BROOKLYN CYCLONES (39-44, 9-8)

ABOUT YESTERDAY AFTERNOON: OF **Stanley Consuegra** went 4-5 with three doubles, a home run, and five RBIs leading the offense to a 9-0 victory over Greensboro. RHP **Garrison Bryant** tossed six scoreless and RHP **Daison Acosta** finished the final three for Brooklyn's second shutout victory of the season. Consuegra led the way with four hits, but INF **Shervyen Newton** went 3-4 with a triple and three runs scored, and OF **Matt Rudick** collected two hits and two RBIs. Greensboro starter RHP **Nick Garcia** struck out nine over five innings.

GREEN AROUND THE GILLS: For the first time ever, the Greensboro Grasshoppers and the Brooklyn Cyclones play against each other. Prior to the realignment in Minor League Baseball ahead of the 2021 season, the Cyclones were part of the New York Penn League at Short Season Class A, while Greensboro has been part of the South Atlantic League since 1979. Pittsburgh has had an affiliate with Greensboro since 2019. Prior to that, the Miami Marlins were with Greensboro from 2003-2018 and the Yankees from 1990-2002. Baseball in Greensboro dates back to the early 1900s.

CON SWAGGER: OF **Stanley Consuegra** put the team on his back Wednesday afternoon, going 4-for-5 with three doubles, a home run, and five RBIs. Consuegra doubled three times for the first time in his career, while he tallied four hits for the second time in his career and five RBIs in a game for the third time in his career. Consuegra recorded 10 total bases, putting together Brooklyn's single-most impactful offensive game of the season.

NIC KNOWS: C **Nic Gaddis** has enjoyed a power play stretch at the plate, homering three times in his past 12 games with a .492 slugging percentage. Since June 21, Gaddis has a .423 OBP and a .915 OPS, reaching in 17 of his past 19 games.

vs. GREENSBORO: The Pittsburgh Pirates affiliate comes to Maimonides Park, setting up a matchup with Brooklyn for the first time in team history. Greensboro is in the North Division and hosts three of Pittsburgh's Top 30 prospects including former Mets minor leaguer No. 6 C Endy Rodriguez. He is joined by No. 11 RHP Jared Jones and No. 19 OF Hudson Head. The Grasshoppers play at First National Bank Field in Greensboro, North Carolina.

PEROZA POP: INF **Jose Peroza** has collected 24 total bases in his past 12 games with four doubles, one triple, and two home runs.

HELP! I NEED SOMEONE: Brooklyn ranks 118 out of 120 Minor League teams with 310 runs scored and 116 out of 120 teams in batting average (.217) and 115 out of 120 in home runs (47).

BOMBOSAS: Since the May 22nd doubleheader against Hudson Valley where the Cyclones blasted five home runs across two games in Coney Island, Brooklyn has turned around its power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 40 home runs in the past 49 games after just seven over the team's first 34 games.

PROSPECT POP: Brooklyn is home to seven of the Mets Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline. Offenisvely, OF **Alex Ramirez** ranks as the No. 4 prospect along with No. 14 OF **Jaylen Palmer**, No. 19 prospect 1B **JT Schwartz**, and No. 29 prospect INF **Jose Peroza**. On the mound Brooklyn hosts No. 9 RHP **Dominic Hamel**, No. 16 prospect RHP **Junior Santos**, and No. 21 prospect **Mike Vasil**.

BREAK ROOM: With the MLB All-Star Game coming up in Los Angeles on Tuesday, the Minors also get a four-day break. While there is no South Atlantic League All-Star Game, Brooklyn is off Monday through Thursday of next week and back at it July 22-24 at Jersey Shore.

MORE!: Luis Moreno makes his sixth start at High-A and seventh South Atlantic League appearance, pitching against Greensboro for the first time.

MORE-K-NO: Moreno struck out a career-high nine batters 7/2 at Hudson Valley on July 2.

WELCOME: Moreno earned the promotion on June 1 coming to Brooklyn with fellow St. Lucie Mets pitcher LHP Nathan Lavender. The promotions from RHP Hunter Parsons and RHP Jordan Yamamoto to Double-A Binghamton made room for two new arms.

BIG YEAR: The Dominican righty has made three starts and six relief appearances with Low-A St. Lucie, striking out eight over six innings in relief against the Daytona Tortugas on May 31 before the promotion. Moreno tossed consecutive outings which would qualify as "quality starts."

2022: With St. Lucie, Moreno posted a 3.56 FIP and a 2.68 ERA with a 22% strikeout rate and a 12% walk rate, compiling 40 1/3 innings in the Florida State League.

ELIMINATING HOMERS: Moreno's 2021 season with Low-A St. Lucie featured nine home runs allowed in 73 innings and 21 games, leading to a 6.20 FIP and 5.42 ERA. This season, Moreno allowed just one home run in 40 1/3 innings at the same level.

JUMP IN: Moreno signed with the New York Mets in June of 2019 at 20 years old. While young pitchers usually sign with teams at either 16 or 17 years old, Moreno signed and pitched with the DSL Mets1 and DSL Mets2 in 2019.
