**ABOUT SUNDAY:** Behind a four-run fourth inning, the Cyclones beat the BlueClaws 6-4 to take all three games from Jersey Shore after the All-Star Break. The bottom of the order, including OF **Joe Suozzi**, C **Juan Loyo**, and 2B **Gregory Guerrero** combined to go 5-7 with five RBIs. LHP **Nick Zwack** lowered his ERA to 1.52 with one run over five innings of seven-strikeout ball en route to the victory. In the ninth, Jersey Shore scored three times, but RHP **Daison Acosta** nabbed his third career save.

**SUBWAY SERIES:** Tonight begins a six-game series between Brooklyn and Hudson Valley -- the New York Mets affiliate against the New York Yankees affiliate -- while the parent clubs also do battle in a two-game series at Citi Field. The Cyclones enter tonight's game a 1/2-game behind the Renegades.

**RA-RA FOR RAMIREZ:** OF **Alex Ramirez** destroyed Jersey Shore pitching in the weekend series. The 19-year-old No. 4 Mets prospect, according to *MLB Pipeline*, had a double, two home runs, and 10 RBIs, going 8-for-13.

**CON SWAGGER:** OF **Stanley Consuegra** has had a dominant start to his Brooklyn career, collecting eight doubles, one triple, and two home runs in 15 games with 10 RBIs.

**NIC KNOWS:** C **Nic Gaddis** has enjoyed a power play stretch at the plate, homering four times in his past 16 games. Since June 21, Gaddis has a .443 OBP, .514 slugging percentage and a .957 OPS, reaching in 21 of his past 23 games.

**PEROZA POP:** INF **Jose Peroza** has collected 35 total bases in his past 19 games with five doubles, one triple, and three home runs.

CARSON COLLECTS 11 Ks: RHP Carson Seymour struck out 11 batters last Friday night against

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: The New York Yankees High-A farm club and the Cyclones have played 18 of 30 in the 2022 series. So far, the Renegades are 10-8. No. 3 prospect, and the No. 39 prospect in baseball, OF Jasson Dominguez has recently joined the team. The current Renegades roster hosts seven of the Yankees Top 30s, including No. 6 SS Trey Sweeney, No. 8 RHP Yoendrys Gomez, No. 19 LHP T.J. Sikkema, and No. 24 2B Cooper Bowman.

Greensboro, becoming the ninth pitcher in Brooklyn Cyclones history to fan 11 batters. It's the first time a Cyclones arm has struck out 11 hitters since 2016 when LHP **Thomas Szapucki** achieved the feat on August 6th at Tri-City. That year, three Cyclones struck out 11 batters between July 23-August 6: RHP **Nabil Crismatt** vs. Aberdeen, RHP **Harol Gonzalez** at Vermont, and LHP **Thomas Szapucki** at Tri-City.

**BOMBOSAS:** Since the May 22nd doubleheader against Hudson Valley where the Cyclones blasted five home runs across two games in Coney Island, Brooklyn has turned around its power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 46 home runs in the past 56 games after just seven over the team's first 34 games.

**PROSPECT POP:** Brooklyn is home to seven of the Mets Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline. Offenisvely, OF **Alex Ramirez** ranks as the No. 4 prospect along with No. 14 OF **Jaylen Palmer**, No. 19 prospect 1B **JT Schwartz**, and No. 29 prospect INF **Jose Peroza**. On the mound Brooklyn hosts No. 9 RHP **Dominic Hamel**, No. 16 prospect RHP **Junior Santos**, and No. 21 prospect **Mike Vasil**.

**MLB DRAFT:** This past week the Mets selected 22 new players in the 2022 MLB Draft, including five picks in the Top 90. The Mets selected No. 11 C **Kevin Parada** from Georgia Tech and No. 14 SS **Jett Williams** from Rockwall-Heath High School in Texas.

BREAKOUT: The 20 year old pitched with Low-A St. Lucie in 2021, tossing 96 innings which doubles the workload he turned in in 2019 (40.2 IP) and 2018 (45). This season marks the second full season assignment for the righty.

VALUED MEMBER: Santos signed with the Mets in 2018 for \$275,000 out of Santiago in the Dominican Republic

WEIRD START: Santos s lasting just two innings in 5-1 loss to the Wilmingt clunky start may have be ponement. Ready, warming up, and tossing in the outfield minutes before schedule first pitch on Friday, Santos had to shut it down and repeat the process on Saturday after the Cyclones-Blue Rocks game was postponed due to soft infield dirt and "wet grounds."

**OPENING DAY STARTER:** Junior Santos made Brooklyn's Opening Day start in Wilmington, Delaware on Saturday evening. It was Santos' fourth Opening Day and first Opening Day start since 2018 when he pitched for the DSL Mets against the DSL Angels. In that outing, he struck out six over three innings of one-run ball.
