THAT FEELS BETTER: After breaking a five-game losing streak with a thrilling 7-6 victory over the Hillcats last night, the FredNats aim to get even in the series with Lynchburg tonight as the final weekend of May has arrived. Tonight, Davian Garcia starts for FXBG looking to build on the two longest and best starts of his professional career in his last couple outings. Garcia got roughed up by the Hillcats the first time he faced them earlier this month, pitching just four innings of five-run ball with four walks. He faces Hillcat righty Jervis Alfaro, a key member of the Hillcats' Carolina-League best starting rotation.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The FredNats scored four runs in the top of the first inning on offense, and eventually held on for a 7-6 victory in what was a wild back-and-forth game with the Hillcats that saw the lead change hands three different times in the game. Nate Rombach and Roismar Quintana both homered, and Cristhian Vaquero threw the potential tying run out at home plate to end the game and preserve the victory for FXBG. The FredNat bullpen covered seven innings and allowed just one run after the starter Angel Roman allowed five runs (four earned). Vaquero drove in the tying run in the 6th with a sac fly, and Luke Dickerson also had a sac fly to drive in the winning run. Merrick Baldo picked up his third save of the year, getting out of bases loaded, nobody out scenario in the 9th, helped by Vaquero's throw.

**MORE OF THAT PLEASE:** FredNat hitters Nate Rombach and Roismar Quintana both blasted their first home runs of the year in last night's win over the Hillcats. Both have power profiles and crush home runs during batting practice each day, and those two swings were the difference last night in a 7-6 victory.

STARTING PITCHING REBOUND: After finishing 10th out of 12 teams in the Carolina League in ERA in the month of April, the FredNat starting rotation has turned it around in a big way in May. This month, Fredericksburg starters have an ERA of 3.66, which is sixth in all of Single-A and third in the Carolina League behind this week's opponent Lynchburg (third at 3.05) and Columbia (3.12). In an eight-game time frame last road trip into last home stand, FredNat starters posted a 1.43 ERA - six earned runs in 47.2 innings - which was the second best mark in Minor League Baseball in that time frame.

**THEY'VE LOCKED IT DOWN**: The FredNats continue to lead the Carolina League in bullpen ERA (3.69) coming into play tonight, and when the group has had chances to close out games late, they've been the best unit in the Carolina League at doing so. Fredericksburg, despite being five games under .500 as a team, is 17-0 when leading after seven innings this year, and 13-0 when leading after eight. Five different FredNats have also recorded saves this year.

**USE THE FORCE**: Shortstop Luke Dickerson is off to a torrid start for the FredNats since his promotion from the FCL two weeks ago. Washington's 6th-best prospect, as ranked by MLB Pipeline, is hitting .294 with an OPS of .877. The 19-year-old already has eight extrabase hits in 15 games played for Fredericksburg. Since his call-up on 5/13, no Single-A hitter has notched more doubles (7) than Dickerson, who also drove in the eventual winning run in last night's game with a sac fly.

**DON'T EVEN TRY IT:** The FredNat catching duo of Kevin Bazzell and Nate Rombach have been prolific at throwing out potential base stealers to start the season. Bazzell is throwing out 41% of base runners this year, which is the best rate in all of MiLB among qualified catchers and he ranks second in all of MiLB with 21 caught stealings. Rombach has 15 caught stealings, which is tied for the 10th-most in Single-A. Rombach is throwing out 32% of potential base stealers this year, which is top-15 in Single-A percentage wise.

**2024 CHAMPIONS**: The 2024 Fredericksburg Nationals won the franchise's sixth total Carolina League championship last September, defeating the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers two games to one to capture the crown. It was the franchise's first since moving to Fredericksburg in 2020, and the first since the Potomac Nationals won the Carolina League in 2014.

**NEW SKIPPER IN TOWN:** After Jake Lowery's third season as Manager of the FredNats ended in a Carolina League championship in 2024, the FredNats welcome Billy McMillon as the third Manager in Fredericksburg franchise history. McMillon, 53, has spent the last three seasons in the Nationals organization as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. Prior to joining the Nationals, he coached for over a decade in the Boston organization, managing at all four full-season levels and also spending three seasons (2016-18) as the organization's base running and outfield coordinator. He also played parts of six seasons in the Major Leagues with Oakland, Detroit, Philadelphia and Florida. He's joined on the staff by returning Pitching Coach Justin Lord, returning Hitting Coach Mike Habas, Development Coach Luis Ordaz, returning Athletic Trainer Jacob Meyer, Strength & Conditioning Coach Mike Reiskind, and Performance Analyst Samantha Unger.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024.

