### JUMBO SHRIMP BLANKED BY REDBIRDS 6-0

The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp were shut out 6-0 on Thursday by the Memphis Redbirds. The Redbirds (58-59, 20-22) opened up the scoring in the fourth inning when **Ivan Herrera** homered off Jumbo Shrimp (59-59, 21-19) starter **Adam Mazur** (0-1). **Nick Dunn** led off the fifth with a solo shot. **Gavin Collins** followed with a double, and two batters later, **Thomas Saggese** launched a two-run shot to widen the gap to 4-0. The score remained that way until the ninth. With one out, singled by Saggese, Koperniak and Herrera turned the carousel to plate a run. **Luken Baker's** sacrifice fly made it 6-0.

### AGUSTÍN THE GREAT

**Agustín Ramírez** had a slow start to 2024 in the New York Yankees organization. In 29 games with Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, he slashed (.224/.328/.364/.692) with 23 strikeouts. Since joining the Marlins organization on July 26, he's 14-for-50 (.280/.368/.480/.848) with two home runs, eight RBIs and four multi-hit games. Despite his short time with Jacksonville, Ramírez has one of the lower swinging strike rates on the team at 7.5% while logging one of the higher walk rates (10.5%).

### AIN'T NO SUNSHINE

After Thursday's 6-0 loss to Memphis, Jacksonville has won 31 games in their last 55 contests. In that time span, the Jumbo Shrimp have struggled, posting the eighth-lowest OPS in Triple-A (.742) while drawing the fewest walks (180). Of those 55 contests, 37 have been within three runs or fewer with Jacksonville winning 22 (.595). Despite outscoring opponents, 165-148 during this run, the Jumbo Shrimp are only scoring 3.1 runs/G, while allowing 2.7 runs/G.

### WHAT IS (G)LOVE?

Last week, Jacksonville committed seven errors in their six-game set against Toledo, including back-to-back contests with three errors. In 2024, the Jumbo Shrimp have been pretty handy with the glove, committing 75 errors (T-sixth fewest) in Triple-A. However, since 8/1, they have seen their fielding percentage drop to the worst in Triple-A (.970) while committing 13 errors in their last 12 games, tied for the fourth-most errors in both the IL and PCL. After committing just 5 errors in their previous 10 games.

### ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS

The Jumbo Shrimp have struggled this season at 121 Financial Ballpark, mustering a meager 26-33 (.441) record. Jacksonville has scored only 247 runs at home (4.2 per game), the fewest in Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp are scoring more than a half-run more per game on the road, totaling 273 (4.9 per game). Meanwhile, on the road, Jacksonville has surrendered only 251 runs (4.5 per game), the third-fewest in Triple-A. They've yielded the 12th-fewest runs of any team at home (4.9 per game). On the year, the Jumbo Shrimp are 31-26 on the road. Jacksonville hasn't had a winning record at 121 Financial Ballpark since 2021 & 2022 where they went (36-29) & (38-37) respectively.

### SWIPER NO SWIPING!

Through the first 97 games of the 2024 season, Jacksonville mustered just 49 stolen bases (second-fewest in Triple-A). Since the trade deadline on July 26, the Jumbo Shrimp still haven't logged a ton of stolen bases, just nine. (T-fifth fewest in Triple-A). However, their percentage on attempts has jumped astronomically. During this 18-game stretch, Jacksonville has only been nabbed stealing a base once in 10 attempts (90.0%) vs. 73.1% through the first 97 games of the season.

### LITTLE GUY, BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A, **Javier Sanoja** was just 6-for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5-foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances. His contact ability has manifested itself in a huge way of late; Sanoja has reached base safely in 71 of his last 82 games, notching 30 multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 105-for-325 (.323/.388/.486/.874) with 25 doubles, five triples, six home runs, 49 RBIs, 36 walks and 44 runs scored. On the season, Sanoja ranks fourth in batting average (.305), third in doubles (27), T-1st in triples (6), T-17th in XBH (39), T-16th in total bases (168) and fifth in hits (111).

### SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville has had great success against Memphis in 2024, posting a slash line of .272/.340/.435/.775. Their .755 OPS is the fourth-best among opponents this season (.819 vs. NSH, .806 vs. TOL, .805 vs. NOR)...Jumbo Shrimp pitchers have posted a 3.70 ERA vs. Redbirds hitters (2nd-lowest ERA vs. OPP)

### ABOUT DARREN

-McCaughan was originally selected by the Seattle Mariners in the 12th round of the 2017 draft out of Long Beach State. McCaughan made his major league debut for the Mariners on July 21, 2021 by pitching 5.0 innings of one-run ball at Coors Field against the Colorado Rockies.

-On February 9, 2024, two days after being designated for assignment, McCaughan was dealt to the Marlins in exchange for cash considerations.

-A terrific collegiate pitcher, McCaughan earned Big West Pitcher of the Year following both his sophomore (2016) and junior (2017) seasons at Long Beach State.
