YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels snapped their five-game losing streak with a 14-5 win over the Somerset Patriots. In the first inning, **David Villar** and **Bruce Maxwell** knocked RBI singles and **Andres Angulo** brought in a run with a groundout to give the Flying Squirrels a 3-0 lead. In the bottom of the first, Somerset got solo homers from Luke Voit and Oswald Peraza, their first two batters of the game, to close back within one. **Frankie Tostado** brought in a run with a single in the third and **Jacob Heyward** followed with a sac fly to open a 5-2 lead. In the fourth, Villar hit a solo homer, his seventh of the year, and Heyward hit a solo shot for his fifth of the season in the top of the fifth to extend the lead to 8-2. The Patriots scored in the fifth on an error to close the gap to 8-3, but Richmond scored six runs in the seventh to put the game out of reach. Tostado, Heyward **Andy Sugilio**, **Kyle Mottice** and **Heliot Ramos** each had RBIs in the inning. **Akeel Morris** made his Flying Squirrels debut and picked up a win after allowing three runs (two earned) in 5.0 innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game series against the Somerset Patriots, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees at TD Bank Ballpark. The game is the first for the Flying Squirrels against the Patriots, who are in their first season as an affiliated team. This is Richmond's only trip to Somerset this season. The Flying Squirrels will host the Patriots for a six-game series at The Diamond from July 13-18.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost six of the last eight games. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 6.0 games behind first-place Bowie. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked tied for eighth in the league with a .231 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked third in the league with a 3.68 ERA for the season.

THE PATRIOTS have won five straight games and sit in first place in the Double-A Northeast Division, 2.5 games ahead of Portland. The Somerset offense is ranked seventh in the Double-A Northeast with a .246 batting average. The Patriots' pitching staff is leading the league with a 3.09 ERA, which is ranked second in all of the minors. The Patriots are in their first season as an affiliated team after picking up the Yankees affiliation during Major League Baseball's restructuring of the minor leagues this past offseason. The Yankees' Double-A affiliation was previously with the Trenton Thunder from 2003-2020. The Patriots were a founding member of the independent Atlantic League in 1998 and went on to win five league titles (2001, 2003, 2005, 2008, 2009 and 2015). Somerset's roster includes five of MLB.com's top-30 Yankees prospects, including SS Oswald Peraza (4), RHP Luis Medina (7), LHP Ken Waldichuk (27), RHP Glenn Otto (28) and RHP Hayden Wesneski (30).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Michael Plassmeyer** makes second Richmond start and his second against Somerset. He was traded from the Tampa Bay Rays to the San Francisco Giants last Saturday in exchange for right-handed pitcher Matt Wisler. He made his Richmond debut on Tuesday and allowed a career-high seven runs over 4.2 innings of work. Plassmeyer began the season with Double-A Montgomery in the Double-A South. In his first four outings of the year, he went 0-1 with a 7.36 ERA (12 ER/14.2 IP). In his last three outings before the trade, all in relief, he combined for a 2-0 record over 15.0 scoreless innings with 18 strikeouts and two walks. Plassmeyer was originally drafted by the Seattle Mariners in the fourth round in 2018 out of the University of Missouri, but he was traded to Tampa Bay after one professional season along with catcher Mike Zunino and outfielder Guillermo Heredia for outfielders Mallex Smith and Jake Fraley. In his first season with the Rays organization in 2019, his first full professional season, Plassmeyer posted a 1.91 overall ERA, which was the third-lowest for a pitcher in Tampa Bay's minor league system in the history of the franchise, trailing only a 1.41 ERA by Blake Snell in 2015 and a 1.77 ERA by Dylan Floro in 2013. **For more on Plassmeyer, see page two.**

FOR SOMERSET: Right-hander Glenn Otto makes his seventh start and eighth overall appearance of the season. It is also his second start against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched on Tuesday, when he picked up 14 strikeouts over 7.0 innings and allowed one run on three hits. His 14 strikeouts were tied for the most by a pitcher in the Double-A this season, matching his own mark from May 20 at Hartford. He is currently ranked tenth in the league in ERA (3.95), first in strikeouts (69), tied for third in innings pitched (41.0), fourth in opponents' average (.209), fourth in WHIP (1.02) and ninth in winning percentage (.600). He was named the first Double-A Northeast Pitcher of the Week this season on May 9. Otto was drafted by the Yankees in the fifth round in 2017 out of Rice.

