### Today's Game

The Fightin Phils hit the road and open up a series at the Portland Sea Dogs, Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox. It is the eighth-of-17 matchups between the teams this season and fifth-of-11 at Delta Dental Park in Portland. Following this week's seven-game series, the Sea Dogs come to Reading from July 18-20 to finish the season series. After winning the 2024 season-series 13-8, Portland holds a 7-0 edge in this year's season-series.

### Game 36 Recap

The Fightin Phils rode their largest comeback of the season en route to a 6-5 win on Sunday afternoon over the New Hampshire Fisher Cats. With the victory, Reading earned its first series-victory of the season, winning the six-game set 4-2. It also finished a week in which all six games between Reading and New Hampshire were decided by one run. Luke Russo started and struggled in his Double-A debut. The righty surrendered four runs on four hits over four innings, along with four walks and four strikeouts. He exited with Reading down 4-0 in the fourth. The Fightin Phils capitalized on New Hampshire walks and wild pitched for a run in the fourth and fifth to tie the game at four, then scored another tally in the bottom of the sixth to grab the lead 5-4. New Hampshire tied the game in the seventh when RJ Schreck homered off Mitch Neunborn, but Reading responded with a solo home run from Seth Beer in the bottom of the seventh to give the Fightin Phils the 6-5 lead. The bullpen was strong as Neunborn tossed three-strong innings, and Josh Hejka and Nelson Alvarez each posted zeroes.

### It's Miller Time

Phillies No. 2 Prospect Aidan Miller is currently riding a season-high six-game hitting streak, and is slashing .381/.458/.619 (1.077 OPS) over that stretch. Miller has now reached base in 25 of his last 28 games played in, dating back to April 12 and has a .350 on-base percentage over that span. Miller has also proven to be a threat on the base paths as his 13 steals rank tied for fifth in the Eastern League.

### Go Keaton Go

Keaton Anthony stayed red-hot with a double in both games of the doubleheader on Saturday. He has doubled in four-straight games, marking the first time a Fightin Phil had doubled in four-straight games since Madison Stokes did it from May 3-7, of the 2023 season. Since May 7 (eight games), Anthony is slashing .419/.455/.742 (1.197 OPS), with four runs, seven doubles, one home run and seven RBI. Entering play today, Anthony holds the following Eastern League ranks: 5th AVG (.318), 10th OBP (.374), 7th SLG (.527), 7th OPS (.901), 1st 2B (15), 2nd XBH (18) and 10th RISP AVG (.341).

### Mashing Mendez

Hendry Mendez capped off a strong week with two more hits and a run scored on Sunday. Last week against New Hampshire (six games), Mendez slashed .364/.375/.727 (1.102 OPS), with five runs, two doubles, two home runs and five RBI. Mendez is eighth in the Eastern League with a .303 average.

### Let's Go Leandro

Leandro Pineda has turned things around in a big way, and it continued with an excellent week against New Hampshire. Last week, Pineda slashed .421/.500/.632 (1.132 OPS), with four runs, four doubles and two RBI. After hitting just .104 in April, Pineda is posting a .304 average in May so far.

### Alumni Spotlight

2022-23 Fightin Phils Mick Abel made his major league debut on Sunday. Abel outdueled reigning National League Rookie of the Year Paul Skenes, as he earned the win, tossing six-shutout innings and striking out nine. His nine strikeouts tied the Phillies franchise record for strikeouts in a major league debut, with Curt Simmons, who set the mark in 1947.

### Packing the Park

Saturday's official attendance of 9,691 was the highest attendance at FirstEnergy Stadium since Aug. 25, 2018, when 9,787 fans watched Reading take on Portland. It was the first crowd over 9,000 since May 28, 2022, when it was 9,528 against Binghamton. Saturday marked the 21st largest crowd in the history of America's Classic Ballpark.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

**May 19, 2004:** At New Hampshire, Gavin Floyd pitches eight no-hit innings only to watch the Fisher Cats plate a run off reliever Eude Brito in the 9th to beat the Phils, 1-0. Floyd strikes out five and walks three.

### From Cats to Dogs

Portland enters today with a 20-15 record, sitting in second place in the Northeast Division. Last week, Portland took two-of-five games at Somerset, with one game being postponed to June. Following this week, the Sea Dogs hit the road and head to Altoona for a six-game series with the Curve. Portland's roster features seven of Boston's top-30 prospects: Luis Peralas (4), David Sandlin (8), Connelly Early (9), Mikey Romero (11), Allan Castro (22), Yordanny Monegro (23) and Blake Wehunt (27).

### Portland Pitcher

Righty, and Red Sox No. 23 prospect, Yordanny Monegro makes the start tonight for Portland. This season, Monegro is 1-1, with a 2.53 ERA over six games/ five starts (21.1 IP, 20 H, 6 BB, 37 SO). He last pitched Thursday at Somerset, suffering the loss, allowing two runs on three hits over five innings, with seven strikeouts. Monegro faced Reading on Apr. 22, allowing three runs (two earned) over 2.1 IP in a no-decision. He spent most of last season with Greenville (A+), going 6-2, with a 2.73 ERA over 15 games with the Drive. The 22-year old signed with the Red Sox in 2020 out of the Dominican Republic.

**LAST START:** 5/15 vs NH: ND, 5.1 IP, 5 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 2 HR, 4 BB, 5 SO, 93 pitches (55 strikes)... The Fightin Phils beat New Hampshire, 11-10, at FirstEnergy Stadium. Cabrera matched a season-high with four runs allowed and also surrendered his first two home runs of the season. He did not allow a run in the first two innings, then was tagged for a solo home run in the top of the third. After a scoreless fourth, Cabrera dealt with traffic in the fifth. He left the game with two runners on and Andrew Bechtold allowed both to score. Cabrera was relieved by Bechtold in the top of the sixth inning.

### 2025 Season:

- Prior to the 2025 season, Cabrera was added to the Phillies 40-man roster (on 11/19/24) to protect him from the Rule-5 Draft
- The Phillies optioned Cabrera to Reading (AA) on March 8
- Appeared in relief for the Phillies in the Spring Breakout Game (3/14 vs PIT) and tossed two innings following Moises Chace, who started the game
- Opens the season ranked as the Phillies No. 11 Prospect (MLB Pipeline)
- Named the Fightin Phils Opening Day starter and allowed 1 ER over 4.2 IP in a no-decision on Apr. 4 vs Portland
- Suffered first loss of season over 4.1 IP at Somerset on Apr. 10
- Earned first victory of season Apr. 16 vs Binghamton, posting season-highs in IP (5.0) and strikeouts (7)
- Threw season-high in innings (6.0), pitches (89) and runs (4) on Apr. 22 at Portland
- Leads team with 25 walks allowed; matched career-high with five May 1 vs HBG
- Had season-best outing May 8 at BNG, matching season-high with six innings and setting season-best with eight strikeouts in no-decision
- Matched season-high with four runs allowed and surrendered first two home runs of season in no-decision May 15 vs New Hampshire

### 2024 Season:

- Began season with Jersey Shore (A+), where he made 14 starts prior to promotion to Reading (AA) on July 9
- Limited LHH to a .190/.261/.286 (.547 OPS) slash line
- Fanned a career-high 14 batters on July 12 vs Wilmington, which was the second-most strikeouts in BlueClaws history
- Collected first Double-A win on Aug. 23 at Binghamton, in his final start of the season
- Over five April starts, posted a 2.25 ERA (7 ER, 28.0 IP)
