FOR STARTERS: The Rocket City Trash Pandas wrap up a six-game homestand against the Birmingham Bar-ons, Double-A affiliate of the Chicago White Sox. Rocket City is coming off a 2-4 road trip in Biloxi and looks to bounce back in the first matchup of the second half against Birmingham. This marks the third of four series between the division rivals this season, with the final meeting set for August 19-24 at Regions Field.

TRASH PANDAS EDGED IN EXTRAS BY BARONS, 3-2: The Rocket City Trash Pandas dropped a hardfought 3-2 extra-inning loss to the Birmingham Barons in 11 innings Saturday night at Toyota Field. Evan Edwards gave Rocket City an early lead with a solo homer, and starter Walbert Ureña delivered seven strong innings. The game remained tied 1-1 into extras before Birmingham scored twice in the 11th. Korey Holland's RBI single brought Rocket City within one, but the rally fell short. Holland finished 3-for-5 in his return. Birmingham's win sealed a series victory for the Barons.

COSMIC SHAKEUP: TRASH PANDAS HIT BY 16 ROSTER MOVES ON SATURDAY: The Angels announced 16 roster moves that impacted the Rocket City Trash Pandas. Headlining the changes were the promotions of RHP **Brady Choban**, INF **Denzer Guzma**n, and OF **Nelson Rada** to Triple-A Salt Lake. On the injury Front, OF Joe Redfield, RHP Jordan Holloway, and INF Evan White were placed on the 60-day Injured List. The Angels gave an unconditional release to RHP Sean Poppen. Joining the Trash Pandas from Triple-A Salt Lake is OF Korey Holland, while seven players were added from High-A Tri-City: INF Matt Coutney, RHP Max Gieg, INF Ryan Nicholson, RHP Roman Phansalkar, LHP Dylan Phillips, RHP Jake Smith, and INF Arol Vera.

**TWO MORE ON SUNDAY:** RHP **Bryce Osmond** returned from his rehab assignement with the ACL Angels, and was reinstated from the 60-day IL. Before injury, his last outing was September 14, 2023 at Tennessee. To make room, C **Jaxx Groshans** was placed on the Development List.

**PUTTING IN THE WORK:** Three Trash Pandas hurlers rank among the top nine in the Southern League in innings pitched with **Walbert Urena** ranking 3rd with 97.1 innings pitched, followed by **Mitch Farris** (7th, 92.1 IP), and **Sam Aldegheri** (T-9th, 89.2 IP).

WALBERT IS IN HIS UREÑA OF EXCELLENCE: RHP Walbert Urena has a 2.05 ERA (5 ER/22.0 IP) over his last four starts since July 9. Urena rankes among the league leaders in games started (T-1st, 20), innings pitched (3rd, 97.1), and complete games (T-1st, 1).

KLASSEN AND ALDEGHERI DEALT IN JULY: LHP Sam Aldegheri and RHP George Klassen were two of the Southern League's best starters in July. Aldegheri has led the league with a 0.78 ERA. In four starts, the left-hander went 3-0, allowing just four earned runs over 23.0 innings while recording 19 strikeouts and 10 walks. Klassen finished T-1st in the league with 26 strikeouts over four starts, finishing with a 3.32 ERA, striking out 26 and walking seven across 21.2 innings.

PITCHING STAFF PACKED A PUNCH IN JULY: The Rocket City pitching staff racked up 213 strikeouts over 24 games in July—an average of 8.9 strikeouts per game—ranking 3rd in the Southern League and 9th across all of Double-A.

SAM BROWN TRADED TO NATS: On Wednesday, the Angels traded Trash Pandas first baseman Sam Brown to the Washington Nationals as part of a four-player deal. A 2023 12th-round pick out of Washington State, Brown hit. 244 with 12 doubles, five homers, and 40 RBI in 92 games for Rocket City this season. He was named Southern League Player of the Week in mid-July and ranked fourth in batting average in May. In return, the Angels received LHP Andrew Chafin and RHP Luis García, while LHP Jake Eder also goes to Washington. José Quijada was designated for assignment.

