RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (9-6)





RHP Hyun-Seok Jang (0-1, 6.52 ERA) vs. RHP Yeferson Vargas (2-1, 4.76 ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: The Quakes open a six-game road trip to San Bernardino, taking on the Inland Empire 66ers (Angels) in the opening game of a six-game series at San Manuel Stadium. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com. VS THE 66ERS: Today's game is the first of 24 between these two teams in 2025 and the first of 12 here at San Manuel Stadium. Last year, the Quakes went 10-2 here in San Bernardino, 17-7 overall.

LAST GAME: The Quakes earned their second walk-off win of the series, as San Jose's sixth error of the game allowed Elijah Hainline to score the winning run in the last of the ninth, as the Quakes won an 11-10 thriller over the Giants on Sunday afternoon at LoanMart Field. Hainline led off the ninth with a double against Giants' reliever Cameron Pferrer (1-1) and scored when Eduardo Guerrero's ground ball to first was mishandled by the pitcher covering the bag. The Quakes rallied from an early 5-0 deficit, but couldn't hold leads of 7-5 and 10-7, as the Giants hit back-to-back homers in the eighth to even the game at 10-10. Rancho reliever Ryan Brown (1-0) tossed a scoreless ninth for the win. **STEADY IMPROVEMENT OFFENSIVELY:** The Quakes had an up-and-down series offensively against San Jose, but were much better over the last two games. After being held to just 15 hits over a three-game stretch, the Quakes had 19 hits over their final two games, including 11 in their 11-10 victory on Sunday. Rancho is now hitting .238, fourth in the league. They have scored 85 runs, also fourth in the league.

ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes activated Niko Perez on Tuesday, after hitting the Injured List with a hamstring injury during the team's first road trip in Stockton.

STILL WEARING THE SAME SHOE: The Quakes have welcomed back Manager John Shoemaker, who returns to Rancho to guide the Quakes for a fifth straight year, a franchise record. The club is 271-243 in four seasons under "Shoe", having made the playoffs twice, including one appearance in the Championship Series (2023). The Quakes have only one returning coach to this year's club, as pitching coach Ramon Troncoso returns to Rancho, joining Shoemaker for his fifth year as well. New members of the coaching staff include hitting coach Johermyn Chavez, pitching coach Brandon Bailey, Bench Coach Dunior Zerpa, Bullpen Coach and former Quake Marco Hernandez, Athletic Trainer Alfredo Casillas, Performance Coach Jake Taylor and Video Associate Max Delorme.

PROSPECT HEAVY: According to MLB Pipeline's rankings the Dodgers have stocked the Quakes with seven of their top-30 prospects. In order, they are: INF Kellon Lindsey (#8), OF Eduardo Quintero (#9), INF Joendry Vargas (#12), RHP Hyun-Seok Jang (#17), OF Mike Sirota (#21), OF Jaron Elkins and RHP Samuel Sanchez (#28). Of the 29 active players on the Rancho roster, 15 of them saw time in a Quakes' uniform in 2024.

HYUN-SEOK JANG: Right-hander Hyun-Seok Jang makes his fourth start of the year and his first against Inland Empire. In his last outing, he allowed two runs on two hits over 3.1 innings, with three walks and four strikeouts in a no-decision against San Jose on April 16th. Jang went 1-2 with an 8.14 ERA over 13 games (10 starts) and 24.1 innings pitched in the ACL last year, before finishing the year with five starts in Rancho, where he went 0-1 with a 2.19 ERA over 12 innings pitched. Jang, who signed with the Dodgers in August of 2023 out of South Korea, was regarded as the top pitching prospect coming out of Korea in 2023 and is rated by MLB Pipeline as the Dodgers' 17th best prospect.

YEFERSON VARGAS: Right-hander Yeferson Vargas makes his fourth start of the year and his first against the Quakes. In his last outing, he allowed one run on two hits over five innings in a win at Modesto on April 16th. Vargas originally signed with the Boston Red Sox in June of 2023 out of the Dominican Republic. He was traded from Boston to the Angels in July of 2024 as part of the deal that sent RHP Luis Garcia to the Red Sox.
