ROAD WARRIORS: After winning two out of the first three over Myrtle Beach in week two of this road trip, the FredNats will try to secure at least a series split tonight as the weekend has arrived in MB. Fredericksburg is 6-3 through the first nine games of this two-week road trip to Charleston and Myrtle Beach. Tonight, RHP Jarlin Susana gets the start looking to bounce back from walking six and allowing six runs last week in Charleston. He faces Myrtle Beach righty Nick Dean, who has been one of the better starters this year for the Pelicans. The FredNats continue to lead the league in runs scored (209) and run differential (+59), and are now tied for first place in the North Division of the Carolina League with the Carolina Mudcats.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** Pelican starter Kenton Egbert set down the first 15 FredNat hitters in a row, but Fredericskburg broke up the perfect game with three runs in the 6th inning after a triple by Marcus Brown, a sac fly by Nate Ochoa, an RBI groundout from Gavin Dugas and a solo home run for Jeremy De La Rosa. FXBG got add-on runs in the 8th and 9th innings on RBIs from Brown and Brandon Pimentel, and the bullpen closed the door once again on a 5-2 victory. Thomas Schultz picked up his MiLB-leading eighth save of the year.

**BULLPEN WORK:** So far in 2024, the FredNat bullpen has been one of the best units in all of Minor League Baseball. After allowing just three runs in 15.1 IP this series, the bullpen has pitched 189.1 innings this year and allowed just 46 earned runs for a group ERA of 2.19. The Freddies are also 13/14 in save opportunities, and Thomas Schultz is tied for first in all of Minor League Baseball with eight saves. The unit has also danced out of trouble time and time again on this road trip. Last night's win over MB was the first drama-free win on this road trip. In all five wins this trip prior to yesterday, the opposing team has had the tying and/or go-ahead runs on base in the 9th inning, and FXBG's bullpen has slammed the door each time. Fredericksburg remains undefeated when leading after 7 (18-0), and 8 (20-0) innings.

**FORMULA FOR SUCCESS:** The FredNats are 17-2 this season when scoring first, including the last 14 out of the last 15 wins. Fredericksburg's only two losses this year when scoring first both came in last week's series against Charleston on Friday and Sunday, and Tuesday night against Myrtle Beach was the first time since mid-April the team won despite not scoring first.

**FORMULA CONTINUED**: Another key to winning this year has been production with runners in scoring position. In 24 wins, Fredericksburg is hitting .247 with RISP, compared to .109 in losses. The FredNats did decently well at the plate with runners in scoring position last week, going a combined 11-for-44 (.250) against the RiverDogs, and then followed it up with an 8-for-32 (.250) peformance in the first three games of this series with the Pelicans.

THEY COME THROUGH: The FredNats have two of the top run producers in the Carolina League in their lineup. Brandon Pimentel is first in the Carolina League and second in all of MiLB in RBI with 42, and Brenner Cox is tied for 4th in the league in RBI with 25. Cox had 9 RBI on this current two-week road trip. Pimentel is second in MiLB to Sugar Land's Pedro Leon, who has played a week's more of games at the Triple-A level.

**SACRIFICE YOURSELF**: The FredNats lead the league in runs scored because of a team offense approach, showcased by FXBG leading the Carolina League in sacrifice flys with 18, which is tied for the most in all of Single-A baseball. The FredNats have a sac fly in six of the nine games on this road trip.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Iriple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 165-132 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Alabama native and Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prarie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past two seasons, roles he will continue in 2024. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

**TONIGHT'S START:** Jarlin Susana is set to make his seventh start of 2024, after getting the nod on Opening Night. The big righty features a heater that routinely exceeds triple digits, to go along with a sinker, a tight slider, plus a curveball and a changeup.

**EARLY-SEASON HIGHS:** After an up-and-down April last year, Susana really hit his stride going into May. From his start on 5/3 vs Down East, Jarlin was flat out dominant. Over his next eight starts, Susana worked to a 2.35 ERA across 30.2 IP, with opponents hitting a measly .167 against him.

LATE-SEASON LULL: Unfortunately, Susana faltered as the season went on. After the aforementioned eight-start stretch, Jarlin made just four more starts the rest of the season. He struggled with his command, walking 15 batters in 22.2 IP, with an ERA north of 9.00. Susana made his final start of the year on 8/5 against Salem before being placed on the Development List to end his season.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Susana took a step back in his previous start against the Charleston RiverDogs. He hadn't walked more than two hitters in any outing this year, but Susana issued six free passes in just 2.2 innings of work, as Charleston taagged him for six earned runs.