FARRIS WHEELING AND DEALING STRIKEOUTS: LHP Mitch Farris became the seventh pitcher in Trash Pandas history to record 100 strikeouts in a single season, reaching the milestone in his 17th start on July 25 at Biloxi. He currently ranks 2nd in the Southern League with 110 strikeouts across 19 appearances (18 starts) in 2025, trailing only Montgomery's Brody Hopkins, who leads with 112. Farris is currently tied for 4th in team history for single-season strikeouts, matching Chase Silseth's 110 from 2022. He trails **Brett Kerry** (118, 2022), **Coleman Crow** (128, 2022), and franchise record-holder **Caden Dana**, who struck out 147 batters in 2024.

ROCKET CITY LIVED UP TO ITS NAME IN JULY: In July, the Trash Pandas launched 19 home runs over 24 games, 3rd in the Southern League and ranking T-10th in all of Double-A baseball. That stretch included a five-homer outburst on July 3 against Knoxville at Toyota Field, tying a franchise record. The surge was fueled by **Oscar Colás** and **Ben Gobbel**, who combined for 10 of the 19 homers. Colás led the league in that span with six, while Gobbel was T-4th.

**SOUND THE BLANKENHORN:** OF **Travis Blankenhorn** has reached base in 30 of 38 games since returning from the Injured List on June 13. The veteran outfielder is tied for the league with eight home runs, and ranks 7th in the Southern League with an .791 OPS with six doubles, a triple, eight home runs, 20 RBIs, and 19 walks over that span.

COLÁS BROUGHT THE BOOM IN JULY: Rocket City outfielder Oscar Colás finished July 4th in all of Dou-ble-A with six home runs, plus he has three doubles, 15 RBIs, and 11 runs scored. On July 3 vs. Knoxville, Colás recorded his first career three-homer game, hitting solo home runs to lead off the third, fourth, and sixth innings. That marked only the second three-homer game in franchise history, the first being Orlando Martinez's performance on May 7, 2021, at Chattanooga.

