Leading Off

Reading returns to Altoona for the first time since the last week of the 2022 season. Altoona won the series 3-2 in Reading from Apr. 25-30.

Walk Off Winners

Sunday's matchup with Portland was scoreless into the eighth inning. The Sea Dogs grabbed a 2-0 lead in the top of the inning, then Oliver Dunn responded with a two-run home run to tie the game. In the bottom of the ninth, Ethan Wilson hit a walk-off home run to give Reading the win. It was Reading's fourth walkoff of the season. Also, entering the game Reading was 9-31 this season wehn scoring less than five runs and 3-26 when being outhit, but still won on Sunday despite those numbers. Zach Haake made his first start with Reading and went five shutout innings.

Pitching Powers

A key reason why Reading has won six-of-eight games has come thanks to its pitching. Since July 4, Reading has a 2.70 ERA, which is second in the league. Last weekend, Reading issued two-walks per nine innings, which is second in the league (behind Altoona) over the last series.

Hello From The Other Side

This weekend marks a cross-division matchup with Altoona. Reading has a .467 winning percentage against the Northeast Division, and just a .300 against the Southeast Division, in which Altoona resides. Reading is 1-8 vs Richmond and 5-6 against Altoona and Harrisburg combined in 2023.

Taking Down Top Dogs

Reading has excelled against better competition this season. Against Somerset (first-half champion) and Portland (runner up), Reading owns a 15-11 record, including three series wins against those teams over the last month. Against the remaining teams in the Northeast Divison, Reading is 14-22 when facing Hartford, Binghamton and New Hampshire (114-131 combined record). Portland and Somerset are 100-66 in total.

Johan To The Show

Johan Rojas made his big-league debut last Saturday. He had three hits and a remarkable defensive play in center. Rojas became the first player to make it to the bigs who began his career at the Phillies Dominican Academy, which opened in 2017 (HT: Steve Potter/Larry Shenk). With Rojas departed, the R-Phils now have a void to fill in center field. Last weekend, Carlos De La Cruz started two games in center and Madison Stokes the other. Manager Al Pedrique said he plans to approach the center field position on a committee basis moving forward.

Around the Organization

The Phillies took three-of-four games from the Padres last weekend and open a series with Milwaukee tonight. Lehigh Valley opens a series in Toldeo after sweeping a three-game series with Charlotte last weekend. Jersey Shore is on the road at Winston Salem after falling to Rome in 11 innings Sunday. Clearwater returns home to take on Tampa, who will make the trip across the bay for the series.

This Day in Baseballtown History

July 18, 2010: At Trenton, Vance Worley wins his fourth-straight start and extends his scoreless streak to 17-straight innings with eight-shutout frames in a 4-0 decision over the Thunder. Worley walks one, allows three hits and strikes out three. The victory also halts a seven-game losing skid for Reading. Worley was called up to Philadelphia three days later.

Curve Work

Altoona enters tonight with a 5-7 record in the second half, and 39-41 record overall in 2023. The Curve were in New Hampshire last weekend and lost Friday. Saturday was suspended and Sunday's game cancelled due to inclement weather. After this week, Altoona is on the road for a six-game series at Harrisburg. Top Prospects Henry Davis and Liover Pegeuro both are no longer with Altoona and now on the Pittsburgh Pirates roster.

Throw A "Curve" Ball

Braxton Ashcraft make his fourth start for Altoona this season. He has thrown seven innings, allowing four hits and no-earned runs. Ashcraft's walked one and struck out seven hitters. His appearences for Altoona have been starts of three (x2) and one inning. Ashcraft made two starts in Bradenton (0.00 ERA, 6.1 IP) and nine starts in high-A Greensboro (0-2, 3.76 ERA, 26.1 IP). He missed all of 2022 after receiving Tommy John Surgery. He spent 2021 in Greensboro, 2019 in West Virginia and 2018 with the Pirates Rookie Team after being sleected in the second round in 2018 out of Robinson High School (Waco, TX). At Robinson, he also was a football star, where he had 37 touchdown receptions as a junior.
