### RIDERS WIN FINALE BEHIND BATS, SPLIT SERIES IN SAN ANTONIO:

RIDERS WIN FINALE BEHIND BATS, SPLIT SERIES IN SAN ANTONIO: The Frisco RoughRiders blew the doors open early against the San Antonio Missions and took an 11-3 win at Nelson W. Wolff Municipal Stadium on Monday. Frisco (3-3, 35-39) took a 7-3 lead through three innings and the bullpen held strong against San Antonio (3-3, 40-35) with no runs allowed over five innings. **Evan Carter** went 3-for-4 including a solo home run in the first inning. San Antonio tied the game in the bottom of the first but Frisco reclaimed the advantage the ensuing half inning. **Aaron Zavala** led off with a double, **Nick Tanielu** and **Josh** Hatcher chipped in singles, and Scott Kapers added a sacrifice fly. The two-run second inning was overshadowed by the next frame when the first seven batters all reached base or had a sacrifice fly. Tanielu highlighted the inning with an RBI triple. Two innings later, Frisco added to the lead when Jax Biggers' fly ball escaped the right field wall for a three-run homer. In his Double-A debut, **Dane Acker** went four innings for Frisco allowing three earned runs with five strikeouts. **Theo McDowell** (2-2) followed by striking out all three batters he faced in the fifth. **Aidan** Anderson took care of two innings with no runs and three strikeouts. Eudrys Manon kept the line going with a scoreless eighth inning, and Nick Starr went 1-2-3 in the ninth to close the game. Hatcher posted three RBIs with two hits and Tanielu went 2-for-4 with two runs scored. Kellen Strahm also scored twice, including his sixth inning run after his leadoff double. Efrain Contreras (4-6) took the loss for San Antonio with six earned runs charged to him in 2.1 innings. Frisco split the series with the Missions, going 3-3 for the fourth consecutive week.

### WELCOME BACK, CARTER

Evan Carter has been fantastic since returning from the Injured List on June 21st against Springfield. Over his last 11 games since his return, he has six multi-hit games, batting .465 (20-for-43)/.520/.791/1.311 with three doubles, one triple, three home runs, 12 RBIs and 11 runs scored. Carter is now third in the Texas League in batting average (.316), third in OBP (.427) and sixth in OPS (.898).

#### THIS PEN IS NO BULL:

Over the last series in San Antonio, the Frisco bullpen dominated, going 2-0 with a 1.82 ERA (5ER/24.2IP). Over the last three games, the pen has allowed just one earned run.

#### TO HAUV AND TO HOLD:

Trevor Hauver has been one of the best hitters for the RoughRiders recently. He is currently riding a 12-game hitting streak, batting .372 (16for-43)/.500/.512/1.012 with three doubles, one home run, five RBIs, seven runs scored, 11 walks and a steal.

#### RISP-ECT THIS:

This season, the Riders are just seventh in the 10-team Texas League in batting average with runners in scoring position, hitting .256, though Frisco is fourth with 292 RBIs with RISP. Over the last 17 games (7-9 record), Frisco is hitting .264 (42-for-159) in those situations

### THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:

Thomas Saggese has been incredible for the RoughRiders on offense. He had a 15-game hitting streak ended on Thursday. In that streak, Saggese hit .443 (27-for-61)/.507/.803/1.310 with five doubles, five home runs, 17 RBIs, eight walks, 13 runs scored and a steal. For his efforts against Springfield, Saggese was named the Texas League Player of the Week, hitting .591 (13-for-22)/.654/.955/1.609 with three doubles, one triple, one home run, seven RBIs, seven runs scored and four walks. Over his last 23 games, he is hitting .363/.449/.670/1.119 with seven home runs and 22 RBIs

### AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN:

Thomas Saggese has been fantastic on first pitches this season, tied for first in the Texas League with a .600 average (15-for-25) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.575 OPS on the first pitch, which is second in the league as well. **Luisangel Acuña** has also been great, hitting .460 (23-for-50) on the initial offering while his 23 hits on the first pitch lead the league and are second in the minors.

### SPEED KILLS

Luisangel Acuña leads the league in steals with 33 and is on pace for a career-best 64 swipes. The RoughRiders are second in Texas League steals with 104 bases in 123 attempts (85 percent).

### ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRidders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Thomas Saggese** hitting Frisco's seventh grand slam of the season on last Friday. They are one of two teams with seven grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, **Luisangel Acuña, Jax Biggers, Dustin Harris, Trevor Hauver, Thomas Saggese** (2)).

#### ΔΟΙΙÑΑ ΜΑΤΑΤΑ

RoughRiders infielder Luisangel Acuña has been on fire at the plate. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .301 (86-for-286)/.361/.444/.805 through the first 66 games. In June, Acuña hit .300/.336/.460/.796. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (113).

On the season, Frisco's 362 walks are first among Texas League teams while their .354 team OBP is third in the Texas League. The Riders have four in the top seven players in Texas League walk rate this season: Dustin Harris (3rd, 15.8%), Trevor Hauver (4th, 15.6%), Evan Carter (6th, 15.3%) and Jax Biggers (8th, 14.8%). Though he is not qualified for the standings, Aaron Zavala is walking at a 17.1% rate so far this season.



-Attended South Grand Prairie High School, going 3-0 with a 1.50 ERA, striking out 20 over 14 innings in a shortened 2020 season. He was committed to Stephen F. Austin State University.

-Missed a majority of his freshman (elbow surgery for a broken growth plate) and sophomore (torn meniscus) seasons before returning healthy for his junior campaign...as a freshman, was limited to designated hitter duties on the junior varsity team while unable to pitch due to injury

-Signed his professional contract while on vacation with friends and family in Gulf Shores, Ala., and went kayaking, fishing and jet skiing to celebrate.

## 2023 SEASON

-In second start of the season with Hickory, he threw seven shutout innings at home against Bowling Green, striking out 10 batters to just three walks.

-Stephan struck out a career-high 11 batters on June 14th against Bowling Green.

-Threw four quality starts out of 11 total starts with Hickory.

### **2022 SEASON**

-Broke spring camp at Low-A and went 4-4 with a 3.34 ERA (34 ER/91.2 IP) and 102 SO across 18 G/16 GS, earning a mid-August promotion to Hickory where he posted a 2-1 record, 1.54 ERA (2 ER/11.2 IP) and 13 SO over 3 GS.

-115 strikeouts were T6th-most among TEX farmhands and .216 opp. BA was 4th-lowest in the organization (min.80.0 IP).

-Induced ground balls at an over 50% rate in 2022 with both Down East and Hickory.

### **2021 SEASON**

-Pitched in the Fall Instructional League and participated in the Texas Tour against local universities in October, making a start against Dallas Baptist University.