#### ADDITIONAL NOTES (CONT)

- RADA REPORT: CF Nelson Rada, moves to Triple-A after being the youngest player in the Southern League the past two seasons, He ranked 3rd in the league and 5th in all of Double-A with 34 stolen bases at the time of his promotion on August 2—19 of which came in a blistering month of May. His 34 steals ranked 3rd in Trash Pandas single-season history, trailing only his own mark of 35 from last year and Kyren Parris' franchise record of 44 set in 2023. Rada ranked among the league leaders at the time of his promotion in stolen bases (3rd, 34), OBP (5th, 380), batting average (12th, 277), and hits (T-9th, 91). Rada had a team-best 26 multi-hit games, including five three-hit games.
- GUZMAN BLAZED THROUGH JULY: The San Pedro de Macorís native was named the Trash Pandas Player of the Month, and was one of the hottest hitters in Double-A last month, leading the Southern League—and was 5th in all of Double-A—with a 1.020 OPS, 47 total bases, and 13 extra-base hits. He ranked 2nd in the league with a .333 batting average and is also was tops in slugging (.580) and 2nd in on-base percentage (.440). His nine doubles rank 2nd in the league, and his 27 hits were T-5th. On July 13 in Chattanooga, he recorded the second five-hit game in Trash Pandas history, going 5-for-5 with three doubles, a home run, and four RBIs. He ranked among the league leaders at the time of his promotion in several categories, including doubles (2nd, 23), extra-base hits (T-1st, 35), RBIs (6th, 53), total bases (T-6th, 139), home runs (T-7th, 11), and slugging (7th, .415), and OPS (12th, .749). Guzman led the team with 16 multi-RBI games.
- GUZMAN AND BROWN GO BACK-TO-BACK FOR LEAGUE POW: INF Denzer Guzman was named Southern League Player of the Week for July 1-6 after leading the league with a 1.316 DPS and seven extra-base hits, along with six RBIs and six walks during a six-game series against Knoxville. One week later, INF Sam Brown earned the honor for July 8-13, posting a league-best .444 batting average (8-for-18) over five games in Rocket City's road series at Chattanooga. Brown added four extra-base hits, six RBIs, five walks, four runs scored, and a 1.398 DPS—also the highest in the league that week. Guzman and Brown became the 13th and 14th players in Trash Pandas history to win the award, and for the second consecutive season, Rocket City produced back-to-back weekly honorees, following Tucker Flint (Aug. 12-18) and Christian Moore (Aug. 5-11) in 2023.
- BACK FROM THE FUTURES GAME: RHP George Klassen made a brief but electric appearance for the American League squad at the Futures Game on July 19, throwing 11 pitches in the bottom of the third inning. He fired two 99 mph heaters—striking out Chicago's Owen Caissie. The No. 3 prospect for the Angels was the only representative for the Angels and became the sixth Rocket City player to earn a Futures Game selection, joining RHP Caden Dana ('24), OF Kyren Paris (' 23), C Edgar Quero (' 23), RHP Ky Bush (' 22), and LHP Reid Detmers ('21).
- KEEPIN' IT QUALITY: Starter Joel Hurtado, has not made a start since June 20, but still ranks third in the Southern League with seven quality starts, and ranks fifth in the Southern League with a 3.10 ERA.
- ANOTHER ONE LAUNCHED TO THE LEAGUE: On July 3, INF Chad Stevens made his MLB debut for the Angels, becoming the seventh this season, and 43rd all-time Trash Panda to make their MLB debut. In 17 games for Rocket City in 2024, he hit .316 with two homers, 10 RBIs, and two stolen bases over 17 games. He joins former Pandas, Robinson Piña (debuted on June 20), Christian Moore (debuted on June 13), Alan Rangel (June 6), José Fermin (April 26), Edgar Quero (April 16), and Michael Darrell-Hicks (April 17), who all debuted this year.
- NEW HALF, NEW TRASH PANDAS: In June, the Trash Pandas had 25 roster moves impact the roster, with 10 moves coming on June 17. Only 17 of the current 28-man roster were active on May 19. Newcomers joining the club in June include OF Oscar Colás (6/3), 18 Evan Edwards (6/3), INF David Mershon (6/17), INF Ben Gobbel (6/17), LHP A.J. Block (6/17), RHP Sam Ryan (6/17), while OFTravis Blankenhorn (IL, 6/7), C Jaxx Groshans (Dev. List, 6/24) and RHP George Klassen (IL, 6/1) have been reinstated from the IL, or Dev. List.
- THE STREAK IS OVER!!!: The Trash Pandas dropped a Southern League record 16 straight games from June 14 to July 2. The streak was the longest in Minor League Baseball this season. The streak surpassed the previous Southern League mark set by the Columbus (GA) Astros in 1971, dropping 15-straight games from May 17-June 1, 1971. That season, the Southern League and Texas League played an interlocking schedule and referred to the agreement as the "Dixie Association".
- PROSPECTS WITH A HALO: The Trash Pandas roster features four of the Angels' top 11 prospects and eight of the top 20 in MLB Pipeline's newest prospect rankings released on July 22; included in the top 11 are RHP George Klassen (3), 0F Nelson Rada (6), LHP Sam Aldegheri (8), and INF Denzer Guzman (11). The other members of the roster included in the Top-30 include LHP Samy Natera Jr. (16), RHP Walbert Ureña (17), RHP Joel Hurtado (19), and RHP Camden Minacci (20).
- THE YOUNG GUNS: The Trash Pandas have three of the nine youngest players in the Southern League. For the second-straight year, OF Nelson Rada is the youngest player in the Southern League at 19.9 years old (8/24/05), the only player in the League born in 2005. INF Denzer Guzman is the eighth-youngest at 21 years old (2/8/04), and RHP Walbert Urena is the ninth-youngest, just 14 days older than Guzman, born on 1/25/04, 21 years old (1/25/04).
- **DELAYING THE LAUNCH:** From June 12-29, the Trash Pandas endured 9 hours and 20 minutes of weather delays, and during the last homestand, June 10-25, they faced delays that totaled 6 hours and 20 minutes. This season, Rocket City has had 14 home games impacted by rain delays or postponements, adding up to 9 hours and 2 minutes of total delay time. According to wunderground.com, rain has been recorded on 22 out of 37 home game days.
- MAY WAS A GOOD MONTH FOR BROWN AND RADA: Over 26 games in May, Sam Brown finished 4th in the league in batting at .301 (28-for-93), with eight extra-base hits, and 14 RBIs, and Nelson Rada finished 2nd in batting at .325 (27-for-83), and 2nd in OBP (.467). Rada led all of Double-A and was 3rd in Mil B with 19 stolen bases.
- ANOTHER WALK-OFF AT TOYOTA FIELD: The June 11th walk-off single in the 10th inning by Cole Fontenelle was the second of the season for the Trash Pandas. This was the first walk-off since Denzer Guzman hit a walk-off homer in the ninth inning on April 5 against Chattanooga. Overall, it marked the 24th walk-off victory for the Trash Pandas at Toyota Field.
- FONTENELLE'S CYCLE: Not only was Cole Fontenelle's cycle on April 8 vs. Knoxville the first in Trash Pandas history, but it was the first in the Southern League since former Smokies star Moises Ballesteros did it on June 15, 2024, at Biloxi. Fontenelle led off each at-bat, which has only been done once in MLB history, by Todd Helton in 1999 against the Florida Marlins. The last LA Angels' minor league player to hit for the cycle was José Rojas, who hit for the cycle on May 11, 2018, while playing for the Double-A Mobile BayBears. Rojas completed his cycle with a grand slam in the eighth inning, leading the BayBears to a 14-3 win over the Mississippi Braves at Trustmark Park.

