman's Minor League career and the first one for the Riders since **Blaire Crim** accomplished the feat on September 2nd, 2022 at Amarillo. Over his last 21 games, he is batting .325 (26-for-80)/.360/.600/.960 with seven doubles, five home runs, 15 RBIs and 13 runs scored. In his last 18 games, he has batted .343/.365/.657/1.022 with all five of his homers.

THE HATCHER HAMMER:

In an incredible win on April 27th, **Josh Hatcher** hammered a three-run, walk-off home run for a 4-3 win over Amarillo. Hatcher's capper was his third home run in as many games. He is slashing .333/.381/.490/.871. Hatcher is second in the league in batting average (.333), fifth in RBIs (22), 10th in slugging percentage (.490) and sixth in OPS (.871). Last Thursday, the Texas Rangers announced that Hatcher was named the Rangers Minor League Player of the Month for April. He slashed .373/.403/.576/.979 over 15 games for Frisco in April with three doubles, three home runs, 16 RBIs, 11 runs and three steals. He finished third in the Texas League in batting average (.373), tied for eighth in RBIs (16), sixth in slugging (.576) and sixth in OPS (.979).

ABOUT NICK

-Went to Northgate High School in Walnut Creek, California (across the Bay from San Francisco, east of Berkeley). His senior season, he went 6-5 with a 2.20 ERA over 11 games.

-Krauth then went to the University of New Mexico for the 2018 season, where he was teammates with current RoughRiders pitcher Justin Slaten.

-After New Mexico, transferred to Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Valley, California where he went 5-4 with a 2.20 ERA. Following that strong season, he transferred again, this time to the University of Connecticut, where he was one of the best pitchers in the country for the 2020 season before it was cut short due to COVID. In his four starts, he went 4-0 with a 0.36 ERA and a .167 BAA. This included five one-run innings against the No. 1 Michigan Wolverines on February 23rd.

-Due to the 2020 MLB Draft getting shortened to five rounds, Krauth went undrafted and signed with the Rangers as a free agent on June 15th.

-Brother, Ben Krauth, pitched for the San Antonio Missions in 2022, making nine starts and recording a 7.18 ERA. In two starts against Frisco, the RoughRiders touched him up for a combined seven runs, six earned, over 7.2 innings while handing him two losses. Ben was released by the Padres organization at the end of the year and retired after six seasons of MiLB experience.

2024 SEASON

-Krauth enters 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation.

-Became the first RoughRiders pitcher to complete a quality start on 4/14/24 against Corpus Christi.

2023 SEASON

-Krauth made first appearance of the season out of the bullpen on Friday, April 7th, allowing three runs over four innings.

-In his first start, Krauth went shutout five innings at San Antonio on April 14th to earn the first win among RoughRiders starting pitchers.

-Threw four scoreless innings on April 20th before game was suspended due to rain in the top of the fifth with the Riders up 9-0, ending his night early. The Riders and the Travelers went on to finish the game on April 21st with Frisco winning 13-5.

-Allowed a run in the fourth inning against Amarillo on April 26th, snapping a 14.2-consecutive innings scoreless streak dating back to April 7th.

-Joined Triple-A Round Rock on May 2nd for a spot start and make two appearances. In his start, he went 3.2 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 3 BB, 1 K. Allowed a grand slam to David Freitas of Oklahoma City in relief appearance.

2022 SEASON

-Spent time as both a starter and reliever, going 4-7 with a 5.38 ERA in 17 starts and 1-0, 2.28 ERA out of the bullpen.

-An extreme groundball pitcher, Krauth rolled groundballs at a 50.2% clip with the Crawdads.

2021 SEASON

-Showing his durability, Krauth led the Low-A East and the Rangers organization with 102.2 innings pitched. He also made a team-high 20 starts.

-Earned Low-A East Pitcher of the Week twice, including once for a complete-game, one-hitter on August 28th vs. Fayetteville (9.0 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 9 K).
