Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Ben Lively** to the mound tonight, looking to avoid an 0-3 series start for the first time since 7/19 vs. Indianapolis. The Indians will counter with LHP **Hunter Barco**. Columbus is 14-20 (.412) versus left handers this year. Barco has pitched against the Clippers five times in his career, going 1-0 with a 3.71ERA (17.0IP, 10H, 7R, 7ER, 15BB, 17K).

vs. the Indians

Columbus is 7-10 against Indianapolis this year, posting a -24 run margin (9-9, +13 in 2025; 12-5, +45 in 2024; 10-8, -23 in 2023; 12-8, +53 in 2022). Since the start of the 2022 season, the Clippers are 18-10 (.643) in games against Indianapolis that are decided by at least five. Individually, **Cooper Ingle** is 19x70 (.271) with 3HR, 9RBI in 20G vs. Indy in his career (**Milan Tolentino** has 6HR, 21RBI in 34G).

Start with a Bang

Over the last 24G, the Clippers have plated 180 runs (most in the IL, 7.5 per), with 121 (67%) tallied in the first four innings of the game, including nine innings of 5+. The opposition has only 58 in the first four innings of the last 24G, but is outscoring the Clippers 90-59 thereafter. Columbus is the only undefeated team in the IL when leading after the 7th (48-0, 58 straight since 8/22/25 vs. Omaha).

Homer Time

The Clippers got back into the homer column yesterday (HR in 23 of last 26G), but also surrendered 3HR to Indy (combined 4.5 homers per game since 7/28; one completely homerless game: 8/15 vs. Omaha). Beginning with that 7/28 contest, Columbus has hit more than any team in pro ball (58, accounts for 53% of runs scored) , while giving up the 5th most (51, leads IL; accounts for 51% of runs allowed).

Ingle is Back

In 34G since his option, **Cooper Ingle** is 42x132 (.318), drawing 30BB (.442OBP) with 16XBH (6HR, .530SLG; 0XBH in last 10G). He dropped below .300 yesterday (8x52, .154, in last 15G, but has 19BB for a .380OBP) for the first time since 7/22 (immediately went 23x48 over 11G hit streak to get back to .328) . At catcher, Ingle has a 1.269OPS (15HR) in 46G (.627OPS, 3HR in 38G between DH and LF).

King Ralph

Dating to 7/28, **Ralph Velazquez** leads the IL in HR (16, +6), RBI (33, +8) and SLG (.931, +195). He is the reigning IL Batter of the Week (.455, 6HR, 12RBI vs. St. Paul), has reached in 17 straight (.461OBP since 8/4) and, aside from going 0x21 in 6G at St. Paul (7/21-7/26), is hitting .343/.415/.710 since 6/18 (19HR, 47RBI). Of his 20HR with Columbus, 15 have come in the first four innings of the game.

Big Time Production

Kyle Manzardo has hit safely in each of 9G since 8/15 (.333, 12x35, 2HR), while collecting an RBI in each of the last 5G (9RBI). In his Columbus career, Manzardo has played only 120G (526PA), but he has still managed 65XBH (.560SLG), including 30HR, against just 50 singles. Additionally, he has scored 95 times with 83RBI, while keeping his strikeout rate under 20% (100K, 19%; 81BB, 15%).

All or Nothing

Over his last 23G, since 7/25, **Kody Huff** is mired in a 16x81 (.198) slump, though he has connected for 6HR (19HR on the season; had 18HR in career prior). He leads the team in runs (73) and RBI (69) and is set to become the fourth 70-70 Clipper since 2019 (**Johnathan Rodriguez**, **Jhonkensy Noel**, **Juan Brito**). Tonight will tie his career high in games played (101; one double from tying personal best).

Out of a Slump

After doubling twice on 6/25 at Omaha, **George Valera** hit .111 (8x72) with a .139SLG in his next 20G (6/27-7/28). On 7/30, he was 2x3 with a HR (snapped 124AB homerless streak) and he has hit safely in nine straight (.371, 13x35, 4HR, 12RBI, .886SLG). Tonight will mark his 300th game in a Clipper uniform (29th all-time; also missed 184G due to six injuries), as he sits 3HR short of 50 in his career.