In that outing, Aldegheri delivered 2.1 innings, allowing two unearned runs in relief, allowing just one hit and one walk while striking out two. He was optioned back to the minors shortly after ... Recalled again on 7/8, and allowed five runs on five hits, walking four, striking out in 2.0 innings vs. Texas.

Great Month of July: Over four starts in July, finished 3-0 with a league best 0.78 ERA (4 ER/23.0 IP), 10 walks, 19 strikeouts. His three wins were tied for the league lead as well.

**2024 in Review:** Sam Aldegheri went 1-2 with a 4.85 ERA and 10 strikeouts over three starts for the Angels after making his Major League debut on Aug. 30 vs. Seattle. He earned his first MLB win in his second start, Sept. 6 at Texas, becoming the first Italian-born player to record a big league win since 1949 and the first pitcher born and raised in Italy to reach the Majors. He is the eighth Italian-born player in MLB history and the first for the Angels franchise.

Aldegheri was acquired from the Phillies on July 27 in the Carlos Estévez trade, after posting a 6-9 record and 3.59 ERA with 134 strikeouts in 19 starts between High-A Jersey Shore, Double-A Reading, and Rocket City. At the time of his promotion to Double-A, he led the South Atlantic League with 95 strikeouts and paced all High-A pitchers (min. 60 IP) with 12.57 K/9. He was named SAL Pitcher of the Week for June 10–16 after tossing 6.0 shutout innings with nine strikeouts against Wilmington.

**CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:** Was rated as having the best pitch control in the Phillies system by Baseball America following the 2023 season ... Started a combined no-hitter for High-A Clearwater against the Bradenton Marauders on April 8, 2023.
