**NANTS INGONYAMA BAGITHI:** Right-hander Lyon Richardson will make his second start and seventh overall appearance with the Sounds on the mound Thursday night against Charlotte. Richardson, a former 2nd round pick by the Cincinnati Reds in 2018 transitioned to a full-time reliever for the first time in his career last season and had 56 appearances between Triple-A Louisville and Cincinnati, going 5-3 with a 4.42 ERA. His last start with Nashville on June 25 vs. Gwinnett was the 100th of his minor league career. He also made five starts with the Reds between 2023-2026. Richardson topped out as the no. 12-rated prospect in the Reds system in 2019.

**NARD DOG:** Eddys Leonard hit his team-leading 11th home run of the season on Wednesday night to break a three-way tie with Luke Adams and Jeferson Quero for the most homers on the club this season. It was Leonard's first home run since June 14 on the road in Durham, ending a 12-game homerless drought. 9-of-11 home runs have come on the road this season for Leonard, who is hitting .267 (32-for-120) with 19 XBH and 25 RBI away from First Horizon Park. Despite playing in 17 career games against the Knights between 2024-2025 with the Toledo Mud Hens (6 G) and Gwinnett Stripers (11 G), all four of his career home runs against the Knights have come this season with Nashville. He is T-7th for the most HRs in the Brewers farm system this season, and ranks 6th in SLG (.504), 7th in AVG (.294), T-8th in XBH (26) and total bases (120), and 10th in OPS (.880). **Since the start of the 2021 season, Leonard ranks T-4th in all Minor League Baseball in XBH (255) and 7th in hits (642). He has the most XBH of any minor leaguer over the span to not yet make his Major League Debut and only Euriel Angeles (654 H, ATH) and Matt Koperniak (664 H, STL) have more hits than Leonard without a Major League debut.**

**BLACK ON TRACK:** Tyler Black extended his on-base streak to 18 consecutive games in Wednesday night's win over the Knights, going 1-for-4 with a walk. The 18 consecutive games remains as the longest-active on-base streak on the team and ties for the fourth-longest on the team this season. Luke Adams (5 G) has the second-longest active on-base streak among active Nashville players currently. Black has posted a .267 batting average (16-for-60), added 7 XBH, 14 RBI and 17 R since beginning his streak on June 13. The 18 consecutive games ties his career-best at Triple-A, having also reached base in 18 straight games with Nashville August 6-27, 2023. In 39 career games against Charlotte, Black has posted a .281 AVG (38-for-135) with 15 XBH, 19 RBI, 34 BB, and 37 R.

**MILLER LIGHT:** Darrien Miller earned his first multi-hit game of his Triple-A career on Thursday night, finishing 2-for-3 with a RBI and a walk. It was his first multi-hit game since going 3-for-4 on June 23 with Double-A Biloxi. Miller has recorded 71 multi-hit games, including 13 three-hit games and set his career-high with four hits on May 13 during the 2022 season with High-A Wisconsin. He added his second career Triple-A RBI Thursday night and owns a career .221 AVG (342-for-1548), 120 XBH and 214 RBI in his regular season minor league career since 2019 and ranks third in all MiLB in HBP (111) since making his professional debut with the ACL Brewers on July 3, 2019.

**TRIVIAL PURSUIT (SPORTS, HARD):** Brewers no. 17-rated prospect Tyson Hardin surrendered the first career minor league RBI for Munetaka Murakami on a double in the bottom of the first inning on Thursday night. Murakami began a rehab assignment with the Charlotte Knights this week and is 2-for-7 with the double and RBI to go along with a walk in last night's game. Murakami took MLB by storm with a homer in each of his first three MLB games after signing with the White Sox on December 21, 2025. He became the first player in MLB history with 10+ HR and 20+ walks in his first 25 career games and set a MLB rookie record for the most HR before June with 20 long balls. He was placed on the 10-day IL with a right hamstring strain on May 30 before being assigned to Charlotte on Rehab July 7.
