YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels split a doubleheader with the Yard Goats. In Game 1, the Yard Goats scored five in the second and 10 in the third to open a 15-0 lead. The Flying Squirrels broke the shutout in the bottom of the seventh with an RBI ground-out by **Jairo Pomares.** In Game 2, the Flying Squirrels walked off for a 2-1 win in eight innings. The game remained scoreless through the regulation seven innings. Nick Morreale threw four scoreless innings for Richmond and struck out four. Wil Jensen struck out five over three scoreless innings. Tanner Kiest picked up his sixth win of the season. Hartford starter Chase Dollander struck out six in six innings. Sterlin Thompson gave the Yard Goats a 1-0 lead in the top of the eighth with a sacrifice fly. In the bottom of the eighth, Luis Toribio drove an RBI double to tie the score and Pomares clubbed a walk-off double

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies, in the finale of a six-game series. This is the only series between the two teams this season. Last year, the two teams met for six games at Dunkin Park in Hartford, with Richmond winning four-of-six. This set is the Flying Squirrels' final series this year against an opponent from the Northeast Division.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 5-2 in their last seven games since last Saturday, winning four straight prior to falling Friday night and in the first game of Saturday's doubleheader. Prior to that winning streak, they went 4-12 in their previous 16 games from July 13-August 2.

THE YARD GOATS clinched their first postseason appearance in franchise history by winning the Northeast Division in the Eastern League's first half with a 38-30 record, finishing 2.5 games ahead of Binghamton and Portland. The Yard Goats will face the second-half division champ in this year's Eastern League playoffs. For the season, the Yard Goats lead the Eastern League in stolen bases (160). Hartford's roster includes seven of Baseball America's top-30 Rockies prospects, including RHP Chase Dollander (No. 2), OF Adael Amador (No. 3), OF Yanquiel Fernandez (No. 4), INF Sterlin Thompson (No. 7), LHP Sean Sullivan (No. 16), SS Ryan Ritter (No. 25), and RHP Zach Agnos (No. 30). MLB.com's top-30 Rockies prospects list includes nine Hartford players, including Dollander (No. 1), Amador (No. 2), Fernandez (No. 4), Thompson (No. 6), Sullivan (No. 13), INF Warming Bernabel (No. 16), RHP Bradley Blalock (No. 20), LHP Mason Albright (No. 22) and LHP Luis Peralta (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander Jack Choate makes his second Double-A start. He made his debut on Tuesday against the Yard Goats and allowed four runs (three earned) over 4.1 innings with five strikeouts. He was promoted from High-A Eugene on Au-gust 1. With the Emeralds, he went 1-3 with a 2.90 ERA in 19 outings (18 starts). For the season, Choate ranks ninth in the Giants organization in strikeouts (92). Choate was selected in the ninth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of NCAA DI Assumption College in Massachusetts. *For more on Choate, see page two.* 

FOR HARTFORD: Right-hander Connor Van Scoyoc makes his 18th start of the season. He last pitched on July 19 and threw five scoreless innings at Bowie. He has made one other start in his career against the Flying Squirrels, throwing six innings and allowing one run on August 29, 2023 at Dunkin Park. Van Scoyoc was selected in the 11th round of the 2018 MLB Draft by the Angels. He was traded to the Rockies on June 25, 2023 for Mike Moustakas.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** The Flying Squirrels have turned 74 double plays this year, which is the most in the Eastern League. Altoona is ranked second with 72. Richmond pitcher **John Michael Bertrand** has induced 15 double plays this year, which is the most in the league, ahead of three pitchers tied for second with 11. It is also tied for the second-most in the minors. The Flying Squirrels turned four double plays on July 27 against Binghamton, which is tied for the most in a game this season in the league. On July 10 against the Senators, Seth Lonsway induced three double plays, which is tied for the most by one pitcher in a game in the league this year. Bertrand matched that with three double plays behind him on July 19 against the RubberDucks.

TAKE THE JAIRO: In Saturday's doubleheader, Jairo Pomares drove in two of Richmond's three runs. In the second game, he lifted the Flying Squirrels to a 2-1 win in extras with a walk-off double. He is currently riding a six-game hitting streak dating back to last Sunday. In that stretch, he is batting .385 (10-for-26) with three doubles, a triple and eight RBIs while adding two stolen bases. For the season, Pomares is tied for seventh in the Giants organization with 10 homers and ranks sixth with 30 extra-base hits.

BERICOTO BASHING: In his last 46 games dating back to June 6, Victor Bericoto is hitting .311 (57-for-183) with four homers, nine doubles, nine walks and 28 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland, but he had not homered in 34 games before belting a two-run shot on Friday night off the scoreboard in left-center. Bericoto has picked up multiple hits in 17-of-38 games dating back to June 15

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked ninth among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,634), just shy of the highest average attendance in franchise history (6,689 in 2013).

PROSPECT WATCH: One of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, which is SS Diego Velasquez (No. 26). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, LHP John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features three Richmond players, including Velasquez (No. 18), OF/1B Victor Bericoto (No. 19) and OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26)

BOULEVARD TO THE BAY: This season, 11 former Flying Squirrels players have reached the majors for the first time. That is tied for the most in a season in franchise history. In 2014, a team-record 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including Joe Panik, Adam Duvall, Andrew Susac, Matt Duffy, Jackson Williams, Edwin Escobar, Hunter Strickland, Chris Dominguez, Gary Brown, Brett Bochy and Chris Heston. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors this season are Erik Miller (2023 Flying Squirrels), Landen Roupp (2022-23), Kai-Wei Teng (2022-23), Nick Avila (2022), Randy Rodriguez (2022-23), Mason Black (2023), Gerson Garabito (2021), Spencer Bivens (2023), Raymond Burgos (2023), Hayden Birdsong (2023-24) and Parker Dunshee (2023). Dating back to 2022, 20-of-the-last-22 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers) and Dunshee (Braves) being the only exceptions. Last year saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster.

LOTTA INS, LOTTA OUTS, LOTTA WHAT-HAVE-YOUS: The have been 59 players who have seen action for the Flying Squirrels this year, which is one shy of the franchise record for a single season. In 2018 and 2019, the Flying Squirrels had 60 different players see time on the field. This season, there have been 30 different pitchers used by the Flying Squirrels, which includes appearances by **Andy Thomas** on June 1 against the SeaWolves and **Luis Toribio** on August 10 against the Yard Goats. There have been 30 different hitters who have seen at least one plate appearance with Richmond this season. In last week's series at Altoona, three players made their Flying Squirrels debuts, including **Zach Morgan**, **Justin Wishkoski**, and **Julio Rodriguez**. Pitcher **Jack Choate** made his Double-A debut on Tuesday night against the Yard Goats.


