TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and Reno Aces (Arizona Diamondbacks affiliate) continue their high scoring series with game five of the six-game series. Reno secured at least a series split with an 8-6 victory on Friday night. Round Rock plated five runs in the first inning behind RBI hits from DH Austin Wynns and SS Keyber Rodriguez before C Cooper Johnson capped the frame with a three-run homer. Reno answered with two runs in the bottom half and chipped away with three more in the second to make it 6-5. The Aces tied the game in the third on a wild pitch and took their first lead in the fourth on a two-run double by 3B Jose Fernandez. Both clubs managed just three hits combined over the final four innings as Reno held on for an 8-6 victory.

WHERE WE STAND

Reno has secured at least a split of the series... Round Rock must win each of the final two games to earn its third series split of the season... a loss in either game would result in the club's ninth series loss of the year... the Express fall to 13 games under .500 for the seventh time this season... after opening the second half with a 6-2 record, Round Rock has gone 2-6 over its last eight games... the club drops to fifth place in the PCL standings, its lowest position since the second half began on 6/23... first three-game losing streak since June 17-20 at Las Vegas when they lost four straight.

WYNNS IS WORKING

Wynns reached base three times on the night for the second time since joining the E-Train on June 23. He recorded RBI singles in each of his first two plate appearances. After slashing .462 (6-for-13)/.500/.769/1.269 with a home run and five RBI in four games during June... hitting .355 (11-for-31) with two home runs, nine RBI and four walks through his first nine games with Round Rock.

SMITH SETTLES IN

INF Josh Smith began his third stint with the Express after he was optioned by Texas on Friday and collected singles in both the first and second innings. He was hitting .286 (6-for-21) with a home run and an RBI through his first six games in July with the Rangers. During his previous stint with the E-Train from June 20-28, Smith slashed .235/.308/.382/.690 with two doubles, one home run, five RBI and four walks.

RELIEF IN RENO

RHP Aidan Anderson and RHP Luis Curvelo combined to silence Reno over the final four innings, allowing just one hit while striking out two. Anderson entered in the fifth inning and tossed two scoreless frames, marking his 13th scoreless outing in 21 relief appearances this season and his third scoreless appearance in July. He also recorded multiple strikeouts for the sixth time this year. Curvelo took over in the seventh and fired two scoreless innings of his own in his 18th appearance for the Express. Through his first four outings in July, he owns a 2-0 record with a 5.06 ERA (3 ER/5.1 IP).

THIS DAY IN NOLAN RYAN HISTORY - THURSDAY, JULY 11, 1985

Fans kept their ticket stubs on this date 41 years ago as 38-year-old Nolan Ryan reached 4,000 strikeouts. The Astros beat the New York Mets, 4-3, as Ryan delivered 7.0 innings with three runs, one earned run on seven hits, three walks and 11 strikeouts. The Astros walked it off in the 12th inning on an RBI single from Bill Doran. Ryan earned his 4000th strikeout when he punched out former Astro, Danny Heep on a curveball to open the sixth frame. On a day where he was named a National League All-Star, Ryan had the 20,921 fans enamored. Steve Carlton was on the 21-day disabled list and 96 strikeouts behind Ryan. Hepesed Carlton for good late in the 1984 season and never caught back up to him.

Howard Johnson scored the first run for New York in the second on a double. The Astros cut the lead to one with a Glenn Davis single in the fourth before taking the lead on a Bill Doran single in the fifth. Kevin Bass made it a 3-1 game with a home run in the sixth. Darryl Strawberry cut the deficit with a sacrifice fly in the seventh before a Gary Carter single scored Keith Hernandez moments later. "It'll be quite a few years down the road before anybody else does it," Ryan said postgame. "There are just so many factors involved. You're talking about years of consistency and being healthy enough to pitch enough innings. Only time will tell on anybody." Play was halted for almost three minutes as the crowd took in the historic moment. "The fans got into this game more than any game I've seen since our 1980 playoff series against Philadelphia," Ryan said.

MANAGER KYLE MOORE

The 2026 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Kyle Moore's first season with the E-Train. In 2025, Moore served as the bench coach for Triple-A Iowa of the Chicago Cubs organization. He previously served as the skipper in the Baltimore chain with Short-Season Aberdeen (2018), Low-A Delmarva (2019), High-A Aberdeen (2021) and Double-A Bowie (2022-23) - combining for a 321-286 (.529) record over five seasons. The 2019 Delmarva Shorebirds were named the 2019 MiLB Team of the Year, finishing with a 90-48 record, the most wins across all of MiLB that season.

A catcher in his playing days, Moore signed with the Orioles as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He played collegiately at University of Alabama after winning three high school state titles with Edgewood (Ala.) Academy. Moore transitioned to coaching in 2012 as a strength and conditioning coach with Delmarva.

PITCHING COACH DAVE BORKOWSKI

Former MLB pitcher Dave Borkowski (Boar-COW-ski) enters his fourth season on Round Rock's staff and 17th year in coaching. He will serve as the Express' pitching coach in 2026, reprising the role he held from 2023-24 after spending the 2025 campaign as the club's bullpen coach. Borkowski spent five seasons as a minor league instructor in the Los Angeles Dodgers' farm system.