**WELCOME TO FXBG:** Davian Abdiel Garcia...was selected by the Nationals with the 170th overall pick in the 2024 MLB Draft out of Florida Gulf Coast last summer...this is his debut season.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Garcia set a career-high, pitching six full innings last week against Carolina. He cruised through five scoreless before allowing a first-pitch, two-run home run to Eric Bitonti that tied the game 2-2 in the sixth. Garcia rallied to finish the frame, but got a no decision.

**AS OF LATE:** In three of his last four starts, Garcia has pitched at least five innings with five or more strikeouts and two or fewer earned runs. However, of the 14 hits he has allowed in his last four starts, three of them have been home runs: two solo shots and one two-run blast.

**COLLEGE EDUCATED:** Garcia threw for two different schools over the course of his collegiate career. He was an All-ASUN First Team selection at Florida Gulf Coast University as a junior in 2024 after transferring in from Pasco Hernandez State. He finished the 2024 college season as FGCU's Friday night starter after starting the season as a reliever. All in all, he went 6-3 for the Eagles last year, spinning a 3.10 ERA across 61.0 IP and striking out 71 batters. He led the ASUN with a 2.89 conference ERA

## **BILLY MCMILLON - MANAGER**

1st Season | Previously: Development Coach, Triple-A Rochester

McMillon, 53, joined Washington in 2022 and has spent the last three seasons as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. McMillon played parts of six Major League seasons with four different organizations, including the Oakland Athletics (2001-04), Detroit Tigers (2000-01), Philadelphia Phillies (1997), and Florida Marlins (1996-97). The former Clemson Tiger was a three-time International League All-Star and the 1996 IL Rookie of the Year with Charlotte, earning him induction into the IL Hall of Fame in 2019 and Charlotte's Round Table of Honor in 2022. McMillon was initially selected in the eighth round of the 1993 MLB Draft by Florida. He replaces Jake Lowery, who managed the FredNats the last three seasons, culminating in a championship last year. Lowery will manage High-A Wilmington in 2025.

Prior to joining Washington, McMillon coached in the Boston Red Sox organization for over a decade. He managed the Worcester Red Sox (Triple-A) in their inaugural season in 2021 after managing Boston's former Triple-A affiliate Pawtucket in 2019. He was set to lead the PawSox again in 2020 before the cancellation of the MiLB season. Prior to managing at the Triple-A level, McMillon was the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for Boston from 2016-18 after managing for six seasons in the organization with Double-A Portland (2014-15), High-A Salem (2012-13), and Single-A Greenville (2010-11). His coaching career began in 2008 when he was Greenville's Hitting Coach.

Lord, 45, returns to Fredericksburg for a third season in 2025 after leading the FredNats' championship pitching staff last season, including the 2024 Carolina League Pitcher of the Year Travis Sykora.

This is Lord's fifth total season coaching in the Washington organization after a six-year professional playing career and several seasons coaching in the Baltimore system. The Alabama native and Florida State alum was scheduled to be the Fredericksburg Pitching Coach in the canceled 2020 season, and was the Pitching Coach for one season in Double-A Harrisburg prior to joining the FredNats in 2023.



### MIKE HABAS - HITTING COACH

2nd Season | Previously: Hitting Coach, ACL Brewers

Habas, 34, returns to Fredericksburg from the 2024 championship staff for his second season with Washington after leading the FredNat offense to a highly successful season, finishing in the top third of the league in virtually every meaningful offensive category.

Prior to joining the Nationals, he spent spending the previous four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization, most recently as the Hitting Coach for the ACL Brewers in 2022 and 2023. Prior to joining Milwaukee, he was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats. While coaching with Gary, he was also the Head Coach at Prairie State College, a Junior College in the Chicago area.



## LUIS ORDAZ - DEVELOPMENT COACH

Ordaz, 49, joins the FredNat coaching staff in the Development Coach role after managing the Florida Complex League Nationals in 2024.

He played parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues, appearing in 206 career games with the St. Louis Cardinals, Kansas City Royals and Tampa Bay Devil Rays. Ordaz has coached in the Washington organization for over a decade, and was the Hitting Coach for the Potomac Nationals for four seasons from 2016-19. He replaces Carmelo Jaime, who will manage the FCL Nationals in 2025 after three seasons in Fredericksburg.
