RIDERS ERASE EARLY THREE-RUN DEFICIT, DEFEAT DRILLERS 9-3:

The Frisco RoughRiders defeated the Tulsa Drillers 9-3 on Thursday evening from Riders Field. Tulsa (12-11, 46-46) started the scoring in the top of the first inning, tagging Frisco (15-9, 59-34) starter and big league rehabber **Tyler Mahle** for three runs on three hits. Damon Keith produced the game's first run with an RBI double, plating Taylor Young. The Drillers added a pair of runs on an RBI double from Brendon Davis. The RoughRiders responded in the bottom of the first inning when **Cody Freeman** doubled, plating **Josh Hatcher** to cut the deficit to 3-1. **Frainery Chavez** tied the game in the bottom of the second with a two-run single to left, scoring **Aaron Zavala** and **Keyber Rodriguez**. In the bottom of the third inning, Jerming Rosario (2-2) walked the bases loaded allowing the Riders to add three runs on no hits. Frisco snagged their first lead of the evening on a balk that pushed Hatcher across home plate. Zavala added to the lead with an RBI groundout before Rodriguez delivered a sacrifice fly, giving the Riders a 7-3 lead. Mahle finished with a final line of 4.0 innings while allowing three runs on three hits and a walk with three punchouts. **Bryan Chi** (2-0) took the mound in relief of Mahle in the fifth, turning in a season-high 4.0 innings of scoreless baseball with a career-high-tying seven strikeouts. Frisco tacked on to the lead in the sixth on an RBI single from **Daniel Mateo**, plating Rodriguez. Leading 8-3 in the bottom of the seventh, Freeman clubbed his second solo homer in as many games to add to the Riders advantage. **Seth Clark** worked a 1-2-3 ninth inning that featured a strikeout, sealing the 9-3 win for Frisco. The RoughRiders offense saw two-hit nights from Freeman, Rodriguez, Chavez and Mateo. Freeman reached in all four plate appearances with two walks, a double and a homer.

I WANT TO BE FOREVER JUNG:

Rangers third baseman **Josh Jung** is slated to rehab with the RoughRiders Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Jung was a star during the World Series last season with the Rangers, batting .308/.329/.538/.867 with four doubles, three home runs and eight RBIs in 17 playoff games. During the regular season, he was the AL All-Star starter at third base while finishing fourth in AL Rookie of the Year voting. With the RoughRiders in 2021, Jung played 43 games, batting .308 with 10 home runs and 40 RBIs before finishing out the season with Triple-A Round Rock and debuting in 2022 with Texas.

PUSH IT TO THE MAXIMO:

Maximo Acosta has been swinging a hot bat for the RoughRiders in July, hitting .293 (17-for-58)/.333/.431/.764 with three doubles, a triple, a home run, eight RBIs, 10 runs scored and six stolen bases. As one of six qualified players in the Texas League age 21 or younger, Acosta is hitting .371 (13-for-35)/.410/.571/.981 over his last nine games. He has also excelled with runners in scoring position, placing third in the Texas League with a .353 average with RISP and first with a .474 average with RISP and two outs.

HOME COOKING:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic at home this year, going 34-13 at Riders Field this season. Their 34 wins and .723 winning percentage at home are both first in Double-A and first among non-Triple-A teams in Minor League Baseball. At home this season, Frisco has a +83 run differential, a 3.61 ERA and is averaging 5.8 runs per game with a .760 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 25-21 with a 3.41 ERA, but a +17 run differential while averaging 4.0 runs per game and owning a .633 OPS. **Cody Freeman** is slashing .346/.401/.610/1.011 at home this season with nine of his 12 home runs. His .346 batting average is the best in the Texas League by a player at their home stadium.

OSUNA FROM THE RIDERS:

Alejandro Osuna has been incredible for Frisco since joining them from High-A Hickory. In 18 games, he is hitting .294 (20-for-68)/.388/.574/.962 with six doubles, two triples, three home runs and 13 RBIs. Over his last 15 games, he is batting .309 (17-for-55)/.418/.618/1.036 with four doubles, two triples, three home runs and 13 RBIs. Two Fridays ago, he went 2-for-5 with a triple and a home run, tying his career-high with five RBIs. He set that career high in his final game in High-A this year, also hitting for the cycle in a 5-for-5 game. In the first inning, Osuna is hitting .357 (5-for-14) with three doubles and a 1.071 OPS for the Riders.

