PLAYOFF BOUND

The Omaha Storm Chasers won the International League 1st Half title with a 49-24 record and 3.5-game lead on second-place Syracuse to end the half, the best Minor League team in the 1st half of the 2024 season.

- Winning the first half in the league secures the Storm Chasers home field advantage in the International League Championship Series, a best-of-three series that will be played at Werner Park from September 24 to 26.
- This September will mark Omaha's first appearance in the playoffs since 2014, when the Chasers won their 2nd of back-to-back Triple-A National Championships.
- The Triple-A Omaha franchise has 17 playoff appearances in the last 55 years, including most recently four straight seasons: 2011 to 2014.

NOTES AND NUGGETS

IN GOOD STANDINGS

While the standings re-set for the start of the 2nd half on June 25, Omaha's enters today's game with the 3rd-best overall record in Minor League Baseball, 24 games over .500 with a 54-30 record (.643 winning percentage).

- 54 wins are the 2nd-most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season, two behind the 56-win Sugar Land Space Cowboys (Astros Triple-A).
- Of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .643 winning percentage overall this year just behind Sugar Land (.651) and Lakeland (.651).
- Omaha held the best record in Minor League Baseball for 30 days, June 5 to July 5 ... the Chasers have still been 1st or 2nd in the Minors in wins every day since May 25.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

64 of Omaha's 83 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or less, including 21 of 30 losses in 2024, with 11 of 21 losses by just one run.

- Close games have been a struggle for Omaha in recent weeks, with the bullpen converting just 5 of its last 13 save opportunities, since June 5.
- Omaha is 17-11 in 1-run games this season, which ranks as the 3rd-most 1-run wins of any Minor League team.
- As a team, Omaha's 25 saves are tied for the 6th-most of any Minor League team and second in Triple-A ... **Will Klein's** 9 saves individually rank 3rd in the International League, while six Storm Chasers players have 2 or more saves this year.

I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT (IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 469 to 378 this season, a +91 run differential.

- A +91 run differential ranks 2nd-best both in the International League and at the Triple-A level, just behind Syracuse (+93).
- Omaha ranks 7th in Minor League Baseball in run differential ... the Greensboro Grasshoppers lead the Minors at +153 (498 to 345).

DAZZLING DEFENSE

Omaha's defense has had its ups and downs this season, but the team is on one of its best stretches in the field this season.

- Over Omaha's last 24 games (since June 9), a .989 fielding percentage (9 errors in 832 total chances) is the 2nd-best in Minor League Baseball over that span.
- The Storm Chasers have not made an error in 8 of the team's last 11 games, with a streak of 6 errorless games snapped yesterday ... early in the season, Omaha went 7 straight games without making an error, March 31 to April 7.

COMEBACK KIDS

Omaha has 31 come-from-behind wins this season, meaning over half (57%) of this year's wins have been games where the Chasers trailed at some point.

- The Storm Chasers have come back from down as many as 5 runs to win and have overcome a 3+ run deficit to win on 10 occasions.
- Omaha has trailed for three innings or more in 11 of the 31 comeback wins, with five victories where the club had to overcome multiple deficits ... the team has 8 wins in games where they trailed after the 6th inning.

RELIEF AID

Omaha's bullpen has been one of the best across the entire Triple-A level in 2024.

- The Storm Chasers relievers lead all Triple-A bullpens with a 3.64 ERA, 1.31 WHIP and an opposing slash line of .207/.319/.353 ... the .207 opponents' average is tied for the 2nd-best in the Minors.
- Omaha's bullpen has combined to not allow a run in 19 games this year, roughly one in every 4.42 games ... however, 13 consecutive games entering today without a scoreless bullpen effort is the longest stretch for the team this season.
- Despite recent struggles, since June 14, Omaha's bullpen has a 3.08 ERA (27 ER in 79.0 IP), the best in Triple-A in that 21-game stretch.
- Noah Murdock** made his Triple-A debut June 11 in Toledo and opened his Triple-A career with 8.0 scoreless innings over 7 appearances ... in 9 total Triple-A outings this year, Murdock has a 0.84 ERA (1 ER in 10.2 IP) with 12 strikeouts.
- Jesus Tinoco** has thrown 3 scoreless appearances since joining Omaha out of free agency ... he has a 0.00 ERA (0 ER in 3.1 IP) with 6 strikeouts since June 27.

- Veneziano is making his 8th start of the season, his 21st Triple-A appearance and 23rd overall appearance in 2024 ... Anthony is on his 4th stint in Triple-A, he has also pitched two Major League games in relief for the Royals over 3 stints ... he has only pitched in Triple-A since April 22 but was on Kansas City's MLB roster June 13-14.
Since 2019, his 445.0 innings are the most of any Kansas City farmhand ... Veneziano also leads the Royals organization across this 5-season span in Minor League strikeouts (467), starts (90) and is tied 1st in wins (28).
Ranked by MLB Pipeline as the No. 13 Royals prospect... and ranked by Baseball America as the No. 5 Royals prospect.

LAST OUTING: SUNDAY, JUNE 30 @ COLUMBUS

Opened his second start of the week with 3.0 scoreless innings, retired 9 of his first 11 batters, worked around a pair of walks in the 1st inning and fired 1-2-3 innings in the 2nd and 3rd ... ran into trouble in a 27-pitch 4th inning where the Clippers sent all 9 batters to the plate, he allowed a walk, three singles and a three-run homer to bring the score from 6-0 in favor of Omaha to a 6-5 game, a one-run lead ... did not come back out for the fifth inning, his day ended at a season-high 84 pitches and 20 batters faced.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Optioned to Omaha on March 20 and pitched in 5 games (2 starts) before getting recalled April 17 by Kansas City ... optioned on April 18, pitched 2.0 innings for Omaha, then recalled April 20 and pitched 2 games in relief for the Royals ... optioned again April 22.
Opened the year in Omaha's rotation, moved to the bullpen the third week of the season and made 10 consecutive relief appearances in Triple-A between April 9 and May 21 ... 5 of his last 8 outings have been starts, since May 24.

