### JACKSONVILLE FALLS IN OPENER WITH GWINNETT

The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp lost their third-straight game as they struggled offensively in their opener with the Gwinnett Stripers, falling 6-2 Tuesday night at Coolray Field. After a scoreless opening frame, Gwinnett (30-40) opened the scoring in the bottom of the second. With one out, **Luke Williams** singled off Jacksonville (30-39) starter **Devin Smeltzer** (L, 2-4). A hit batter and a walk loaded the bases before **Joe Hudson** walked to bring in the first run of the game. **Magueris Sierra** reached on a fielder's choice to bring in Gwinnett's second run. The Stripers added two runs in the fifth and sixth innings, taking a 6-0 lead and they never looked back.

### GONE FISHIN'

Since 2021, Jacksonville's first year back in Triple-A, they are an extraordinary 26-11 (.703) against the Gwinnett Stripers. Perhaps most dominantly, in 2022, the clubs matched up 23 times, with Jacksonville winning 17 of those contests (.739). Since 2021, Jacksonville has outscored Gwinnett 179 to 153 or an average of 4.8 to 4.1 runs per game. In four different series last year, the Jumbo Shrimp had a clean sweep, going 4-0 against the Stripers. Since 2021, Jacksonville has lost only one series to Gwinnett (9/29 - 10/3).

### THE BRIAN KING

Heading into play on May 12, **Brian Miller** had posted just a .217/.318/.633 line for the season. However, over the last 30 games, the Durham, N.C., native is 31-for-101 (.307/.393/.416/.809) with seven doubles, two triples, eight RBIs and 14 runs scored. After posting an 8.2 percent walk rate in 2022, Miller is walking in 10.7 percent of his plate appearances this season. He has chopped his ground ball rate from 46.3 percent to 37.8 percent.

### CHICKS ARE DIGGING IT

In the 11 games from May 14-26, the Jumbo Shrimp launched just nine home runs, tied for the fifth-fewest in Triple-A. However, over the last 22 contests, Jacksonville has blasted 28 long balls, including a season-high six on May 27 against Charlotte, their most at notoriously pitcher-friendly 121 Financial Ballpark since hitting seven against the Carolina Mudcats on June 4, 2010. Those 28 home runs are tied for 15th-most in Triple-A over the last 22 games.

### YOU CAN ONLY PLAY WHO'S IN FRONT OF YOU

Jacksonville's 30-39 record is tied for 16th in the International League, but the Jumbo Shrimp have played arguably the most difficult schedule in the circuit. Fifty-three of the club's 69 games, or 76.8 percent, have come against teams with a record of at least .500. That figure is by far the most in the league with Gwinnett sitting second with 48 games against teams with a winning record. Jacksonville is 23-30 (.434) against teams who have posted a record of at least .500.

### IT'S \*STARTING\* TO TURN AROUND

Over the 27 games from May 5-June 4, Jacksonville starting pitchers combined to surrender 103 runs, 100 earned, on 142 hits (12.4 H/9) in 103.1 innings for an 8.71 ERA. During this stretch, Jacksonville starters walked 64 (5.8 BB/9) against only 75 strikeouts (6.5 K/9). However, over the last 13 contests, the club's starting pitching has improved considerably. Over this recent 13-game stretch, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have totaled 33 runs, 33 earned, on 55 hits (8.8 H/9) in 56.0 innings for a 5.30 ERA with 40 strikeouts (6.4 K/9) against 21 walks (3.4 BB/9). Jacksonville starters have yielded one run or fewer in five of these last 13 contests.

### FOUR SCORE AND ONE MONTH AGO

The Jumbo Shrimp have scored at least four runs in 10 of their last 13 games, going 6-7 in that span. The Jumbo Shrimp are being outscored 65 to 63 during this run. After going 0-6 to close out May and open the month of June, Jacksonville has won four of their last seven. The Jumbo Shrimp's longest stretch of scoring at least four runs stands at 10 (April 27-May 7). During that run, Jacksonville went 7-3 and outscored their opponents 65 to 49.

### SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville snapped a four-series losing streak by splitting their series last week with Nashville. After falling in the final two contests last weekend against Memphis, Jacksonville has split their last two series and have now gone without a series win for over one month (May 2-7). **Collin Lowe** became the 15th different pitcher to start for the Jumbo Shrimp in 2023...In 2022, 25 different starters took the mound for Jacksonville, which was a franchise record.
