TODAY'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field, as your Rancho Cucamonga Quakes continue their series with game five of a six-game home stand against the Inland Empire 66ers (Angels). After tonight's game, fans will enjoy a spectacular Fireworks show, thanks to Fiore Legal, while the Quakes will don the Chaquetas uniforms on the field! Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE 66ERS: Today's game is the 23rd of 24 between these two teams in 2025 and the 11th of 12 here at home. The Quakes have taken five of six in the first three series so far against the 66ers. Last night's loss gives the 66ers three straight wins over Rancho for the first time this year and leaves the Quakes with a 16-6 mark against the 66ers. In 2024, Rancho went 7-5 here at home vs Inland Empire, 17-7 overall.

LAST GAME: The 66ers broke a 5-5 tie in the ninth, scoring six times to take the lead for good in an 11-6 win over the Quakes on Friday night at LoanMart Field. Rancho reliever Connor Godwin (2-3) struggled to start the ninth, as he allowed all six men he faced to reach safely. Inland Empire reliever Will Gervase (1-1) earned the win with 1.1 innings of relief. Rancho's Jaron Elkins (7) and Samuel Munoz (9) hit back-to-back home runs, helping Rancho rally from five runs down, as they eventually tied the game, only to drop their third straight game overall.

SNELL RECAP: The Quakes welcomed their third Dodger rehabber in 2025 on Thursday night, as lefty Blake Snell tossed two innings to start Thursday's game. Snell allowed one hit and pitched around an error, striking out four batters while throwing 31 pitches (23 strikes). He joins Teoscar Hernandez and Luis Garcia, who played at LoanMart Field earlier this year. All Dodger rehabbers are sponsored by Yaamava' Resort and Casino at San Manuel.

ROAD NOT SO FRIENDLY, LATELY: The Quakes have had a tough go of it recently on the road, as they've dropped seven of their last nine road games overall. The recent San Jose series finished poorly for Rancho, as they dropped decisions of 9-2, 12-4 and 20-2. With Friday night's 15-3 loss at Visalia, they had been outscored by 45 runs (56-11) over a four-game road losing streak. Sunday's loss in Visalia drops Rancho to just 23-22 on the road this year.

ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes made a move on Friday, as infielder Elijah Hainline was promoted to High-A Great Lakes. Hainline was batting .298 with four homers, 29 RBIs and 20 stolen bases in 66 games. No corresponding move was made, so Rancho's 30-man roster stands at 28 active players.

THE FUTURE IS NOW: Coming up on Sunday, a pair of former Quakes will appear in the MLB Futures Game in Atlanta. 2024 Quake OF Zahir Hope and 2023/24 OF Josue De Paula will be the two Dodger representatives. Both players have spent the entire 2025 season in Great Lakes of the High-A Midwest League.

STERLING PATICK: 20-year-old Sterling Patick makes his 12th start and 16th appearance, his second start and third appearance against the 66ers. Against the 66ers this year, he's allowed eight runs on ten hits over 4.1 innings. Patick's last start was on Sunday, July 6, where he tossed two scoreless innings, allowing two hits in a no-decision at Visalia. Patick was a 2023 18th-round selection for the Dodgers out of South Hills High School in West Covina.

CHRIS CLARK: Chris Clark makes his 18th start and his fourth against the Quakes. In three games against the Quakes, he's 0-2 with a 6.06 ERA, allowing 11 runs on 16 hits over 16.1 innings. In his last outing overall, he allowed six runs on nine hits over 3.2 innings in a loss vs Lake Elsinore on July 6. Clark made six appearances for the 66ers in 2023, before spending all of 2024 in High-A Tri-City of the Northwest League, when he went just 3-12 with a 6.09 ERA across 22 starts. Clark was a fifth-round pick for the Angels out of Harvard back in 2023.