Rough Stuff

In the last 11 days, **Milan Tolentino** (.103, 3x29), **Blake Perkins** (.130, 3x23), **Alfonsin Rosario** (.100, 2x20) and **Dayan Frias** (.000, 0x17) have combined to hit .090 (8x89), though Tolentino has a pair of bombs (38 since start of '25, 2nd most in IL) and Perkins has one. The quartet has managed only 7BB (7%) against 43K (44%) in 97PA and they were 1x14 with 2BB (both Perkins) and 8K yesterday.

This Date in Clipper History

8/27/1992

Columbus beat Syracuse 3-1 for a franchise-record 89th win, with 11 games to be played. **Royal Clayton** was credited with the win on the mound. The '92 team would go on to win 95 games, a record that still stands to this day. Clayton would finish his career as the 2nd winningest pitcher in team history with 41 wins. He is 3rd all-time in appearances (177) and innings pitched (513.2) while placing 7th in strikeouts (307).

First Half Wrap

Despite being eliminated from playoff contention on the penultimate Sunday of the first half, the Clippers were 41-33 and finished with their first winning record in the front half since the season was split in 2023 (averaged 32 wins from 2023-25, topping out at 34-38, .472, last season). From 4/22-6/17, they spent every day between 3.0 and 6.0 games off the lead, while occupying anywhere between 4th and 13th in the standings. A late push (15-6 from 5/16-6/9) got them to within 2.5 before derailing with a 3G losing streak at Indy to seal their fate. On the back half, Columbus has posted just one winning record, clinching a playoff berth in 2024 with a mark of 48-26 (.649).

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,494 to 1,439).

Challenging Times

The Clippers are 178-140 (.560) in pitch reviews, with batters going 92-84 (.523) and pitchers/catchers going 86-56 (.606). They have run out of challenges in 47G and have not challenged in 8G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 5-4 in extra innings this year, after having gone .500 in each of the last two seasons. Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 55-37 when playing past regulation (.598, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 27-17 at home (.614; 5-7 in last 12G). Of the 92G to require extra play, 73 have been resolved after one frame (including nine DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 on 9/20/22 at Toledo).

On the Runs

Starting with the embiggened 150G schedule in 2022, the Clippers scored over 800 runs in three consecutive seasons from 2022-2024 (855, 808 and 805 runs, respectively; accounting for the 3rd, 4th and 5th best totals in team history). Following a steep decline last season (670, fewest scored in a full season since 2018), Columbus is looking to top 800 again (on pace for 842, would rank as 4th most all-time; record is 898 scored in 1983).

On the Run

On the basepaths, the Clippers are making a run at the franchise mark in stolen bases, with 147 through 125G (on pace for 173SB). The team record was set in 2024 when Columbus swiped an even 200, but the team speed was throttled last year (129SB; still, the 2nd highest total since the Cleveland affiliation started in 2009). However, with 43CS so far, the Clippers are also pacing for the most times caught stealing of the Cleveland affiliation (51; nabbed 51 times in 2024).

Crazy Eighth's

From the 8th inning on, the Clippers have scored an IL-best 175 runs while crafting a .883OPS (over 60 points better than all other teams). On the flipside, Columbus has given up 118 runs from the 8th on, resulting in a +57 run differential (Clippers are getting outscored 291-183 from innings 5-7).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 80 grand slams and 1,989RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

In Big Trouble

The Clipper pitching staff is trending toward the worst ERA in club history, sitting at 5.51 through 125G. Since the reorganization of the minor leagues in 2021, Columbus has twice finished the season with a 5+ ERA (current record is 5.32, set in 2023), after having done so just once in the first 43 seasons (5.08 in 1983). Additionally, the staff is pacing to give up 213HR (2nd most in franchise history; 214HR allowed in 2023).

Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 7th in the IL this year (.980), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 68G this season (40-28, .597), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

Good Baseball

CJ Kayfus bunted a runner into scoring position with a single on 7/5 vs. Louisville, with that runner kicking off a 5-run inning that led the Clippers to victory. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 90-23 (.796) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 7-2 mark this season (.778, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers have the 8th most last at bat wins this year (14, four off the lead) while playing in the 12th most games decided in the last at bat (27, Norfolk has 39). Since the start of the 2024 season, Columbus has played in 101G decided in the last at bat (2nd most in the IL), going 48-53 (.475, 16th best winning percentage; 3rd most wins, 2nd most losses).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's seventh year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 452-465 (.493), 422-419 with Columbus (.502).
