YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the SeaWolves, 4-1. Austin Murr hit a solo homer in the first. In the fifth, Ben Malgeri gave the SeaWolves a 2-0 lead with a solo home run. Erie scored two runs in the sixth on an error and a bases-loaded walk to open a 4-0 lead. The Flying Squirrels broke up starter Carlos Pena's no-hit bid in the sixth and broke the shutout in the ninth with a run scoring on a wild pitch.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, in the second of a six-game series. This is the final series between the two teams this year. The Flying Squirrels were swept in a six-game series at UPMC Park back in May. The SeaWolves won four-of-six at The Diamond from May 28-June 2.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 4-2 in their last six games since Wednesday after losing their previous six straight from August 14-20. In their last seven games dating back to the August 18 finale in Harrisburg, the Flying Squirrels are batting .277 (73-for-264), which is the highest in the Eastern League. In that span, they have scored a league-best 41 runs (5.1 runs per game) and homered eight times. They had only hit six home runs in their previous 19 games from July 27-August 17.

THE SEAWOLVES clinched the Southwest Division's first-half title with a 38-29 record to book their third consecutive postseason appearance. They are in second place in the division standings in the second half. Erie's roster includes three of Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects, including RHP Jackson Jobe (No. 1), INF Hao-Yu Lee (No. 11) and RHP Troy Melton (No. 12). Jobe is rated by Baseball America as having the best control, best changeup, best slider and best fastball in the Tigers system. He is also rated by Baseball America as the No. 5 overall prospect in baseball. MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects list includes four Erie players, including Jobe (No. 2), Lee (No. 8), Melton (No. 12) and RHP Eric Silva (No. 29).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander John Michael Bertrand makes his league-leading 25th start of the season and the fourth of his career against the SeaWolves. He last pitched on Thursday and took a no-hit bid into the sixth inning before allowing four runs that frame. On the year, he leads the minors with 19 groundball double plays induced and he is second in the Eastern League with a 50.5 groundball percentage. In fielding, he leads all MiLB pitchers in total chances (35) and assists (28). This year, he has made nine scoreless starts, all at least five innings, which is the most in the Eastern League. Bertrand has been named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week twice this year, first for throwing seven perfect innings against the Baysox on April 27 and then for working six hitless innings in Bowie on May 23. Last season, he climbed three levels, working from Low-A San Jose to High-A Eugene before joining Double-A Richmond in July for the remainder of the season. For the year, he led all qualified Giants minor league pitchers in winning percentage (.688) and ranked second in ERA (3.65), second in wins (11), tied for second in WHIP (1.23), third in innings pitched (118.1) and fourth in BAA (.248). Entering 2024, Bertrand was rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Giants system. Bertrand began his collegiate career at Furman University in South Carolina before playing his final two seasons at the University of Notre Dame. He was selected by the Giants in the 10th round of the 2022 MLB Draft. For more on Bertrand, see page two.

FOR ERIE: Right-hander Troy Melton makes his 23rd start of the season and his third against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched on Thursday at Bowie and allowed five runs over 5.2 innings of work. He pitched against Richmond on May 10 at UPMC Park and threw five scoreless innings in a win. On May 29 at The Diamond, he allowed one run in the first inning but was removed before the second after throwing 31 pitches. For the season, he ranks 10th in the Eastern League with 116 strikeouts. Melton is in his first Double-A season. He was selected in the fourth round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Tigers out of San Diego State. He split the 2023 season between Low-A Lakeland and High-A West Michigan, going 3-1 with a 2.74 ERA en route to being named a Midwest League All-Star. Melton is rated by Baseball America and MLB.com as the No. 12 Tigers prospect.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The Flying Squirrels have turned 83 groundball double plays this year, which is the most in the Eastern League. Richmond pitcher **John Michael Bertrand** has induced 19 double plays this year, which is the most in the minor leagues. The Flying Squirrels turned four double plays on July 27 against Binghamton, which is tied for the most in a game this season in the league. They matched that feat with four double plays in the first four innings at Harrisburg on August 16 with Bertrand pitching. Those four double plays were tied for the most induced by a pitcher in the Eastern League dating back to 2005, which is the first year those statistics are readily available. It has been accomplished by three other Richmond pitchers, including **Daryl Maday** in 2010, **Clayton Blackburn** twice in 2014 and **Garrett Williams** in 2019. Bertrand's 19 GIDPs this year are tied for the fourth-most in a season in franchise history, trailing 27 by **Craig Westcott** in 2012 (second-most in the Eastern league since at least 2005), 21 by **Clayton Tanner** in 2010 and 20 by **Mike MacDonald** in 2010.