TOASTY: Over his last 10 games since June 6, **Frankie Tostado** is batting .316 (12-for-38) with one homer and nine RBIs. He is now second on the team this season with 19 RBIs. He leads qualified Richmond batters with a .267 batting average on the year.

FABULOUS FABIAN: Over his last 13 games since June 1, **Sando Fabian** is batting .368 (14-for-38) with one homer, five doubles and nine RBIs while scoring four runs. Fabian hit .184 through his first 18 games of the season, but his performance since June 1 has raised his season average to .264.

TORRES ON A TEAR: In his last nine games since June 1, **Bryan Torres** is batting .333 (7-for-21) with one double and two RBIs. He has seen time defensively this season at catcher, second base and third base. Torres is in his first Double-A season. Prior to 2021, he had not played higher than the rookie level.

MO' TIME: Over his last nine games since June 5, **Kyle Mottice** is batting .300 (9-for-30) with a double and four RBIs. On the season, he is batting .371 (13-for-35) against left-handed pitchers compared to .203 (13-for-64) against right-handers. He has hit the ball to the opposite field on 47.1 percent of his balls put in play, which is the highest rate in the Double-A Northeast.

BREAKING OUT: After going 0-for-14 over four games from June 10-15, **David Villar** has hit .500 (7-for-14) with two homers and five RBIs over his last four games since Wednesday. He picked up three hits on Wednesday night, tying a season high, and added a solo homer on Thursday. He went deep again on Friday to take the team home run (7) and RBI (21) lead.

STRONG START: The Flying Squirrels' 22-19 record is tied the second-best start in team history through 41 games, even with the 2014 and 2018 seasons. The only season with a better start through 41 games was a 23-18 start in the franchise's inaugural season in 2010.

GETTING ON THE BOARD: Dating back to August 25, 2019, the Flying Squirrels have scored at least one run in 50 consecutive games. That streak includes all 41 games of the 2021 season. The next closest streak in the league is Bowie, which has not been shut out in 48 consecutive games dating back to August 23, 2019.

LAW OF AVERAGES: The 12 teams in the Double-A Northeast have combined to hit .239 this season. In 2019, the Eastern League combined for a .238 batting average, which was the lowest for the circuit since a .234 mark in 1971 and the sixth-lowest since the league was first classified as "Double-A" in 1963.

LEAVING THEM LOADED: Over the last 16 games since June 1, the Flying Squirrels have hit .192 (28-for-146) with runners in scoring position. For the season, the Flying Squirrels are batting .152 (5-for-33) with the bases loaded, which is last in the league. In those 30 at-bats with the bases loaded, the Flying Squirrels have combined to pick up 15 RBIs.

PITCHERS WHO RAKE: For the season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Double-A Northeast with seven hits, six RBIs and four runs scored by pitchers at the plate. Richmond is also tied with Hartford for first in the league with three walks worked by pitchers while batting. On the year, Richmond has gone 19-11 (.633) against National League affiliates, but have gone 2-4 (.333) against affiliates of American League clubs. After using the designated hitter for this week's series against Somerset, pitchers will return to the batter's box for the next two sets against Hartford and Binghamton. After July 4, the Flying Squirrels will return to using the DH for the remaining four series in July.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Heliot Ramos** (3), **Tristan Beck** (12), **Sean Hjelle** (13) and **Jose Marte** (30). Ramos is also rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 83 overall prospect. Four players, Ramos (3), Hjelle (11), Beck (20) and **Caleb Kilian** (30) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
