Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, open a six-game series against the Quad Cities River Bandits, High-A affiliate of the Kansas City Royals, the only meetings between the two clubs this year. The first three games of this series conclude the first half, followed by the second three games opening the second half.

Last Game, Sunday: Whitecaps 13, Lugnuts 1. Luke Gold cracked a grand slam to cap an eight-run ninth inning, as West Michigan blew out the Lugnuts late to win five of six games in the series. The 'Caps outscored the Nuts 52-16 and outhit them 79-44, posting a 1.51 team ERA while ballooning the Lugnuts' team ERA to 7.50.

On Deck: The Lugnuts and River Bandits play through Sunday, finishing up the first half on Thursday and opening up the second half on Friday. Then the Nuts return home from Tuesday, June 24, through Sunday, June 29, vs. the Dayton Dragons.

**Prospecting:** The Lugnuts have six of MLB Pipeline's Top 30 Athletics prospects: No. 8 prospect (**Tommy White**), No. 11 (**Joshua Kuroda-Grauer**), No. 13 (**Steven Echavarria**), No. 17 (**Ryan Lasko**), No. 18 (**Rodney Green, Jr.**) and No. 28 (**Nate Nankil**). The A's new No. 2 prospect and the most recent MiLB Top 100 prospect was Lansing's Opening Day starter, southpaw phenom **Gage Jump.** 

Welcome Back to the QC: 2024 River Bandits outfielder Jared Dickey was traded to the Athletics last year at the deadline with Will Klein and Triple-A ace Mason Barnett, returning to Davenport from August 20-25 last year and going 5-for-24 (.208) with exactly one hit in five of the six games, including a home run in the series opener on August 20 – his 10th home run of the season.

This Section is About T.J. Schofield-Sam: Lansing's first baseman is 2nd in all of Minor League Baseball in batting average (.347), and leads the MiLB leader, San Jose's Carlos Gutierrez, in OPS, .950-.914. Schofield-Sam leads the Midwest League in base hits (74) and HBPs (18), and ranks 2nd in total bases (112), 3rd in OPS (.950), tied for 2nd in triples (4), 3rd in slugging (.526), 3rd in OBP (.424), tied for 4th in runs scored (41), tied for 6th in doubles (15) and tied for 5th in extra-base hits (24).

The Men in the Pen: The Lugnuts have four of the six most heavily used relievers in the league, with Blaze Pontes appearing in the most games (22) and Mark Adamiak, Hunter Breault and Yehizon Sanchez tied for 2nd with 21 appearances. Adamiak leads the league with 10 saves.

At the Plate: The Lugnuts rank 1st in the Midwest League in fewest strikeouts (439), 3rd in batting average (.257), 2nd in base hits (535), 1st in doubles (126), 3rd in on-base percentage (.354), 3rd in total bases (796) and 4th in OPS (.736).

On the Mound: Lansing's pitching corps is 1st in the league in holds (27), tied for 1st in complete games (2),1st in fewest HBPs (21), 1st in fewest balks (4), 2nd in fewest walks (219) and tied for 3rd in saves (16).

In the Field: The Nuts have turned 67 double plays this season, most in the Midwest League.

Welcome to the Show: Five former Lugnuts have made a name for themselves in the Majors this season, from first-time manager Clayton McCullough (2008-2009) with the Marlins to players Max Muncy (March 27), Gunnar Hoglund (May 2), Denzel Clarke (May 23) and Jack Winkler (May 31), increasing the overall total to 197 Nuts who've worked their way from Lansing to MLB.

What Crowds! The Lugnuts drew attendances of 3,847; 3,835; 6,364; 7,258; 7,896 and 7,379 during the last homestand, averaging out to 6,097 fans per game. That's a higher average per game than such Triple-A notables as Las Vegas, El Paso and Charlotte.

Recent Transaction: Outfielder Jonny Butler, on the Injured List, has begun a rehab assignment in the Arizona Complex League.

#### **History vs. Quad Cities**

The Lugnuts are 74-81 all-time vs. the River Bandits, 41-37 at home and 33-44 in Davenport.

After not meeting up at all in 2021 and 2022, the Lugnuts and River Bandits played 12 games against one another in 2023. (Lansing went 7-5, 3-3 in QC.)

Last year, the Nuts went 2-4 at Quad Cities, held in late August. Future Royal Jac Caglianone went 6-for-25, .240, .589 OPS, with 2 doubles, 1 walk, 4 strikeouts. The Nuts batted .188 and scored 20 runs in the series.

## JUNE 15TH IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**1997:** The Lugnuts hosted the Midwest League All-Star Game, won by the East 6-5 over the West before an All-Star Game league-record crowd of 10,060. The event included a "Stars of Yesterday" old-timers game involving Bob Feller, Fergie Jenkins, Gates Brown, Willie Horton, and Mickey Lolich.

**2003:** The Lugnuts' Keith Butler stars in the Midwest League All-Star Game, going 3-for-3 with a walk-off RBI single to lift the East over the West. 5-4.

**2017:** The West Michigan Whitecaps set a Midwest League record with 11 doubles and tied a franchise record with 25 hits, demolishing the Lugnuts, 15-8, at Cooley Law School Stadium – a result that eliminated the Lugnuts from playoff contention.

   induced double plays in four consecutive innings in last start, and 10 double plays total for the season.

No-Hit History: On June 13, 2024, tossed five hitless innings, walking two and striking out six, before handing the baton to Grant Judkins (2 2/3) and then Colton Johnson (1 1/3) as part of the Lugnuts' 8-0 no-hitter of the Cedar Rapids Kernels, the 4th no-hitter in franchise history and the first home no-hitter since April 2003.

Jupiter? How did Jake's hometown receive its name? The Hobe tribe lived in the area; a Spanish mapmaker miswrote their name as Jobe, which was then miswritten again as Jove, which was then mistranslated to Jupiter. Jupiter is located on the eastern coast of Florida in Palm Beach County on the Atlantic Ocean. Burt Reynolds was born in Lansing and died in Jupiter.

Hometown Hero: Started four years for Jupiter High School ("Warriors," wearing green and gold)... totaled 229 strikeouts, 1.49 ERA and 1.13 WHIP... two-time FHSAA All-State... honored twice as the 9A Player of the Year... also from Jupiter H.S.: Miles Mikolas and Dante Bichette (but not son Bo, who was homeschooled and played for Lakewood High School in St. Petersburg). the Garland family was originally from New England before moving to Florida shortly before Jake was born; the Garlands all root for Boston-area teams.

College Days: Attended the University of Miami (Coral Gables), a baseball program founded in 1940 with four NCAA championships and 25 CWS appearances... played for head coach Gino DiMare... true freshman year was the pandemic-shortened 2020 season, making six relief appearances before the year was shut down... returned in 2021 as a member of the rotation: 16 games, 13 starts, totaling a teamhigh 68 innings (5.69 ERA, 38 K, 14 BB, .286 avg.)... improved in 2022 to a 3.99 ERA in 65 1/3 innings (54 K, 11 BB, lowering home runs from 10 to four)... fifth of six Hurricanes drafted in 2022... the last Miami product drafted by the A's: Jemile Weeks (1st round, 12th overall, 2008)... two other Hurricanes previously played for the Lugnuts: 3B Mark Sobolewski and OF Adam Finnieston.
