Prospecting: The Nuts' roster has three players on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 rankings of A's prospects: No. 16 (**Steven Echavarria**), No. 19 (**Zane Taylor**) and No. 24 (**Nate Nankil**). Baseball America's recent re-ranking of A's prospects puts Echavarria at No. 16, Zane Taylor at No. 18 and **Nathan Dettmer** at No. 21.

Meet the Kernels: Cedar Rapids has the Twins' No. 3 (**Eduardo Tait**), No. 5 (**Dasan Hill**), No. 7 (**Marek Houston**), No. 10 (**Riley Quick**), No. 15 (**Brandon Winokur**), No. 21 (**Khadim Diaw**) and No. 29 (**Yasser Mercedes**) prospects. Last year, the Kernels and Lugnuts split a six-game series in Lansing. The Nuts' best hitters were **Pedro Pineda** (.368 avg., .984 OPS, 7-for-19) and **Ben Newton** (.333 avg., 6-for-18), but were out-homered 6-0, including a pair of roundtrippers from **Brandon Winokur**.

Movin' On Up: Congratulations to infielder **Casey Yamauchi** and outfielder **Devin Taylor**, who were promoted to Double-A Midland yesterday. Yamauchi, whose .297 batting average is 10th in the Midwest League, departs Lansing after playing 222 career games for the Lugnuts, scoring exactly 100 runs. Taylor makes his first career trip to Double-A after playing in the Nuts' first 57 games of the year, ranking 3rd in the Midwest League in hits (59), 5th in RBIs (43, one behind a four-way tie for the league lead) and 5th in walks (48).

Welcome to Town: To replace Casey and Devin, a pair of experienced Lugnuts returned to town. Infielder **Jared Sprague-Lott**, who opened this season with the Nuts, joins the ballclub from Single-A Stockton, while outfielder **Carlos Pacheco**, who played 18 games for the Nuts to conclude last year, joins the Lugnuts from Double-A Midland. Sprague-Lott, by the way, was named the California League Player of the Week for June 2-7, batting .524/.615/1.000 in five games against Ontario last week, going 11-for-21 with 11 runs scored, one double, three homers, nine RBIs, four walks, one HBP and three stolen bases.

Welcome to the Show: 2024 Lugnut **Kade Morris** made his MLB debut on June 6 vs. Houston, becoming the 205th all-time Lugnut to reach the Majors and the fifth this season (**Daniel Susac**, **Eduardo Rivera**, **Henry Bolte**, **Gage Jump**). There are eight current Lugnuts on the Athletics: **Morris**, **Bolte**, **Jump**, **Lawrence Butler**, **Hogan Harris**, **Jack Perkins**, **Tyler Soderstrom** and **Colby Thomas**.

Two for the Price of One: The Lugnuts have turned 67 double plays in 57 games, tied for first in Minor League Baseball with the OKC Comets - 67 in 62 games.

Cooperstown Bound: An original 1996 Lugnut as a member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** went to be voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, was named a nine-time All-Star, and won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series during a 20-year MLB career. On July 27, Beltrán will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown.

JUNE 9 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2009: In Game 1 of a home doubleheader, Chase Lirette twirled a seven-inning complete game in a Lugnuts 8-2 win over the West Michigan Whitecaps. Game 2 was a marathon: The Whitecaps scored three in the 1st, the Lugnuts scored three in the 2nd, and then both teams hung goose eggs until the 11th inning when Avisail Garcia's two-run triple gave the Whitecaps a 5-3 victory.

2011: Drew Hutchison (6 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 9 K) outpitched future MLB reliever Trevor Rosenthal (6 IP, 5 H, 2 R, 1 BB, 10 K), and the Lugnuts won at Quad Cities, 2-0, thanks to an RBI triple from Jake Marisnick and an RBI double from Marcus Knecht in the 7th inning. The game was wrapped up in two hours and 16 minutes.

2026 Campaign: 2026 Lugnuts Opening Day starter... tossed quality start against Quad Cities, April 22: 6 IP, 4 H, 3 R, 1 HR, 1 BB, 3 K on 80 pitches... quality start in rematch vs. QC, May 12: 6 2/3 IP, 4 H, 2 R, 1 BB, 5 K on 90 pitches... lefties are hitting .222, righties hitting .212... allowing .275 avg in 1st inning, .121 in 2nd, .111 in 3rd, .361 in 4th, .158 in 5th... with no outs, allowing a .296 avg., but drops to .211 w/ one out, .111 w/ two outs... has posted a 3.70 ERA at home compared to 6.46 ERA on the road.

Gatorade, Not Gator: Echavarria posted a 0.28 ERA with 80 strikeouts in 50 innings as a senior at Millburn High School, allowing only one extra-base hit the whole season. He was named New Jersey's 2022-2023 Gatorade High School Baseball Player of the Year and the top prep prospect in the state. Initially committed to Oregon, he changed his commitment to the University of Florida as his senior year dawned, but then signed with the A's for \$3 million to head into professional baseball – the only New Jersey high schooler taken in the 2023 MLB Draft.

Pro Ball: After signing, Echavarria debuted in instructional league ball in 2023. He was slated to pitch in the 2024 Spring Breakout for the A's against the Giants, but the game was canceled due to rain. On May 2, 2024, Game 22 of the Stockton Ports' season, he made his official professional debut, starting against Visalia and working three scoreless innings before allowing two unearned run in the fourth... posted 9.00 ERA in six May starts (20 R/18 ER in 18 IP)... limited opposition to one run or fewer in nine of his final 13 starts of the year, including stretch from June 25-August 4 with just 2 ER allowed in 25 2/3 IP... best inning was the fourth inning: 3-for-26, .115 avg. against... base-stealers were successful in 11 of 13 attempts.