I WANT TO BREAK FREE(MAN):

Cody Freeman has been one of the best hitters on the RoughRiders this season. While he slowed down slightly at the plate in June (batting .253/.298/.437/.735), he has been hot in July. Over his last 16 games, he is hitting .300 (18-for-60)/.377/.533/.910 with four doubles, three home runs, 13 RBIs and six runs scored. This season, he has a career high in average (.277), slugging percentage (.471) and OPS (.807) while being on pace to set new career bests in RBIs (72) and home runs (18).

THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Frisco's bullpen has been the best in the Texas League this season, owning a 2.96 ERA, which is also the second-best in all of Minor League Baseball. Both in their series opener and series finale against Northwest Arkansas on Tuesday and Sunday, the bullpen allowed six runs. Those six runs were the most the bullpen had allowed in a game since April 23rd against Amarillo. That tied for the second-most allowed, with nine runs allowed in the second game of the season (4/6 at Wichita) marking the most. Overall, the Riders are on pace to have the second-best team ERA in franchise history (3.51), just behind 2014 (3.39). Additionally, their .228 BAA is on pace to tie the 2021 team for the lowest mark in the franchise's history.

WE'RE GOING DANCING:

Tuesday marked the first day of the second half. The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

ABOUT KUMAR

-Pronounced "KA-mar", not "KOO-mar".

-Son of Tracy and Lalitha Rocker. Tracy played defensive tackle for Auburn in the 1980s. He was inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame in 2004 and is the current defensive line coach for the Tennessee Titans. Uncle, David, was a DT for the Rams in the early 1990s as well.

-His name "Kumar" translates to "prince" or "young child" in Hindi as a nod to his mother's Indian heritage. Mother's parents emigrated from India to Maryland in 1965.

-Drafted originally by the Colorado Rockies in the 38th round of the 2018 draft after being named the Gatorade Georgia Baseball Player of the Year at North Oconee High School in Bogart, Georgia, but did not sign. Parents valued education and he chose to go to college.

-Played football for two years at North Oconee as well, but chose baseball.

-Broke out as a star at Vanderbilt University as a freshman in 2019, winning College World Series Most Outstanding Player for the Commodores' championship team, going 2-0 with a 1.46 ERA in the College World Series. Additionally named D1Baseball.com and Baseball America Freshman of the Year and The Tennessean 2019 Sportsman of the Year after a 12-5 season with a 3.25 ERA over 22 games with 16 starts. In 99.2 innings, he struck out 114 with 21 walks.

-His freshman season was highlighted by a no-hitter against Duke in the Super Regional round. He walked just two while striking out 19 batters in the 131-pitch no-no.

-After a COVID-shortened 2020 season, he teamed up with former RoughRider and Ranger pitcher **Jack Leiter** once again to create one of the best 1-2 punches in college baseball history. In 2021, Rocker was a unanimous First Team All-American, leading the nation with 14 wins and 179 strikeouts over his 20 starts (122.0 innings) with a 2.73 ERA.

-Drafted by the Rangers in 2022 after year in Indy Ball. *see 2022 season below*

2024 SEASON

-Entered the season as the No. 5 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com. Ranked as the No. 3 prospect when he joined the RoughRiders on July 26th.

2023 SEASON

-Made Rangers MiLB debut with High-A Hickory, going 2-2 with a 3.86 ERA, striking out 42 over 28.0 innings to just seven walks. His 37.8 percent strikeout rate was tied for eighth among all MiLB players with at least six starts.

-Was removed from start on 5/17 with elbow discomfort and underwent "Tommy John" surgery (performed by Rangers team physician Dr. Keith Meister) on 5/22. He missed the remainder of the season.

2022 SEASON

-Drafted by the New York Mets in the 1st round of the 2021 draft (10th overall), but did not sign.

-Prior to being drafted by Rangers, played for Independent Tri-City Valley Cats, making five starts, going 1-0 with a 1.35 ERA with 35 strikeouts to four walks over 20 innings. Valley Cats (in Troy, NY) was managed by former Ranger Pete Incaviglia.

-Did not see action in Rangers system after 2022 draft.