CAREER NOTES

- 2023
Opened the year with NW Arkansas (AA) and started Opening Day for NWA ... threw at least 5.0 innings and struck out at least 5 in all 8 Double-A starts, with four scoreless starts ... promoted to Triple-A on May 19 and was named Omaha's pitcher of the week, with a 4.22 ERA (42 ER in 89.2 IP) over 18 games (17 starts) ... combined to go 10-5 with a 3.55 ERA (52 ER in 132.0 IP) and 127 strikeouts (8.66 K/9) in the Minors, before he was called up to the big leagues on September 19 to end the year with the Royals.
Among Royals Minor League pitchers: ranked 2nd in wins (10), 2nd in innings (132.0) and 5th in strikeouts (127).
Threw 7 quality starts between the Naturals and Chasers ranked second in the system ... finished 2nd in Omaha with 5 quality starts, including 2 of his final 3 Triple-A outings before his MLB call-up.
Earned his first Major League call-up on September 19, brought up with RHP Jonathan Bowlan ... waited a week to make his MLB debut on September 26 at Detroit and 2 unearned runs scored ... pitched 1.1 scoreless innings September 28 at Detroit.

- 2022
Spent the entire year with NW Arkansas (AA) and went 6-9 over 26 outings (25 starts) with a 5.72 ERA (78 ER in 122.2 IP) and 129 strikeouts ... made a team-best 8 quality starts and led the Naturals staff in games started and innings pitched.
All 8 of his quality starts came over his last 15 of the season beginning with a 7-inning complete-game shutout on June 9 at Tulsa (LAD), the first complete game of his career and most innings pitched ... was named the Texas League's Pitcher of the Week for June 6-13 after this start, with 5 strikeouts over 7.0 shutout innings.
Over his first 9 games (8 starts) in April and May, went 1-4 with a 8.44 ERA (30 ER in 32.0 IP) with 25 strikeouts (7.03 K/9) ... over his last 17 starts from June to September, went 5-5 with a 4.76 ERA (48 ER in 90.2 IP) with 104 strikeouts (10.32 K/9).

- 2019
Spent the entire year with Quad Cities (A+), named the River Bandits' Pitcher of the Year ... appeared twice in the High-A Central All-Star team, as the league's Pitcher of the Year and as the left-handed starting pitcher representative on the All-Star team.
His 127 strikeouts led the Royals organization, while 22 starts tied for 2nd and 93.2 innings ranked 7th ... among Royals Minor League pitchers who threw at least 90.0 innings, ranked 1st with 12.20 K/9 and a 32.3% K% ... tied for the High-A Central Lead in strikeouts.

- 2019
Spent his first season in pro ball with Idaho Falls (R) in the Pioneer League ... did not allow an earned run in the first 4 games (11.0 innings) of his career, a 4-outing (2 start) span between June 17 and July 3, striking out 9 along the way.

Attended Coastal Carolina University, where he pitched in 49 games (35 starts) across three seasons with the Chanticleers (Sun Belt Conference) and went 14-6 with a 5.04 ERA (99 ER in 176.2 IP) with 187 strikeouts.

Graduated from Warren Hills High School (N.J.) in 2016, where he had a 0.74 ERA and 64 strikeouts in 47.1 innings as a senior, while leading his team in steals ... threw 9.0 no-hit innings with 16 strikeouts in a game that year but got a no-decision in an 1-0 loss (11 innings).

QUICK NOTES

2024: Opened this year on Kansas City's 60-Day Injured list, as he makes his recovery from Tommy John surgery ... began his rehab assignment on May 7 in the Arizona Complex League ... transferred to NW Arkansas (AA) on May 19 and made 2 starts in Double-A, then transferred to Omaha on May 27 for 5 starts ... has been pitching in the bullpen since June 25, will now work as a regular reliever for the first time in his pro career.
This is his 7th season in the Royals organization ... skipped over the Double-A and Triple-A levels to make his MLB debut in 2020 and has almost exclusively pitched in the big leagues since, outside of a short stint in Omaha in 2022.
Since debuting with Kansas City in 2020, his 325.0 innings and 60 games started for the Royals rank third among the club's pitchers in that span.
Only made three starts in 2023, his 4th MLB season ... placed on the Injured List on April 16 with a left flexor strain and underwent Tommy John surgery in late April.

2024: Did not appear in any Cactus League games for the Royals, opened the year on Omaha's Injured List ... assigned to NW Arkansas (AA) on April 16 and pitched 5.1 scoreless innings for the Naturals (4 outings) ... assigned to Omaha for his 4th season with the Chasers on April 29 ... has largely pitched in relief this year, with 2 opener starts ... has 8 scoreless outings and 8 outings of 2.0 innings or more, with at least 1 strikeout in 15 of 18 appearances.
Opened the 2023 season with Omaha and pitched in 5 games (4 starts) before his contract was selected by Kansas City on May 3, threw 2.0 scoreless innings in MLB Debut on 5/4 vs. BAL ... totaled 3 stints with each Omaha and Kansas City by the end of the season ... 4 of 12 appearances with Omaha were scoreless, including 3 starts.