His tenure also includes an 11-year stint as a minor league coach for the Houston Astros. Prior to joining the coaching ranks, Borkowski enjoyed a 15-year professional playing career that saw him post a 13-20 record and 5.87 ERA across seven MLB seasons with the Detroit Tigers (1999-2001), Baltimore Orioles (2004), and Houston (2006-08). He was originally selected by Detroit in the 11th round of the 1995 MLB Draft out of Sterling Heights (Mich.) High School.

BENCH COACH CHASE LAMBIN

Lambin enters his sixth year on the Express staff and will reprise his role as bench coach for the fifth straight year (beg. 2022). The 2026 campaign will mark Lambin's 12th in the Texas organization. He has previous stops as a hitting coach for High-A Down East (2019), Low-A Hickory (2018), Short-A Spokane (2017), and the Rookie-level Arizona League Rangers (2016). He first joined the Rangers as a member of the Spokane coaching staff in 2015.

Lambin was selected by the New York Mets in the 34th round of the 2002 June draft out of the University of Louisiana at Lafayette and played in the Mets, Marlins, Nationals, Twins, and Royals organizations. He also has international experience, spending the 2009 season with Chiba Lotte in Japan. The versatile defender appeared at every position except catcher over the course of his career.

BULLPEN COACH JULIO VALDEZ

Valdez enters his seventh year in the organization and first as the Rangers' Triple-A pitching coach after serving in the same role with Double-A Frisco (2025), High-A Hickory (2024), Low-A Down East (2023), Rookie-level ACL Rangers (2022), and DSL Rangers (2020-21). During the canceled 2020 campaign, Valdez worked with pitchers at the Dominican Republic complex and Fall Developmental League in Arizona.

The Florida native played baseball at Alabama State University from 2012-16. He attended Lake Howell (Fla.) High School, where he posted a career 15-4 record and 2.20 ERA, and earned all-conference honors as a junior and senior. Valdez transitioned to an assistant coach role at Alabama State in 2017 before becoming Director of Pitching at the Texas Pitching Institute in El Paso, Texas. He spent two years at TPI before taking the same role at Baseball Rebellion in Durham, N.C., before joining the Rangers.

HITTING COACH MATT LAWSON

Former Rangers farmhand Matt Lawson returns for a fifth straight season as Round Rock's hitting coach. Lawson previously served as an assistant coach, hitting instructor, and recruiting coordinator at his alma mater, Missouri State University, from 2014-21. The Missouri native was selected by the Rangers in the 14th round of the 2007 MLB Draft and played seven professional seasons as an infielder in the Texas (2007-10), Seattle (2010), and Cleveland (2011-13) organizations. With Texas, he was named Short-A Spokane's team MVP as a rookie in 2007 and a league All-Star for High-A Bakersfield (2009) and Double-A Frisco (2010) before he was involved in the 2010 trade that brought Cliff Lee to the Rangers.

He holds a degree in psychology and a graduate degree in sports management.

DEVELOPMENT COACH KAWIKA EMSLEY-PAI

Emsley-Pai enters his sixth year in the Texas organization and returns to the Express as a development coach, this after beginning his Rangers tenure in the same role during the 2021 season. He has also served as Double-A Frisco's bench coach (2025) and was a development coach with Frisco (2023-24) and High-A Hickory (2022). He served as the Centralia (Wash.) College head coach and education advocate from 2019-21. Prior to his stint at Centralia, Emsley-Pai had a three-year stint as an education advocate at a maximum-security juvenile rehabilitation facility.

A former catcher in the minor leagues, Emsley-Pai spent six seasons with the Diamondbacks (2010) and Pirates (2011-15) organizations, topping out at Double-A Altoona in 2014. He was originally selected by Arizona in the 10th round of the 2010 June draft out of Lewis-Clark State College in Lewiston, Idaho after spending his freshman year at the University of Texas in 2008.

- Former 2nd round selection by the Chicago White Sox in 2014 is making his return to affiliated baseball for the first time in 7 years and 2 months (2,614 days). Last pitched for Triple-A Charlotte on April 28, 2019 against Indianapolis. Of the 25 players to appear in that game, only Adams and LHP Brandon Waddell (Triple-A Syracuse) are still playing affiliated baseball.
- Signed with Texas on June 24 after opening the season with the Gastonia Ghost Peppers (Atlantic League). Owned a 6-1 record with a 4.42 ERA (28 ER/57.0 IP) in 10 starts.
- Pitched in 2025 with the Gary Southshore RailCats (American Association) in his first professional action since 2019. In 20 starts held a 4.41 ERA (59 ER/120.1 IP).
- White was taken in the second round in 2014 out of White County High School after the White Sox selected LHP Carlos Rodon in the first round. Was committed to play at the University of Georgia but decided to sign with the White Sox. Chicago assistant scouting director Nick Hostetler said after they picked Adams, "we feel like we got a first-round talent in the second round."
- In 2016, Adams was listed as the No. 3 prospect in the White Sox system behind No. 2 prospects SS Tim Anderson and No. 1 prospect, current Tacoma RHP Carson Fulmer.