BERICOTO BASHING: In his last 58 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .299 (69-for-231) with five homers, 12 doubles, 12 walks and 33 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland, but he had not homered in 34 games before belting a two-run shot on August 9 off the scoreboard in left-center at The Diamond. Bericoto homered again last Friday.

TO THE MUNGUIA: In his 19 August games, **Ismael Munguia** is batting .347 (25-for-72), third-highest in the Eastern League, with five doubles and five RBIs, adding four stolen bases. He has at least one hit in 16-of-19 games played this month. Last year, he hit .282 over 75 games with the Flying Squirrels. In his Richmond career, Munguia is batting .289 (127-for-439) in 111 games, which is the fifth-highest career mark in franchise history (min. 450 PA).

FAMILIAR FACES: Erie's roster includes two former Flying Squirrels relief pitchers. **Matt Seelinger** pitched for the Flying Squirrels in 2021 and went 3-1 with a 3.07 ERA in 36 appearances. He was also part of the only nine-inning no-hitter in Richmond franchise history on May 13, 2021 at FNB Field in Harrisburg, recording an out in the eighth inning. He spent parts of the 2022 and 2023 seasons in the Eastern League with Reading. He signed with the Tigers in June and joined the SeaWolves. **Eric Silva** began this season with the Flying Squirrels, going 4-2 with a 4.35 ERA in 28 games with two saves. He was swapped to the Tigers at the trade deadline on July 31 in exchange for Mark Canha and joined the SeaWolves.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked 10th among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,543), just shy of the highest average attendance in franchise history (6,689 in 2013).

BOULEVARD TO THE BAY: This season, 12 former Flying Squirrels players have reached the majors for the first time. That is the most in a season in franchise history. In 2014, 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including Joe Panik, Adam Duvall, Andrew Susac, Matt Duffy, Jackson Williams, Edwin Escobar, Hunter Strickland, Chris Dominguez, Gary Brown, Brett Bochy and Chris Heston. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors this season are Erik Miller (2023 Flying Squirrels), Landen Roupp (2022-23), Kai-Wei Teng (2022-23), Nick Avila (2022), Randy Rodriguez (2022-23), Mason Black (2023), Gerson Garatito (2021), Spencer Bivens (2023), Raymond Burgos (2023), Hayden Birdsong (2023-24), Parker Dunshee (2023) and Grant McCray (2024). Dating back to 2022, 21-of-the-last-23 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers) and Dunshee (Braves) being the only exceptions. Last year saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster.

LOTTA INS, LOTTA OUTS, LOTTA WHAT-HAVE-YOUS: The have been 60 players who have seen action for the Flying Squirrels this year, which ties the franchise record for a single season. In 2018 and 2019, the Flying Squirrels also had 60 different players see time on the field. This season, there have been 31 different pitchers used by the Flying Squirrels, which includes appearances by **Andy Thomas** on June 1 against the SeaWolves and **Luis Toribio** on August 10 against the Yard Goats. There have been 31 different hitters who have seen at least one plate appearance with Richmond this season.

PROSPECT WATCH: Two of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF Vaun Brown (No. 11) and SS Diego Velasquez (No. 26). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, LHP John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features two Richmond players, including Velasquez (No. 17) and LHP Jack Choate (No. 21).
