## Leading Off

Reading continues a six-game series with game three tonight against Somerset. Reading has an 8-6 edge in the season series.

## Looking Back

Reading fell 9-3 last night as home runs powered Somerset to victory. Mick Abel surrendered a career-high four home runs and it also marked the second time this season an R-Phils' pitcher has allowed four homers in a game. Offensively, Reading struck out 17 times, which matched a season-high and the first time since July 1 vs Richmond. Yoendrys Gomez was excellent for the Patriots, striking out 11 over just 4.1 innings pitched. On offense, Oliver Dunn homered for the second-straight game, while Robbie Glendinning and Ethan Wilson each drove in runs.

## Gettin' It Dunn

Oliver Dunn added another home run last night, marking the fifth time this season he has homered in back-to-back games. Dunn now has 19 home runs on the season along with 70 RBI, both marks are career highs. His previous career highs for homers was seven and RBI was 25. He's also had a ton of success against his former team Somerset, hitting .325 with three homers and 10 RBI. August has treated Dunn was too, as he's slashing $.393 / .435 / .893$ with a 1.328 OPS. He's also added eight home runs, 22 RBI and 14 runs over 14 games this month. To add, Dunn is sixth in the league in hitting (.288), fourth in homers (19), second in RBI (70), second in OPS (.946), fourth in hits (97) and second in total bases (183).

## Parkinson Powers

Tonight's starter David Parkinson has been stellar lately. Over his last six starts, dating back to July 7, he's 5-0 with a 1.30 ERA, with 35 strikeouts and a .208 average against. Parkinson has climbed up the league rankings as well, holding the following top-10 distinctions: 7th ERA (4.02), T4th Wins (7), 7th IP (94.0) and 3rd Winning Percentage (.636). This all comes after Parkinson missed all of 2022 and went 1-11 in 2021.

## Home/Road Splits

Reading has performed vastly better on the road this season than at home. The R-Phils are 30-27 away from FirstEnergy Stadium, and just 17-35 while at home. Offensively, they're hitting .257 while away and .251 at home, while scoring nearly one-run more per game on the road. Reading has homered more at home, slugging 73 compared t0 59 while away. Reading's home ERA is 5.12 and on the road, it's 4.11.

## Around the Organization

The Phillies beat the Blue Jays 9-4 last night as Bryce Harper led the way with three hits and two home runs. Lehigh Valley walked off Jacksonville 4-3, thanks to a Dustin Peterson home run. Drew Hutchinson started and went seven-strong frames. Jersey Shore was victorious 5-4 over Asheville Justin Crawford had two hits and Kendall Simmons slugged a grand slam for the Blue Claws. Clearwater fell 12-4 to Dunedin as Zach Arnold had two hits and Emaarion Boyds had a triple.

## 'Sup Somerset

Somerset enters tonight with the best-overall record in the Eastern League at 65-44, which saw them win the first half title. The Patriots are 23-18 in the second half, which currently sees them in first in the division. Somerset and Binghamton split a six-game series last week in New Jersey. Next up, Somerset returns home and welcomes Hartford. One of the Yankees' top prospects Jasson Dominguez headlines a Somerset team loaded with talent. Ben Rice has been a force since joining Somerset last night and has already left a strong mark on this series through just two games.

## Patriot Pitcher

Righty Richard Fitts gets the start tonight for Somerset. It'll be Fitts' fourth start against Reading this season, as he has a 2.76 ERA and no decisions ( $16.1 \mathrm{IP}, 14 \mathrm{H}, 6 \mathrm{BB}, 14 \mathrm{SO}$ ). Overall in 2023, Fitts is $9-5$ with a 3.38 ERA over 21 starts ( $119.2 \mathrm{IP}, 101 \mathrm{H}, 30 \mathrm{BB}, 130 \mathrm{SO}$ ). Last time out, Fitts earned a win as he tossed six-shutout frames againt Binghamton last Thursday, while striking out seven and allowing just two hits. Fitts began his pro career by splitting 2022 between Single-A Tampa and High-A Hudson Valley, where he went 7-8 with a 3.70 ERA over 22 starts. The Yankees selected Fitts in the sixth round of the 2021 draft out of Auburn and he ranks as their number 12 prospect. Fitts holds the following Eastern League ranks: 2nd ERA (3.38), 2nd Wins (9), 1st SO (130), T1st GS (21, 1st IP (119.2), 3rd BAA (.224), 1st WHIP (1.09) and 2nd WPCT (.643).
