YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Erie SeaWolves, 14-4, tying the team's season high for runs scored. Erie opened the scoring in the top of the first with an RBI single by Drew Ward. Richmond answered immediately with a two-run homer in the bottom of the first inning by **Diego Rincones**. Later in the inning, **Will Wilson** hit an opposite-field, three-run homer to open a 5-1 lead. The SeaWolves closed back within three runs with a solo homer by Eric De La Rosa in the top of the second. In the bottom of the second, **Mitchell Tolman** extended Richmond's lead to 6-2 with an RBI single. **David Villar** led off the fifth with a solo home run and **Simon Whiteman** added a two-run single to push the lead to 9-2. Ward hit a two-run homer in the top of the seventh to close the gap to 9-4. In the bottom of the seventh **Luis Basabe** hit an RBI double and **Brandon Martorano** brought home a run with a fielder's choice. **Vince Fernandez** picked up an RBI on a fielder's choice in the eighth and Basabe extended the lead to 14-4 with a two-run single. **Raffi Vizcaino**, **Frank Rubio** and **Joey Marciano** each threw one scoreless inning for the Flying Squirrels.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. This series marks the first time the two teams have faced off this season. The Flying Squirrels will travel to Erie for a six-game series from September 13-19 to finish the 2021 season.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 10-17 since July 21 but have won four straight games. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 11.5 games behind first-place Akron. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked ninth in the league with a .236 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked third in the league with a 3.89 ERA for the season.

THE SEAWOLVES have dropped five of the last six games after winning six of the previous seven. The SeaWolves are ranked fourth in the league with a .251 team batting average and third with 120 homers. The Erie pitching staff is ranked sixth with a 4.24 ERA. Erie's roster includes seven of MLB.com's top-30 prospects, including C Dillon Dingler (No. 4 - on IL), RHP Reese Olson (No. 11), LHP Joey Wentz (No. 13), RHP Alex Faedo (No. 15 - on IL), INF Andre Lipcius (No. 23), RHP Paul Richan (No. 26 - on IL) and RHP Beau Brieske (No. 28). Prior to this series, the Tigers promoted No. 1 prospect Spencer Torkelson, No. 2 prospect Riley Greene and No. 10 prospect Ryan Kreidler from Erie to Triple-A Toledo.

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Aaron Blair** makes his sixth start for the Flying Squirrels and his second against the SeaWolves. He last pitched on Tuesday against Erie and allowed one run, a solo homer by Dylan Rosa, and three hits over 5.0 innings, tying his longest outing at Double-A this year, and season-high five strikeouts. Blair has gone 0-2 with a 2.25 ERA (4 ER/16.0 IP) over his last four starts since July 30. Blair began the season with the independent West Virginia Power and had his contract selected by the San Francisco Giants on July 23. He made his first start of the year on May 29 against Southern Maryland, picking up a win after allowing one run over 5.0 innings with six strikeouts. He began a start on June 3 against Long Island but left in the first inning with an injury before the game was suspended for rain. Blair was the 36th-overall pick in the 2013 MLB Draft by the Arizona Diamondbacks out of Marshall University, the highest draft pick in the school's history. He was traded to the Atlanta Braves in December 2015 along with Dansby Swanson and Ender Inciarte for pitchers Shelby Miller and Gabe Speier. Blair reached the majors for the first time in 2016 with the Braves. He missed most of the 2018 season and all of 2019 after undergoing shoulder surgery. He signed with the Arizona Diamondbacks in 2020 but was released in May after the MiLB season was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. **For more on Blair, see page two.**

FOR ERIE: Right-hander A.J. Ladwig makes his 17th start of the season. Last time out, he worked 5.0 innings and allowed one run in a no-decision against Altoona last Sunday in Erie. For the season, he has gone 3-1 with a 3.33 ERA in 10 home starts but is 2-4 with a 6.67 ERA in six road starts. Ladwig was drafted by the Detroit Tigers in the 11th round in 2014 out of Wichita State. He has pitched parts of three total seasons with the SeaWolves, going 16-13 with a 4.39 ERA in 46 outings (45 starts).

BIG FLIES IN BUNCHES: The Flying Squirrels have hit 22 homers in the last 11 games since August 10, which is tied for the most in the Double-A Northeast with Erie (22). In that stretch, **Sandro Fabian** and **David Villar** have hit four homers, **Diego Rincones** has three, **Brandon Martorano** has two home runs and **Vince Fernandez**, **Jacob Heyward**, **Simon Whiteman**, **Shane Matheny**, **Heath Quinn**, **Andres Angulo**, **Will Wilson** and **Mitchell Tolman** each have one home run.

