LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox came from behind on Sunday to defeat the Akron RubberDucks 5-4 and salvage a series split against the Eastern League's best team. Bowie trailed 4-1 heading into the sixth and rallied for four runs on four hits and one error. Ryan Higgins delivered his first Double A hit with a two-run double off the wall in right-field to put Bowie ahead 5-4. The Baysox also broke their 25 inning scoreless streak on a Jud Fabian sacrifice fly in the third. Kyle Virbitsky earned the win with 1.1 innings of relief and Dylan Heid collected a six-out save.

SADDLING UP THE PONIES

Entering this week, the Binghamton Rumble Ponies own the best record in the Northeast Division at 18-13. Before their loss on Sunday, they had won a league-best eight in a row. The Rumble Ponies pitching has been a strong suit with the fourth-best ERA in the league (3.76). Eight of the Mets' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, are on the active roster- OF/1B Ryan Clifford (No. 4), C Kevin Parada (No. 9), RHP Blade Tidwell (No. 10), RHP Brandon Sproat (RHP), OF Alex Ramirez (OF), RHP Tyler Stuart (No. 18), RHP Joander Suarez (RHP), and OF Rhylan Thomas (No. 30).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP David Peterson gets the ball for Binghamton in a rehab start. Peterson has been on the 60-day injured list while recovering from offseason hip surgery. The left-hander made four rehab starts with Single-A St. Lucie and did not give up a run in 8.2 innings while striking out 16 and walking just one batter. Peterson is in his fifth season in the big leagues after pitching a career-high 111 innings with a career-high 128 strikeouts over 27 appearances (21 starts). Peterson last pitched for Binghamton in 2019 and made 24 starts. The Denver, Colorado native was drafted in the 1st round by the Mets in the 2017 Draft with the 20th overall pick.

SCORING STRUGGLES

The Baysox were held scoreless for 25 consecutive innings until the third inning of Sunday's game when **Jud Fabian** brought home **Dylan Beavers** with a sacrifice fly. Before Fabian's sac fly, the last run scored by Bowie was in the third inning of Thursday's win. Bowie still leads the league in runs scored (162) this season but has scored just nine runs over its last five games after putting up 17 alone in the series opener last Tuesday against Akron.

ON-BASE BOWENS

After going 1-for-4 on Saturday, 1B **TT Bowens** now owns a batting average of .333, good for second in the Eastern League behind Hartford's Zac Veen (.341). After playing just 47 games last year due to injuries, Bowens is amongst the league leaders in several offensive categories. The 25-year-old is tied for third in RBI (22), is fourth in slugging percentage (.575), fifth in OPS (.973), and fifth in XBH (13).

THE FABULOUS FABIAN

After a slow start to the season, OF **Jud Fabian** has picked it up since the calendar turned to the month of May. The Orioles No. 12 prospect is tied for the league lead in May with four homers and is third in RBI with 10. Fabian's six homers on the season lead the team and he has now swatted 21 career home runs in 91 Double-A games.

RELIEVERS STAY READY

After 4.1 more innings and four more strikeouts from Baysox relievers on Sunday, Bowie's bullpen continues to lead the Eastern League and all of Double-A in innings thrown (154.0) and strikeouts (194). 16 of the 17 wins accumulated by Baysox pitchers have been credited to the relievers. Opposing hitters are batting just .209 against the Baysox bullpen, which is good for the seventh-lowest average in all of Double-A.

LONG TOSSIN'

RHP **Ryan Long** makes his sixth start (seventh overall appearance) and his 12th career Double-A start tonight. The 24-year-old is coming off his shortest outing of the season after going just 1.2 innings last Wednesday against Akron. He allowed six hits, four runs, two walks and struck out two in the loss. Before the start, he had pitched into the fourth inning in three straight starts. This will be Long's first career outing against Binghamton.



The “Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake” are an alternate identity of the Baysox, as a part of MiLB’s “Copa de la Diversión™” or “Fun Cup™”. During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie’s “Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake” identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the “Chesapeake Baysox.” This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George’s Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The “Bowie Pit Beef” is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore’s east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization’s Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles’ Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer’s fifth season in the Orioles’ system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.

CHASE SEBBY

Fundamentals Coach

Sebbly joins the Baysox staff as the Fundamentals Coach in 2024. Sebbly was the fundamentals coach in Aberdeen last season and was a development coach within the Orioles’ organization in 2022. Sebbly played collegiately as a catcher at Cypress College and Ball State.

Facteau was the development coach in Aberdeen last season, but began his professional coaching career as a development coach on the Baysox staff in 2022.
