LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox fell 8-6 in 10 innings to the Erie SeaWolves on Sunday afternoon. Bowie faced a 5-0 deficit early, eventually tying the game at six in the bottom of the ninth with a two-run single from **Silas Ardoin**. Both Ardoin and **Samuel Basallo** homered for Bowie and each drove in three runs. **Enrique Bradfield Jr** notched a career-high four hits in the defeat. Erie took the lead in the top of the tenth on a two-run double before holding Bowie scoreless in the bottom half.

SO LONG, SAMUEL!

On Tuesday, the Baltimore Orioles promoted C/1B **Samuel Basallo** to Triple-A Norfolk from Double-A Bowie. Basallo, the No.3 BAL/No. 11 MLB Prospect (MLB.com), ends his Baysox stint with a .295 average, 16 home runs, and an .832 OPS in 110 career Double-A games. Basallo's career OPS is the highest of any Double-A player his age (20 years, 13 days) or younger since Mike Trout in 2011 (min. 400 PA). At the time of his promotion to Triple-A, Basallo ranked top five in the Eastern League in hits (1st - 115), extra-base hits (3rd - 38), home runs (4th - 16), and batting average (5th - .289) this season. He ended his time in Double-A by being named Eastern League Player of the Week on Monday. Basallo hit .421 last week against Erie with four extra-base hits, six walks and six RBI. Basallo is the second-consecutive Baysox player to win the award, after **Dylan Beavers** took it home the prior week. Basallo is the first 20-year-old to be named Eastern League Player of the Week since **Gunnar Henderson** won the award twice during his time with the Baysox in 2022.

ARMS RACE

In the month of August, the Bowie starting rotation has the best ERA in the Eastern League and third-lowest in Double-A at 2.50. Overall, Baysox pitching has posted a 2.94 staff ERA in August - the best of any month this season and second-best in the Eastern League. Bowie arms lead Double-A with 1,156 strikeouts this season.

BRADFIELD TO BOWIE

OF **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** has hit safely in eight of his first 11 Double-A games. Sunday, Bradfield notched a career-high four hits for the first time as a professional. Bradfield's 65 stolen bases this season rank as second-most in all of Minor League Baseball. Bradfield has 16 games with multiple stolen bases this season.

SECOND HALF SILAS

C **Silas Ardoin** is hitting .291 since the return from the All-Star Break (July 19) with a .419 on-base percentage - third-best among qualified Eastern League hitters. Ardoin notched his first home run since June 13 (25 GP) on Sunday. Defensively, Ardoin has been one of the best catchers in MiLB - his 63.2 SB% against him is best among Double-A backstops with at least 50 games behind the plate this season.

ATTACKING IN AUGUST

After hitting only .207 in the month of July (tied for league-worst), Bowie has turned things around in August with the fourth-best batting average in the league at .252. The Baysox have scored 109 runs - third-most in the circuit, thanks to a league-best on-base percentage of .348. The Baysox have also stolen the most bases this month (38)

DUCKS ON THE POND

The Akron RubberDucks lead the Baysox by 8 games for the Eastern League South-west division second half postseason spot. Akron took four of six from Bowie at Canal Park last month, and have won seven of 12 in the season series. Akron's roster currently includes five of the Guardians' Top 30 prospects (MLB.com), including 1B/ OF C.J. Kayfus (No. 7), C Cooper Ingle (No. 15), LHP Parker Messick (No. 20), OF Petey Halpin (No. 28), IF Kahlil Watson (No. 30).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Trenton Denholm is Tuesday's projected starter for Akron. Denholm was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on Monday, after tossing eight innings of one-hit, shutout ball this past Wednesday at home against Harrisburg. The 24-year-old allowed seven runs in five innings in his Double-A debut at the beginning of August, but has only allowed one run in 13 IP since. Denholm pitched over 100 innings with High-A Lake County prior to promotion. He was a 14th round pick of the Guardians in 2021 out of UC Irvine, where he pitched with Baysox RHP **Peter Van Loon**.