POWER SURGE: This season, the Flying Squirrels rank fifth in the Double-A Northeast with 105 home runs. The team is on pace to hit 133 home runs this season in 120 games. The franchise record for the most home runs in a season is 109 in 2013. Richmond's 105 home runs this season is the second-highest homer total in a season in the franchise's history, ahead of the entire 2018 (97), 2017 (93), 2019 (84), 2016 (83), 2011 (83), 2012 (76), 2014 (74), 2010 (71) and 2015 (61) seasons. This year, the team has combined for a .397 slugging percentage, which is ninth in the league but would be the highest in the franchise's history (Ahead of a .382 mark from 2013). The Flying Squirrels have hit 50 homers in home games at The Diamond this year, the most in franchise history.

LEAVING THE YARD: The 2021 Flying Squirrels have five players who have reached double-digits in home runs this season, including **Vince Fernandez** (14), **David Villar** (14), **Sandro Fabian** (13), **Frankie Tostado** (11) and **Heliot Ramos** (10). Five players with 10 or more homers ties a franchise record, matching the 2013 season, which included **Jarret Parker** (18 - tied for most in a season in team history), **Adam Duvall** (17), **Javier Herrera** (16), **Andrew Susac** (12) and **Mark Miniccozzi** (10).

FABULOUS FABIAN: Over the last 11 games since August 10, **Sandro Fabian** is hitting .349 (15-for-43) with four homers and 15 RBIs. He has picked up multiple hits in four of those games. He hit two homers in the second game of last Saturday night's double-header at Bowie and is now tied for third on the team with 13 this season, which is a new career high. Fabian has picked up 11 RBIs over the last seven games since August 14, with multiple RBIs in four of those contests.

BACK IN THE SWING OF THINGS: In his last 11 games since August 10, **David Villar** is batting .410 (16-for-39) with four homers and six RBIs. He now leads the team with 14 home runs this season, which is also tied for the seventh-most in a season in franchise history. Last Thursday, Villar snapped a season-high stretch of 25 games without a homer, going deep at Bowie. He picked up two home runs in the series finale at Prince George's Stadium on Sunday afternoon. Villar has multiple hits in six of his last 11 games.

GO, DIEGO, GO!: Over his last 28 games since July 17, **Diego Rincones** is batting .320 (32-for-100) with seven homers, six doubles, one triple and 22 RBIs. He hit two homers in last week's series in Bowie and added another on Saturday night at The Diamond against the SeaWolves. Over his last 17 games since August 3, Rincones is batting .354 (23-for-65) with three homers, five doubles and 11 RBIs. He added a walk-off single on Friday night to cap a three-run bottom of the ninth for the Flying Squirrels in a 7-6 win over the SeaWolves.

TAKE A WALK: In 2019, **Jacob Heyward** set the single-season franchise record with 80 walks, surpassing the previous mark held by **Mark Miniccozzi**, who walked 62 times in 2013. Heyward has walked 27 times this season. For his career with the Flying Squirrels, Heyward has worked 107 walks, which sits him in second in the team's history in career walks. The franchise career walks record is held by **Ricky Oropesa**, who walked 113 times in his four seasons with Richmond from 2013-2016.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Frankie Tostado** is tied for 10th with 51 RBIs. **David Villar** is ninth with a .370 OBP, tied for sixth with 87 hits, tied for ninth with 22 doubles, tied for fourth with 41 walks, tied for seventh with 37 extra-base hits, tied for ninth with 154 total bases and tied for 10th with 54 runs scored. **Simon Whiteman** is tied for seventh with 15 stolen bases. **Trenton Toplikar** is ranked eighth with a 5.20 ERA and tied for seventh with 81 strikeouts. **Patrick Ruotolo** (32/T-3rd), **Joey Marciano** (32/4th), **Matt Seelinger** (30/T-5th) and **Frank Rubio** (30/T-5th) are in the top-ten in the league in games pitched. **Patrick Ruotolo** is tied for fourth with eight saves and **R.J. Dabovich** is tied for ninth with six.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Will Wilson** (10), **Tristan Beck** (14 - on IL), **Diego Rincones** (23) and **R.J. Dabovich** (30). **Simon Whiteman** is rated by *Baseball America* as being the "Fastest Baserunner" in the Giants system and Rincones is rated as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Two players, Wilson (15) and Beck (29), are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.

ROAD TO THE SHOW: Former Richmond reliever **Jose Marte** made his MLB debut for the Angels on Friday night, becoming the 75th Flying Squirrels alum to reach the majors. He entered in the fourth inning and worked 2.0 scoreless innings with four strikeouts and allowed one hit. Marte made 19 appearances for the Flying Squirrels in 2021, going 2-0 with a 3.57 ERA. He is the sixth Flying Squirrels alum to reach the majors for the first time during the 2021 season, joining **Johnesswy Fargas**, **Sammy Long**, **Daniel Camarena**, **Dusten Knight** and **Connor Overton**.
