LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox fell in both games of their doubleheader to the Somerset Patriots on Sunday, losing 4-1 and 6-1 to drop their fourth straight series. In game one, **Samuel Basallo** homered to tie the score at one. **Patrick Reilly** threw 3.1 shutout innings with five strikeouts in his Double-A Bowie debut but the Patriots scored three ninth-inning runs to win the game. In game two, Somerset jumped out to a 6-0 lead with **John Rhodes** breaking the shutout on a solo homer in the seventh.

ALL-STAR SAMUEL

C/1B **Samuel Basallo**, the Orioles '24 All-Star Futures Game selection, is tied for the 7th-most hits in the Eastern League (92) and is 4th in total bases (153). On Sunday, Basallo homered for a second consecutive game, his 15th of the season, and is one homer shy of sharing the Eastern League lead. The No. 2 O's/ No. 12 MLB prospect is tied for the 2nd-most homers by a teenager in MiLB (15) and is the first teenager to hit double-digit homers in an Eastern League season since Vladimir Guerrero Jr. in '18.

BENCOSME BARRELS

IF **Frederick Bencosme** has tallied a hit in 10 of his last 11 games. The Orioles No. 24 prospect had his nine-game hit streak snapped in game one on Sunday. Over his last 10 games, Bencosme is batting .455 (15-for-33) with three doubles, a homer and four RBI. Against Somerset last week, Bencosme went 11-for-19 in the series.

THE FABULOUS FABIAN

OF **Jud Fabian's** 16 homers on the season is tied for the most in the Eastern League with Hartford's Zach Kokoska, Erie's Chris Meyers and Somerset's Agustin Ramirez. The O's No. 8 prospect has 31 career home runs with the Baysox, the 13th Baysox player in franchise history to eclipse 30 career homers.

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF **Dylan Beavers'** 11 homers on the season has already matched his home run total from last year. The 22-year-old has reached base in 69 of 87 games played in his second season with the Baysox. He leads the team in walks (47) and stolen bases (24), both tied for 4th-most in the Eastern League, respectively.

SECOND HALF SILAS

C **Silas Ardoin** is batting a team-best .345 since the All-Star Break with an on-base percentage of .500 and OPS of .914. The 23-year-old has collected a hit in five straight contests. Defensively, Ardoin has been one of the best backstops in the Eastern League. His 21 base runners caught stealing is third-most in the circuit.

COUNTRY RHODES

OF **John Rhodes** broke Somerset's shutout bid in game two with his second homer of the series on Sunday. The last time Rhodes faced Harrisburg, the Orioles No. 19 prospect went 5-for-5 with a home run and a career-high six RBI on Father's Day Sunday on June 16.

SIZING UP THE SENATORS

Entering this week, the Harrisburg Senators are in last place in the Southwest Division with a record of 12-21. The Double-A affiliate of the Nationals missed out on the postseason in the first half by one game. Harrisburg's offense is at the bottom of the league in AVG, OPS and HR but the pitching owns the second-best ERA in the circuit. Eight of the Nationals top 30 prospects are on the Senators active roster - OF Daylen Lile (No. 9), RHP Tyler Stuart (No. 16), OF Andrew Pinckney (No. 18), RHP Zach Brzycky (No. 19), SS Kevin Made (No. 20), OF Jeremy De La Rosa (No. 25), RHP Andry Lara (No. 26), RHP Marquis Grissom (No. 27).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Chase Solesky makes his eighth start of the season for the Senators. The 26-year-old is coming off a strong month of July where he posted a 2.89 ERA in 37.1 innings. In his most recent start against Akron on Wednesday, he pitched a season-high 6.1 innings over two runs and six hits allowed in a no decision. Solesky began the season with Triple-A Charlotte before being released on March 20. The Nationals signed him to a minor league deal on June 10.

Gave up first run of season on 7/25 vs AKR. Has six or more strikeouts in three of five outings this season. Struck out season-high seven over 4.0 scoreless, hitless innings of relief on 7/19 vs HFD. Started first two outings of season and threw at least four scoreless innings each. Baysox are 2-2 when he starts. Began season on 60-day IL. Sent on a rehab assignment to FCL Orioles on 6/4 before continuing rehab assignment in High-A Aberdeen on 6/16. In three rehab starts with IronBirds, threw 10 IP and struck out 13 over 3 BB to a 6.30 ERA.

2023: Spent entire season with Double-A Bowie primarily as a starter. Posted a 6.04 ERA in 18 games (11 starts) over 53.2 innings with 70 strikeouts. Struck out sixth-most batters on the team. Punched out five or more batters eight times. Did give up 12 homers, tied for fourth-most. Was on the IL from 7/13 - 8/19. Returned from the IL on 8/19 and made five appearances to finish out season. Pitched in the Arizona Fall League for Mesa Solar Sox. Appeared in five games (two starts) and threw 9.2 innings with 15 strikeouts over nine walks.

2022: Spent entire season with High-A Aberdeen. Pitched in 24 games (14 starts) and threw 88.2 innings with 97 strikeouts to a 3.25 ERA. Recorded most wins (11) and 10th-most IP in O's system. Threw five scoreless innings as part of a combined no-hitter on 6/18. Started two postseason games and allowed just one run over nine innings, including four scoreless innings in South Atlantic League Championship Series.

2021: Debuted professionally with Single-A Delmarva. Pitched in six games (two starts) and struck out 16 batters over 13 innings without allowing a walk.

CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
