TONIGHT'S GAME: Good evening and welcome to LoanMart Field, as the Quakes host the Lake Elsinore Storm (SD) in game three of a brief three-game set. Tonight is IEHP Kids Eat Free Sunday and Baseball Card Set Giveaway to 1,500 fans in attendance. After the game, kids will "Run the Bases" thanks to San Antonio Regional Hospital. Game time is 5pm and tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE STORM: This is the 24th of 30 match-ups and the ninth of 15 here at LoanMart Field during the regular season. The Quakes are 9-14 against the Storm in 2024, 6-2 here at home, but 3-12 at The Diamond. Last season, the Quakes won the season-series (17-13), going 11-7 here at home.

LAST GAME: The Quakes scored the game's final four runs, winning a wild one on Saturday night at LoanMart Field, 4-3 over the Lake Elsinore Storm. Rancho endured a triple play in the eighth, then survived a bases-loaded one-out jam in the ninth, with the Storm's Wyatt Hoffman lining out to a leaping Jeral Perez at shortstop for the final out of the game. Christian Ruebeck retired both batters he faced in the ninth for his third save, while reliever Callum Wallace (2-4) pitched 1.1 innings of scoreless relief for the win. Rancho broke a 3-3 tie in the bottom of the sixth, when Lake Elsinore pitchers Javier Chacon (4-2) and Xavier Ruiz combined for four straight two-out walks, the last of which came to Oswaldo Osorio, forcing home Cameron Decker with the eventual winning run.

SERIES WIN?: The Quakes have a shot at a second straight series win with a victory today over the Storm. Rancho won five of six in last week's series against Stockton, marking their first series win since they took four of six from Inland Empire in the opening days of the second half. It's the second series win they've taken from Stockton this year, after winning three of four at LoanMart Field in the opening home stand of 2024.

CATCHERS WHO HIT: The Quakes have gotten some incredible offensive production lately from their two catchers, as Jesus Galiz and Carlos Rojas are the top two hitters for the Quakes in the second half. Galiz, who saw a nine-game hitting streak come to an end on Friday, is hitting a team-high .457 in the second half, raising his average to .282 entering today's game. Rojas is batting .404 in 13 second-half games, raising his average to a team-best .301 overall.

MCLAIN NAMED PLAYER OF WEEK: Sean McLain was named the league's Player of the Week this past Monday, after destroying Stockton pitching last week. In six games, McLain hit .538 (14-for-26) with two homers and ten RBIs, and an OPS of 1.575. McLain is hitting .299 in 20 second-half games, after only hitting .148 in 32 games in the first half. He enters this series with an average of .211 with three homers and 23 RBIs over 52 total games in 2024.

WYATT CROWELL: Left-hander Wyatt Crowell makes his sixth start for the Quakes and his ninth total appearance of 2024. Crowell has been incredible over his first five starts, allowing just one run on four hits over his first 14 innings. In his last appearance overall, he allowed one hit and one walk, while striking out three over two scoreless innings in a no-decision at Stockton on July 14. Crowell joined the Quakes from the Arizona Complex League, where in four starts, he pitched just six innings, allowing four runs on just two hits, but with four walks and nine strikeouts. The lefty was drafted by the Dodgers in the fourth round of the 2023 draft out of Florida State University.

ISAIAH LOWE: Isaiah Lowe makes his 16th appearance and 12th start of the year, his fifth appearance and third start. In four games against the Quakes, he's 1-1 with a 2.95 ERA, allowing six runs on eight hits over 18.1 innings. Lowe's last start was on July 14, where he suffered a loss to Fresno, allowing three runs on six hits over five innings. Lowe is ranked by MLB Pipeline as the #19 prospect within the San Diego system. He was drafted in the 11th round by the Padres in 2022 out of Combine Academy in Lincolnton, North Carolina.
